- 1. Kerala govt to launch 'Shaili App' for diagnosing, and controlling lifestyle diseases:** The government of Kerala is set to launch an Android App 'Shaili', aimed at diagnosing and controlling lifestyle diseases among the people in the state of Kerala. The app has been set up as part of the population-based screening project launched by the Health Department under the Nava Kerala Karma plan. Capital: Thiruvananthapuram, Governor: Arif Mohammad Khan, Chief Minister: Pinarayi Vijayan.
- 2. A book 'INDO-PAK WAR 1971- Reminiscences of Air Warriors' released by Rajnath Singh:** Defence Minister Rajnath Singh has released a book titled 'INDO-PAK WAR 1971- Reminiscences of Air Warriors' at the 37th Air Chief Marshal PC Lal Memorial Lecture organised by the Air Force Association in New Delhi, Delhi. The book was edited by Air Marshal Jagjeet Singh and Group Captain Shalendra Mohan. The book features 50 Swarnim articles written by veterans narrating their experiences in detail.
- 3. Adani Wilmar became India's largest FMCG company surpassing HUL:** Adani Wilmar Limited became the largest Fast Moving Consumer Goods Company (FMCG) in India beating Hindustan Unilever Limited (HUL), after the announcement of its Quarter Four results for the financial year 2022 (Q4FY2022). AWL has reported total operating revenue of Rs 54,214 crore in the Financial Year 2022 whereas HUL reported a revenue of Rs 51,468 crore in the Financial Year (FY) 2021-22 Adani Group Founded: 1988; Headquarters: Ahmedabad, Gujarat, Chairman: Gautam Adani, Managing Director: Rajesh Adani.
- 4. Supreme Court gets 2 new judges to regain full strength of 34:** The Union government of India has notified the appointment of Justice Sudhanshu Dhulia, the chief justice of Gauhati High Court, and Justice Jamshed Burjor Pardiwala, a judge of the Gujarat High Court, as judges of the Supreme Court. The Collegium headed by Chief Justice of India NV Ramana had recommended their names for appointment on May 5. The other members of the Collegium are Justices UU Lalit, AM Khanwilkar, DY Chandrachud and L Nageswara Rao. At present, the Supreme Court has a strength of 32 judges as against a sanctioned strength of 34 judges. The fresh appointments will help regain the 34-judge strength, but two other vacancies will arise soon with Justice Vineet Saran set to retire on May 10 and Justice Nageswara Rao on June 7.
- 5. Nepal's Kami Rita Sherpa climbs Mount Everest for 26th time:** Nepal's legendary climber Kami Rita Sherpa has climbed Mt Everest, the tallest peak in the world for the 26th time to set a new world record. Leading an 11-member rope fixing team, Kami Rita & his team reached the summit, breaking his own previous world record.
- 6. Utkarsh Mahotsav organized by Central Sanskrit University begins:** A three-day Utkarsh Mahotsav is being organized by Central Sanskrit University in New Delhi. The objective behind organising the Utkarsh Mahotsav is to promote the Sanskrit language across the country and beyond. The main theme of this Mahotsav is 'Global Orientation of Sanskrit Studies in the New Educational Era'.
- 7. Priyanka Mohite becomes first Indian woman to climb five peaks above 8,000 metres:** Priyanka Mohite from Maharashtra's Satara district has become the first Indian woman to climb five peaks above 8000 metres. Priyanka achieved the milestone after climbing Mount Kanchenjunga. The 30-year-old climbed the third highest peak on Earth.
- 8. Indian Bank Launched Digital Broking Solution 'E-Broking':** Indian Bank, a public sector bank, has introduced its digital broking solution – 'E- Broking', as a strategic move toward comprehensive digitalisation of its customer products. E-Broking, an instant and paperless demat & trading account opening service, is now available

through the bank's mobile banking app, IndOASIS. MD & CEO: Shanti Lal Jain, Establishment: August 15, 1907, Headquarters: Chennai, Tamil Nadu, Tagline: Taking Banking Technology To The Common Man.

