- 1. International Day for Mine Awareness and Assistance in Mine Action 2022:** The United Nations' International Day for Mine Awareness and Assistance in Mine Action is celebrated every year on the 4th of April. The day aims to raise awareness about landmines and progress toward their eradication. In 2022 the United Nations Mine Action Service marks the Day under the theme "Safe Ground, Safe Steps, Safe Home." On 8 December 2005, the General Assembly declared that 4 April of each year shall be observed as the International Day for Mine Awareness and Assistance in Mine Action. It was first observed on 4 April 2006.
- 2. Australia wins ICC Women's Cricket World Cup 2022:** Australia beat England by 71 runs in the finals to claim their seventh Women's World Cup on April 03, 2022, at Hagley Oval in Christchurch, New Zealand. The Player of the Tournament went to Alyssa Healy. Alyssa Healy of Australia scored 170 runs in the match, the highest individual score made by any cricketer, male or female, in the World Cup Final. She was also the leading run-scorer in the tournament with 509 runs. The 2022 ICC Women's Cricket World Cup was the 12th edition of the Women's Cricket World Cup. The tournament was held in New Zealand from 4 March to 3 April 2022. **Most wickets (All time):** Jhulan Goswami (45), India.
- 3. WHO suspends UN supply of Bharat Biotech's Covaxin vaccine for Covid-19:** The World Health Organization suspended supply through United Nations agencies of COVID-19 vaccine Covaxin, produced by India's Bharat Biotech, to allow the manufacturer to upgrade facilities and address deficiencies found in an inspection. WHO suspension is in response to the outcomes of its post EUL (emergency use authorisation) inspection held between March 14-22, 2022 and the need to conduct process and facility upgrade to address recently identified GMP (good manufacturing practice) deficiencies.
- 4. Arunabha Ghosh, CEO of the Delhi-based Council for Energy Environment and Water has been named by United Nation in climate team:** Arunabha Ghosh, CEO, of the Delhi-based Council for Energy Environment and Water has been appointed as a member of a high-level group constituted by United Nations Secretary General, Antonio Guterres, to bolster action against stemming global warming. The High-Level Expert Group on the Net-Zero Emissions Commitments of Non-State Entities was constituted on March 31. The 16-member group will be led by Catherine McKenna, former Canadian Minister of Environment and Climate Change.
- 5. FICCI estimate India's GDP growth rate for FY23 at 7.4%:** The Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce & Industry (FICCI) has estimated India's GDP to grow at 7.4 per cent in the financial year 2022-23 (FY23). The Ficci's Economic Outlook Survey was released on April 03, 2022.
- 6. Vikas Kumar named as Managing Director of Delhi Metro Rail Corporation:** Vikas Kumar has been appointed as the new Managing Director of the Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC). He succeeds Mangu Singh, whose tenure ended on March 31, 2022. Kumar is the third managing director of the DMRC after E Sreedharan and Mangu Singh. He will hold the post for a term of five years. DMRC Opened: 24 December 2002.
- 7. India's unemployment rate falls to 7.6% in March from 8.1% in Feb 2022:** As per the data from the Centre for Monitoring Indian Economy (CMIE), the overall unemployment rate in India fell to 7.6 per cent in March 2022. This rate was 8.10 per cent in February 2022. Haryana recorded the highest unemployment rate in March 2022, at 26.7 per cent. It was followed by Rajasthan (25%) and Jammu and Kashmir (25%), Bihar (14.4%), Tripura (14.1%) and West Bengal (5.6%). Chhattisgarh has registered an unemployment rate of 0.6 per cent this March, which is the lowest so far.
- 8. Ministry of Culture launches 'Temple 360' website:** The Minister of State for Culture and External Affairs, Meenakshi Lekhi has launched a website 'Temple 360'. During an event organized by the Ministry of Culture at IGNCA Amphitheatre, Indira Gandhi National Centre of Arts, New Delhi under the aegis of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav. Temple 360 is a digital platform where anyone can visit or do darshan of 12 Jyotirlinga and Char Dham from any location, making everyone's life convenient while also keeping people connected. Temple 360 is a website where one can visit a temple of their choice, anytime and from anywhere from India.

