- 1. Centre to Rank 131 Cities Based on Actions to Improve Air Quality: The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) will launch the 'Swachh Vayu Sarvekshan' programme under National Clean Air Programme 2019 (NCAP) to rank cities based on their actions to improve air quality. The ranking will be based only on the actions taken by the cities to improve the air quality in different domains and not on the measurement of the air quality parameters to rank the cities. According to the World Air Quality Report of 2021, India ranked fifth among the 117 most polluted countries.
- 2. Arogya Manthan 2022 launched by Mansukh Mandaviya: Arogya Manthan 2022 event was officially launched by the Union Health Minister in Government of India, Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya to commemorate four years since the launch of the Ayushman Bharat-Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB PM-JAY) and one year since the launch of the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM). More than 10 crore impoverished people are intended to benefit from the programme, which offers vulnerable families a five lakh rupee health subsidy each year. Prime Minister Narendra Modi in September 2018 announced its debut.
- 3. Dr. M Srinivas named as new Director of AIIMS Delhi: The dean of Employees' State Insurance Company (ESIC) Hospital and Medical College, Hyderabad, Dr M Srinivas has been appointed the director of New Delhi's All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), nearly six months after the tenure of the previous director, Dr Randeep Guleria, formally ended. The appointment is for a period of five years with effect from the date of assumption of charge of the post, or till attaining the age of 65 years, or until further orders, whichever is the earliest, according to the order. AIIMS Delhi Established: 1956; AIIMS Delhi First Director: B.B Dikshit; AIIMS Delhi Under: Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.
- 4. Leh achieved 100 percent digitization of banking operations: The highest-located district in India, Leh has achieved 100 per cent digitization of banking operations. Union Territory Level Bankers Committee Ladakh, the Reserve Bank of India has felicitated the bankers of the district. Leh district has completed the digitization of all the operating banks in a short span of a year. Thrissur district of Kerala became the first fully digital banking district of the country in August 2021. Kerala is also the first state in India to achieve the target of Financial Inclusion of having at least one bank account in a family. Ladakh Lieutenant Governor is Radha Krishna Mathur.
- 5. Jagdeep Dhankhar released a book titled "Pandit Deendayal Upadhyay Jeevan Darshan Aur Samsamyikta": The Vice President, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar has released the book titled "Pt. Deendayal Upadhyay Jeevan Darshan Aur Samsamyikta" (five volumes) in New Delhi and on this occasion highlighted the importance of Pt Deendayal's thoughts in contemporary times.
- 6. Chhattisgarh CM Bhupesh Baghel launched 'Hamar Beti Hamar Maan' campaign: Chhattisgarh government has decided to launch a campaign on women's safety titled 'Hamar Beti Hamar Maan' (our daughter, our honour). The focus of the campaign is creating awareness on safety measures among school- and college-going girls and prioritising registration and investigation of women-related crimes. Under the campaign, lady police officers and personnel will visit schools and colleges in the state to hold discussions and give guidance on legal rights, good touch-bad touch and preventive measures against sexual harassment and exploitation, cybercrime and social media-related crime, to girl students. The Rs 485-crore airport project is a joint venture of the Airports Authority of India (AAI), and the governments of Punjab and Haryana.
- Indian Railways installed RTIS system developed by ISRO: Indian Railways is installing a Real-Time Train Information System (RTIS), developed in collaboration with the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO), on locomotives "for automatic acquisition of train movement timing at the stations, including that of arrival and departure or run-through". With this, Train Control will now be able to track the location & speed of RTIS-enabled locomotives /trains more closely, without any manual intervention.

- 10. Indian government introduces "Sign Learn" smartphone app: Sign Learn" smartphone app: The Center released the "Sign Learn" smartphone app, a 10,000-word lexicon for Indian Sign Language (ISL). Pratima Bhoumik, minister of state for social justice and empowerment, introduced the app. The 10,000-word Indian Sign Language Research And Training Centre (ISLRTC) lexicon serves as the foundation for Sign Learn. All the terms in the ISL dictionary can be searched using Hindi or English on the app, which is accessible in Android and iOS versions.
- 11. Asha Parekh to be bestowed with 52nd Dadasaheb Phalke award :Veteran actress Asha Parekh has been declared the recipient of the 2020 Dadasaheb Phalke award, making her the 52nd awardee of the honour. Union Minister for Minister of Information and Broadcasting, Anurag Thakur announced her name. Southern film superstar Rajinikanth was the recipient of the last Dadasaheb Phalke award. The Dadasaheb Phalke Award is the highest honour in Indian cinema. The award was instituted in 1969, the award is the highest honour for an artiste in Indian cinema.
- 12. Bathukamma: Telangana festival begins across state, PM greets everyone: Telangana festival Bathukamma: The state floral festival known as Bathukamma has started in Telangana. The state's nine-day official celebration got underway on the 25th. On the auspicious anniversary of Bathukamma, Prime Minister Narendra Modi thanked everyone, especially the Nari Shakti of Telangana. - 13. CBI raids nationwide against Child Abuse material under Operation Megha Chakra: Operation Megha Chakra: CBI hunts for Child Sexual Abuse Material Online Circulation Cases in 20 States & UTs. As part of Operation Megha Chakra, the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) searched 56 locations across 20 States and Union Territories in relation to cases of the internet distribution of child sexual abuse material. - 14. Cochin International Airport awarded ASQ award for 'Mission Safeguarding': The Cochin International Airport Limited (CIAL) has been awarded the Airport Service Quality (ASQ) award 2022 by the Airport Council

