

PARTS OF SPEECH

Words are divided into different kinds or classes, called Parts of Speech, according to their use; that is, according to the work they do in a sentence. The parts of speech are eight in number:

- 1. Noun.
- 2. Adjective.
- 3. Pronoun.
- 4. Verb.
- 5. Adverb.
- 6. Preposition.
- 7. Conjunction.
- 8. Interjection.



Akbar was a greatKing.

Kolkata is on the Hooghly.

The rose smells sweet.

The sun shines bright.

His courage won him honour.

An Adjective is a word used to add something to the meaning of a noun; as,

There are twenty boys in this class. COVERNMENT

An Adjective has three divisions:

- Articles: A/AN/THE
- **Determiners**: some ,any, few, many,little,much...
- Degree: Tall/Taller/Tallest

WAY TO GOVERNMENT JOBS

A Pronoun is a word used instead of a noun; as,

John is absent, because he is ill.

The book are where you left them

A Verb is a word used lo express an action possession or state; as

Kolkata is a big city.

Iron and copper are useful metals.

Rama has a big house.

The girl wrote a letter to her cousin

An Adverb is a word used to add something to the meaning of a verb, an adjective, another adverb or preposition; as,

He worked the sum quickly.

This flower is very beautiful.

She pronounced the word quite correctly.

He sat just behind me.

A Preposition is a word used with a noun or a pronoun to show how the person orthing denoted by the noun or pronoun stands in relation to something else; as,

There is a cow in the garden.

A Conjunction is a word used to join words or sentences; as. Rama and Hari are cousins. Two and two make four. I ran fast, but missed +1-

An Interjection is a word which expresses some sudden feeling; as,

Hurrah! We have won the game. Alas! She is dead.

As words are divided into different classes according to the work they do in sentences, it is clear that we cannot say to which part of speech a word belongs unless wesee it used in a sentence.

WAY TO GOVERNMENT JOBS

They arrived soon after. (Adverb)

They arrived after us. (Preposition)

They arrived after we had left. (Conjunction)