- 9. Crunch Time:** Narendra Modi's National Security Crises" is a new book authored by Dr. Sreeram Chaulia : Meenakshi Lekhi, Minister of State for External Affairs, launched the book at the India International Center in New Delhi, Delhi. The book emphasizes the importance of public trust in the government to secure the country from external security threats. The book examines Prime Minister Modi's decision-making during the China and Pakistan crises.
- 10. Haryana govt launched crop insurance portal of 'Mukhya Mantri Bagwani Bima Yojana':** The Haryana Agriculture Minister J P Dalal launched the portal of Mukha Mantri Bagwani Bima Yojana' with an initial corpus of Rs 10 crore for the scheme. Under this the farmers will be compensated for the damage caused to their crops due to adverse weather and natural calamities.
- 11. Andhra Pradesh's First 'She Auto' Stands Set Up In Tirupati:** In a move to provide safe transport to women and girl students, the police in Andhra Pradesh's Chittoor have set up three 'She Auto' stands, the first of its kind in the state. The three 'She Auto' stands have been set up in RTC Bus Stand, Mahila University, and Ruia Hospital in Tirupati.
- 12. Economic Cooperation and Trade Agreement signed by India-Australia:** India and Australia signed an Economic Cooperation and Trade Agreement (IndAus ECTA), hailing it as a watershed moment and one of the biggest economic doors there is to open in the world. It will provide zero-duty access to 96 per cent of India's exports to Australia, including shipments from key sectors like engineering goods, gems and jewellery, textiles, apparel, and leather.
- In a virtual ceremony attended by Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Prime Minister Scott Morrison, Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal and Australia's Minister for Trade, Tourism and Investment Dan Tehan signed the deal. Under the agreement, Australian wine imports, almonds, lentils, oranges, mandarins, pears, apricots, and strawberries will all benefit from decreased duties. The pact will increase bilateral trade to \$45-50 billion in five years and create over one million jobs in India.
- 13. India-Nepal launch multiple projects, sign four agreements during Modi-Deuba meeting:** Prime Minister Narendra Modi and his Nepalese colleague Sher Bahadur Deuba met in New Delhi, initiating a number of projects and signing four important agreements across a variety of fields. Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. (IOCL) and Nepal Oil Corporation Ltd. signed agreements on Nepal becoming the 105th member of the International Solar Alliance (ISA), technical cooperation in railways, petroleum product delivery, and technical experience sharing in the petroleum sector.
- The two Prime Ministers also observed the first passenger train service between India's Jaynagar and Nepal's Kurtha, the handover of India's Solu corridor transmission project to Nepal, and the progress of 132 health facilities being built across 10 districts in Nepal under a Gol grant.
- The Jaynagar-Kurtha railway line is part of the Jaynagar-Bijalpura-Bardibas train link, which is being built with a grant of INR 548 crore from the Indian government.
- It's a 35-kilometre rail stretch, with 3 kilometres in Bihar, India, and the rest in Nepal.
- After Bhutan, Singapore, and the United Arab Emirates, Nepal is now the fourth country outside of India to accept RuPay. Sher Bahadur Deuba is a long-serving Nepali Congress politician with a political career spanning seven decades.
- 14. National Maritime Day 2022 observed on 5th April:** National Maritime Day in India is observed on 5 April every year. This year is the 59th edition of the National Maritime Day. The Day is celebrated every year day to illustrate the awareness in supporting intercontinental commerce and the global economy as the most well-organized, safe and sound, environmentally responsive approach of transporting goods from one corner to another corner of the world. The theme of the Day is "Sustainable Shipping beyond Covid-19".
- 15. Viktor Orban wins Fourth Term as Prime Minister of Hungary:** Hungarian Prime Minister, Viktor Orban won a fourth successive term in office by a landslide victory in the country's general elections for 2022. His right-wing Fidesz party secured 53.1% of the total 98% of the count complete. Hungary Capital: Budapest, **Currency:** Hungarian forint.