International (ACI). The award is considered to be the highest honour in the global aviation sector. CIAL received the award in the 5-15 million passenger category of airports operating in the Asia-Pacific region. The award is for its implementation of the 'Mission Safeguarding' programme, which ensured seamless traffic and reinforced passenger satisfaction in the aftermath of the pandemic. Earlier in March of this year, CIAL had received the 'Covid champion' award at Wings India 2022, for the successful implementation of 'Mission Safeguarding'.

- 15. Indian-origin Suella Braverman won first Queen Elizabeth II award: Britain's Indian-origin Home Secretary, Suella Braverman has been named winner of the first-ever Queen Elizabeth II Woman of the Year award at a ceremony in London. The 42-year-old barrister, who was appointed to the Cabinet earlier this month by British Prime Minister Liz Truss, said it was the "honour of her life" to take on the new role at the Asian Achievers Awards (AAA) 2022 ceremony, dedicated to the memory of the late monarch who passed away recently. Braverman was previously Attorney General between 2020-2022. Sue-Ellen Cassiana "Suella" Braverman KC is a British politician and barrister serving as Home Secretary since 6 September 2022. She was the Attorney General for England and Wales from 2020 to 2022.
- 16. Uttarakhand awarded for adventure tourism & all round development of tourism: On the occasion of World Tourism Day, Uttarakhand received the first prize in two categories, for the best adventure tourism destination and all-around development of tourism from the Ministry of Tourism. The State's Tourism and Culture minister Satpal Maharaj received the awards from Vice President Jagdeep Dhankar during the presentation of the National Tourism Awards 2018-19 in New Delhi. Governor: Gurmit Singh, Chief minister: Pushkar Singh Dhami.
- 17. Gol appoints Lt Gen Anil Chauhan as the new Chief of Defence Staff: The government of India has announced the appointment of Lt General Anil Chauhan (Retired) as the next Chief of Defence Staff (CDS), who will also function as Secretary to the Government of India, Department of Military Affairs. The NDA alumnus became the General Officer Commanding-in-Chief of the Eastern Command in September 2019 and held the charge until his retirement from the service on May 31, 2021. The Chief of Defence Staff is the Permanent Chairman of the Chiefs of Staff Committee and has to be the main military adviser to the Defence Minister besides giving impartial advice to the political leadership. General Rawat, 63, took charge as India's first Chief of Defence Staff in January 2020. The position was created to integrate the three services the Army, the Navy and the Air Force.
- 18. Senior Advocate R Venkataramani named as new Attorney General of India: Senior advocate R

 Venkataramani has been appointed as the new Attorney General of India. The President has appointed Mr

 Venkataramani as the new Attorney General for a period of three years from the 1st of October. The notification regarding Mr Venkataramani's appointment as the Attorney General was issued today by the Department of Legal Affairs, Union Ministry of Law and Justice. Mr Venkataramani will replace current Attorney General KK Venugopal whose term ends on September 30, 2022. Mr Venugopal is currently on his third extension. What is Article 76?:- Article 76 of the constitution mentions that he/she is the highest law officer in India. As a chief legal advisor to the government of India, he advises the union government on all legal matters. He also is the primary lawyer representing the Union Government in the Supreme Court of India.
- 19. Uttar Pradesh wins Ayushmann Utkrishta award 2022: Ayushmann Utkrishta Award 2022 has been given to Uttar Pradesh for adding several healthcare facilities to the health facility register. With 28728 new healthcare facilities added to the National Health Facility Register, Uttar Pradesh is the best performing state in the nation. With over 2 crore ABHA Accounts, the state is also the second best State for creating Ayushmann Bharat health accounts (ABHA). These are the state's initial few landmarks.

Global Innovation Index 2022: India climbs to 40th rank: Global Innovation Index 2022: India has climbed to the 40th rank in the Global Innovation Index of the World Intellectual Property Organization. This is a huge leap of 41 places in 7 years. India has leapfrogged to 40th position on the Global Innovation Index (GII) 2022 from the 81st spot in 2015. India's innovation performance is above average for the upper-middle-income group in almost every innovation pillar, with the exception of infrastructure, where it scores below average. Within Central and Southern Asia, India continues to lead in the 40th position, moving further up the rankings, from its 46th position in 2021. - 22. RBI Repo Rate Hike by 50 bps to 5.9%: RBI Monetary Policy: RBI Repo Rate: The decision of RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das headed the six-member Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) has been announced. The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has hiked the repo rate by 50 basis points to 5.90%, the fourth straight increase in the current cycle, to tame the sustained above-target retail inflation rate.