- 16. SEBI has announced an ideathon Manthan to foster innovation in the securities business:** an ideathon to promote innovation, Sebi Chairperson Madhabi Puri Buch said that India is ideally positioned to harness technology in the securities market to give bespoke solutions at a very low cost to individuals across the country.
- 17. RBI fixed WMA limit for States/UTs at Rs 47,010 crores:** The Reserve Bank reduced the Ways and Means Advances (WMA) for states and union territories to Rs 47,010 crore from Rs 51,560 crore on Friday, citing an improvement in the economic scenario. WMAs are short-term loans provided by the RBI to the government to help it deal with any discrepancies between receipts and payments. Due to the uncertainty surrounding COVID-19, the RBI increased the WMA limit for all states to Rs 51,560 crore.
- 18. HDFC Bank declared Best Performing Bank in SHG Linkage by NRLM, Ministry of Rural Development, Govt of India:** At a function organised at Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi, the award was presented by Shri Giriraj Singh, Hon' Minister of Rural Development to Mr. K Venkatesh, Head – Sustainable Livelihood Initiative, HDFC Bank. Notably, HDFC Bank was the only Private Bank to be felicitated for remarkable work in SHGs – by the National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM). Govt of India started National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM) in 2011 as a poverty alleviation project. Implemented by the Government of India under the ministry of Rural Development, NRLM's focus is to promote self-employment and create sustainable livelihood opportunities for the rural poor.
- 19. Delhi government launched scheme to set up 'Hobby Hubs' in government schools:** The Delhi government has set up Hobby Hubs for government schools in Delhi after school hours to promote extra-curricular activities. This project will implement in the single shift government school. A project to set up 'Hobby Hubs' in government schools in Delhi with after-school dance, music, arts and crafts activities during this new academic session is in the works.
- 20. International Day of Sport for Development and Peace 2022:** The International Day of Sport for Development and Peace (IDSDP) is observed globally on April 6. To raise awareness of this potential, 6 April was declared as the International Day of Sport for Development and Peace (IDSDP) by the UN General Assembly. The global theme of IDSDP 2022 is, "Securing a Sustainable and Peaceful Future for All: The Contribution of Sport."
- 21. March 2022:** Govt had collected an all-time high of Rs 1.42 lakh crores as GST : The greatest ever GST was collected in March, which is a very good for the economy. The Goods and Services Tax (GST) collection totaled Rs 1,42,095 crore, breaking the previous high of Rs 1,40,986 crore set in January 2022. The March 2022 revenues are 15% greater than the same month last year and 46% higher than the March 2020 revenues.
- 22. Dharmendra Pradhan releases book titled "Birsa Munda – Janjatiya Nayak":** Union Minister of Education and Skill Development, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan released a book titled "Birsa Munda – Janjatiya Nayak". The book has been written by Prof. Alok Chakrawal, Vice-Chancellor, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh. This book is a comprehensive attempt to bring to the fore the struggle of Bhagwan Birsa Munda and the contribution of forest dwellers in the freedom movement.
- 23. The Environment Minister announces the launch of the 'Prakriti' green initiative:** Union Minister of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Shri Bhupender Yadav, the mascot 'Prakriti' was launched to raise public awareness about small changes that can be made to our lifestyle for a better environment. As well as various green initiatives taken by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change and the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) to ensure effective Plastic Waste Management (PWM) in the country. To combat the problem of plastic pollution, India's Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, pledged to eliminate single-use plastics (SUPs) by 2022. The Union Minister for Environment, Forest & Climate Change also administered the 'Swachh Bharat Harit Bharat Green Pledge' to the crowd, carrying the momentum forward and emphasising the importance of active citizen engagement.
- 24. Gangaur festival celebrated in Rajasthan:** The unmarried women worship Gauri to seek her blessings for finding a good husband. The married women worship her for health, welfare, happy married life, and long life of their husbands. On the first day of Chaitra, the day following Holi, this festival begins and continues for a period of 16 days. Chief Minister of Rajasthan: Ashok Gehlot; Governor: Kalraj Mishra.

- 25. President Ram Nath Kovind visits in Amsterdam and names a new yellow tulip variety 'Maitri':** President Ram Nath Kovind landed in Amsterdam for the final leg of his two-nation journey — his first visit to the Netherlands in 34 years — during which he would hold talks with the Dutch top leadership names a new yellow tulip variety 'Maitri'.
- 26. CM of Uttar Pradesh has launched the 'School Chalo Abhiyan' initiative:** Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath begins the 'School Chalo Abhiyan' in order to secure 100 per cent enrollment in elementary and upper primary schools in Uttar Pradesh. Citing an official announcement, the state government will make an effort to shape the future of primary education and the holistic development of elementary schools.
- 27. Journalist Aarefa Johari awarded Chameli Devi Jain Award 2021:** A journalist from Mumbai, Aarefa Johari was awarded the Chameli Devi Jain Award for an Outstanding Woman Media person 2021. It was announced by the Media Foundation. Aarefa Johari works for 'Scroll. in' in Mumbai, Maharashtra. In 2020, Neetu Singh got this award. She is associated with 'Goan Connection' media house. Jury: Nirupama Subramania, Githa Hariharan and Ashutosh. Chameli Devi Jain Award is the annual prestigious recognition in the field of Journalism for women media persons journalist in India who have reported on themes such as social development, politics, equity, gender justice, health, war and conflict, and consumer values.
- 28. World Health Day 2022 Celebrates on 7th April:** World Health Day is a global health awareness day celebrated on the 7th April every year. Every year, World Health Day focuses on contemporary health issues that require immediate attention, with varied themes. On World Health Day 2022, World Health Organisation will focus global attention on urgent actions needed to keep humans and the planet healthy and foster a movement to create societies focused on well-being. The theme for World Health Day 2022 is 'Our Planet, Our Health'.

- 29. Forbes Billionaires 2022:** The Richest People In The World: The Forbes billionaires 2022 list is out, which compiles the list of the world's richest, who this time was hit by the impact of the Russia-Ukraine conflict, coronavirus pandemic and sluggish markets. Elon Musk, the Tesla and SpaceX founder topped Forbes' list for the first time ever with a net worth of \$219 billion. Elon Musk is leading the Forbes billionaires list with a net worth of \$219 billion, followed by Amazon chief Jeff Bezos at \$171 billion. Ambani ranked at the 10th position on the global list, followed narrowly by fellow industrialist and Adani Group founder Gautam Adani, whose fortune climbed by almost \$40 billion over the past year, to an estimated \$90 billion.
- 30. Ministry of Ayush's Yoga Mahotsav begins at the Red Fort in Delhi:** On World Health Day and the 75th day of the countdown to International Day of Yoga, the Ministry of Ayush is hosting a magnificent programme for the presentation of the Common Yoga Protocol in the backdrop of 15th August Park, Lal Quila, (Red Fort) Delhi. The Ministry of Ayush is the nodal ministry for the International Day of Yoga's commemoration. The primary event of IDY is a Mass Yoga Demonstration, which is led by Prime Minister Modi every year. The IDY-2022 preparations are well underway. Because the 8th International Day of Yoga falls within the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav year, the Ministry advises commemorating IDY at 75 iconic locations around the country. This countdown effort is already underway, and IDY-2022 observation is gathering traction.
- 31. ADB Projects India's economy to grow by 7.5% in FY23:** Asian Development Bank projected a 7 per cent collective growth for South Asian economies in 2022 with the subregion's largest economy India growing by 7.5 per cent in the current fiscal year before picking up to eight per cent the next year.