RBI projects 7% GDP growth for FY23, Inflation remain 6.7%: RBI projects 7% GDP growth for FY23: The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has projected 7% real GDP growth for the Financial year 2023 (FY23). Inflation in India is predicted to remain 6.7%. As a result, RBI raised its policy rate by 50 basis points (bps) in response to growing concerns about increasing inflation, global headwinds, and a drop in the value of the rupee to historic lows.
- 24. Kumar Sanu, Shailendra Singh, Anand-Milind gets Lata Mangeshkar Award (2019-2021): Noted playback singers Kumar Sanu and Shailendra Singh and music-composer duo Anand-Milind were conferred with the National Lata Mangeshkar Award for different years. They will be presented the prestigious award (on September 28), the birth anniversary of the late legendary singer, at her birthplace Indore. State Culture Minister Usha Thakur conferred Shailendra Singh, Anand-Milind, and Kumar Sanu with the award for the years 2019, 2020 and 2021 respectively.
- 25. Hurun India 40 & under self-made rich list 2022' topped by Zerodha's Nikhil Kamath: Nikhil Kamath, the cofounder of Zerodha, topped the 'IIFL Wealth Hurun India 40 & Under Self-Made Rich List 2022' with a net worth of Rs 17,500 crore. Bhavish Aggarwal, the founder of Ola, came in second place (Rs 11,700 crore), and Divyank Turakhia of Media.net in third place (Rs 11,200 crore). The IIFL Wealth Hurun India Rich List 2022 has been researched and compiled by the Hurun Research Institute for the tenth year running.
- **26. Death of Jayanti Patnaik, former MP and first chair of the National Commission for Women:** Death of Jayanti Patnaik: Jayanti Pattnaik, the first chair of the National Women's Commission and a former member of parliament, passed away in Bhubaneswar, the capital of Odisha. She was the wife of late Janaki Ballav Pattnaik. President Droupadi Murmu has sent her condolences to her family, friends, and well-wishers, describing her as an accomplished social worker who won the hearts of the people of the state by her service and dedication.

- 28. Reliance Jio Chairman Akash Ambani listed on Time's 100 Emerging Leaders': Reliance Jio Chairman Akash Ambani listed on Time's 100 Emerging Leaders'. Reliance Jio Chairman Akash Ambani, son of billionaire Mukesh Ambani, has been named by TIME magazine in the TIME100 Next list that recognises "rising stars from across industries and around the world. Significantly, he is the only Indian to be featured on the list this year. However, there is another Indian-born American business leader, subscription social platform OnlyFans' Indianorigin CEO Amrapali Gan, on the list as well.
- 29. World's largest safari park to be developed in Gurugram: World's largest jungle safari park to be developed in Haryana. The World's largest jungle safari park is spread across an area of 10000 acres in the Aravalli Mountain Range of Gurugram and Nuh District. This project will be the largest such project in the world.
- 30. 5G Launch: PM Modi says rollout of 5G a gift to 130 billion Indians: 5G Launch: The nation's 5G services were officially inaugurated by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on October 1st, 2022, ushering in a period of ultrahigh-speed mobile internet, according to a statement from the Prime Minister's Office. The sixth iteration of the India Mobile Congress was also launched by PM Modi. - 31. Indian Women's rights activist Srishti Bakshi wins 'Changemaker' award: A women's rights activist from India, Srishti Bakshi has won the 'Changemaker' award at the UN SDG (United Nations Sustainable Development Goals) Action Awards held at a ceremony in Bonn, Germany. The award is given to recognise the efforts of Srishti Bakshi to raise awareness of gender-based violence and inequality. Srishti Bakshi, a marketer -turn ed-women's-rights- activist and founder of the CrossBow Miles movement, started on an on-foot pilgrimage of 3,800 Km through 12 Indian states from Kanyakumari to Kashmir. She has covered a distance of 30-35 km and met anywhere between 150-200 people a day.
- 32. India celebrates 118th birth anniversary of Lal Bahadur Shastri: India celebrates the 118th birth anniversary of Lal Bahadur Shastri, the nation's second Prime Minister. Shastri, who succeeded Jawaharlal Nehru, was respected for his forthrightness and honesty, and after his passing, he was awarded the Bharat Ratna, making him the first posthumous laureate of this prestigious award. Shastri has the same birthday (2 October) as Mahatma Gandhi even though he was born in 1904, 35 years later. He is also remembered for composing the slogan of "Jai Jawan, Jai Kisan". Shastri died on January 11, 1966, in Tashkent, Uzbekistan, just a day after the peace treaty was signed for the end of the 1965 Indo-Pakistan War.
- 33. International Day for the Total Elimination of Nuclear Weapons 2022: The United Nations observes 26

 September every year as the International Day for the Total Elimination of Nuclear Weapons. The aim of the day