- 32. Union Bank launches super-app UnionNXT and digital project SAMBHAV:** Union Bank of India has launched its super-app named UnionNXT and digital transformation project SAMBHAV, with an investment outlay of around Rs 1,000 crore for the current financial year 2022-23 (FY23). The public sector lender expects recovery from the spending in two years and aims to have 50 per cent of business originating on the digital platform by 2025.
- 33. One Health' pilot project launched by Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying:** The Government of India's Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying (DAHD) has launched a pilot project in Uttarakhand to implement the One Health Framework through the One Health Support Unit.
- 34. Sarhul Festival 2022 celebrated in Jharkhand :** Sarhul is the festival of the New Year celebrated in the state of Jharkhand by the tribal communities as part of the local Sama religion. It is celebrated in the Hindu month of

- 36. Karnataka establishes cooperative bank for milk producers:** Karnataka Chief Minister, Basavaraj Bommai Establishing the 'Nandini Ksheera Samridhi Cooperative Bank' is a revolutionary initiative, which will provide greater financial strength for the milk producers. Karnataka is the only state in the country to set up an exclusive bank for milk producers. Union Home Minister Amit Shah launched the logo of "Nandini Ksheera Samurdhi Sahakar Bank". Capital: Bengaluru, Chief Minister: Basavaraj S Bommai, Governor: Thawar Chand Gehlot.
- 37. Gujarat Govt to receive Rs 7,500 Cr Loan from World Bank, AIIB:** The World Bank and the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) stated that the Gujarat government's Mission School of Excellence project, which aims to improve education quality in the state, will receive a loan worth Rs 7,500 crore. The state government will spend Rs 10,000 crore over the next five years on the Mission School of Excellence initiative, which would cover all 35,133 government and 5,847 grant-in-aid schools in the state. - 38. NCW Launches Anti-Human Trafficking Cell:** The National Commission for Women launched an Anti-Human Trafficking Cell to improve effectiveness in tackling cases of human trafficking, raising awareness among women and girls, capacity building and training of Anti Trafficking Units and increasing responsiveness of law enforcement agencies. Formed: 1992, Headquarters: New Delhi, executive: Laliitha Kumaramangalam.
- 39. Madhya Pradesh government launched Mukhyamantri Udyam Kranti Yojana:** Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh, Shivraj Singh Chouhan will launch the Udyam Kranti Yojana. According to officials, the MP Mukhyamantri Udyam Kranti plan was announced for the first time in November 2021, as per the MSME department's gazette announcement, but it was never executed. Loans ranging from Rs. 1 lakh to Rs. 50 lakh would be offered to youth under this scheme for self-employment.
- 40. Ministry of Information and Broadcasting establishes the AVGC Promotion Task Force:** An animation, visual effects, gaming, and comics (AVGC) promotion task group has been established by the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting. The task force, which will be led by the I&B Secretary, will produce its first action plan within 90 days. Industry, academics, and state governments are all represented.
- 41. 'Tomb of Sand' becomes first Hindi novel to get shortlisted for International Booker Prize:** In the history of the International Booker Prize, the novel 'Tomb of Sand', authored by Geetanjali Shree, has become the first Hindi language work of fiction to be shortlisted for the prestigious literary prize. The novel has been translated into English by Daisy Rockwell. The book Tomb of Sand will compete with five other novels from around the world. The literary prize comes with a cash award of 50,000 pounds, which is split equally between the author and translator.
- 42. AAI launches 'AVSAR' Scheme to provide platform to SHGs:** The Airport Authority of India (AAI) has launched an initiative "AVSAR" to encourage the talent of women, artisans and craftsmen and provide them with the right opportunities. AVSAR stands for 'Airport as Venue for Skilled Artisans Of The Region'. Under "AVSAR" (Airport as Venue for Skilled Artisans Of The Region), which is an initiative of AAI, an opportunity to help the indigent to mobilize their households into functionally effective self-earned groups for self-reliance and self-dependence, has been provided
- 43. Cabinet gives approval to extension of AIM till March Next year:** The Union Cabinet approved the continuation of the Atal Innovation Mission (AIM) until March 2023. AIM's stated goals include developing 10,000