- 9. New Electoral Map released for Jammu and Kashmir: A three-member Delimitation Commission redrawing the electoral map of Jammu and Kashmir allotted 47 Assembly seats for Kashmir division and 43 for Jammu in its final decision submitted barely a day before its two-year term was to end. After the panel, led by retired Supreme Court judge Ranjana Prakash Desai, approved the final verdict, giving Jammu six additional seats and Kashmir one more, a gazette notification was released. The Commission, which includes ex-officio members Chief Election Commissioner Sushil Chandra and Jammu and Kashmir Election Commissioner K K Sharma. The Union Territory has five Parliamentary constituencies, each with 18 Assembly seats.**
- 10. Alkesh Kumar Sharma appointed as Ministry of Electronics and IT's Secretary:** Alkesh Kumar Sharma, a senior IAS officer, has been named Secretary of the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY). He was previously the Cabinet Secretariat's secretary (Coordination). Minister for Railways, Communications, Electronics & Information Technology: Shri Ashwini Vaishnaw.
- 11. Reliance became 1st Indian company to cross USD 100 bn annual revenue: Reliance Industries become the first Indian company to record annual revenue of more than a whopping \$100 billion. The company has recorded a 22.5% rise in net profit for the quarter ended March 2022. Reliance has recorded strong growth in retail, digital services, and the oil & gas business. CEO: Mukesh Ambani (31 Jul 2002-) Founder: Dhirubhai Ambani, Founded: 8 May 1973, Maharashtra;**
- 12. Delhi govt will provide "Mukhyamantri Muft Sewer Connection Yojana": Delhi govt will provide free sewer connections under the "Mukhyamantri Muft Sewer Connection Yojana". 25,000 households located in East Delhi will be provided with free sewer connections under the 'Mukhyamantri Muft Sewer Connection Yojana.'**
- 13. Tamil Nadu govt announced breakfast scheme for primary school students: Tamil Nadu chief minister, MK Stalin has announced that all government primary school students from 1st to 5th standards will be provided nutritious breakfast on all working days. Tamil Nadu is set to become the first state to offer breakfast along with midday meals.**
- 14. Guruswamy Krishnamoorthy receives British Honour 'MBE' For His Service During the COVID-19 Pandemic:** Guruswamy Krishnamoorthy, CEO of Penlon, a world-class British medical technology firm, is likely to receive The Most Excellent Order of the British Empire (Civil Division) Award 2022 – Honorary Member of the Order of the British Empire (MBE) recognition from the Queen at Buckingham Palace, London, UK. Guruswamy Krishnamoorthy hails from Madurai, Tamil Nadu, India. The British Honorary Awards are awarded twice a year, first during the new year and again in June, on the date of the Queen's official birthday.
- 15. Lokpal to have Permanent Office at World Trade Centre Building in Delhi: The Lokpal of India will finally move into a swanky office at World Trade Centre in south Delhi's Nauroji Nagar, four years after being appointed as the country's first anti-corruption ombudsman to investigate complaints against public functionaries, including the Prime Minister, and almost a decade after the Act was passed by Parliament. On March 19, 2019, Justice Pinaki Chandra Ghosh, along with eight other members, was appointed as India's first Lokpal. The appointment came five years after the Lokpal and Lokayukta Act of 2013 was passed to probe accusations of corruption. The Lokpal and Lokayukta Act, which was passed in 2013 to investigate charges of corruption against certain types of public workers, was made five years later.**
- 16. Padma Vibhushan Pandit Shivkumar Sharma Passes Away:** Indian music composer and santoor player, Pandit Shivkumar Sharma passed away at the age of 84. He had been suffering from kidney-related issues for the last six

months and was on dialysis. Sharma received the prestigious Padma Shri in 1991, and the Padma Vibhushan in 2001.

17. National Technology Day 2022 Observed on 11th May: National Technology Day is observed every year on 11th May across the country. National Technology Day has significant historical importance in India. The theme for National Technology Day 2022 is "Integrated Approach in Science and technology for sustainable future". The theme was launched by Union Minister Jitendra Singh.

18. Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister launched Ladli Laxmi scheme 2.0: Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister, Shivraj Singh Chouhan launched the second phase of the Ladli Laxmi scheme (Ladli Laxmi scheme-2.0). The scheme is an innovative initiative to encourage girl children to pursue higher education and make them self-dependent. Ladli Laxmi scheme is a comprehensive scheme that offers financial assistance for a girl from birth until her marriage in instalments.

19. On closing day of LIC IPO, the total subscription at 2.95 times: On the final day of bidding, the insurance behemoth Life Insurance Corporation of India's (LIC) IPO, the country's largest ever, witnessed 2.95 times greater demand than the shares on sale, generating bids totalling Rs 43,933 crore. The Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC) is an Indian statutory insurance and investment company with its headquarters in Mumbai. Life Insurance Corporation of India was founded on September 1, 1956. The IPO received 7.33 million retail investor applications, breaking the previous record of 4.8 million set by Reliance Power in 2008.

20. NSO survey: Unemployment rate of India at 8.7% in October-December 2021: The National Statistical Office (NSO) data has revealed that the unemployment rate for people above 15 years in urban areas slipped from 10.3% to 8.7% between October and December 2021. Joblessness or unemployment rate (UR) is defined as the percentage of unemployed persons in the labour force.

21. WEF to focus on innovative technology to assist small and marginal farmers: The World Economic Forum (WEF), in collaboration with the government's research institute Niti Aayog, is focusing on how to better employ emerging technologies like artificial intelligence (AI), the Internet of Things (IoT), blockchain, and drones to aid farmers, especially small and marginal farmers.

22. Sedition Law in India: Sedition is defined in Section 124A of the Indian Penal Code as an offence committed when a person, through words, whether spoken or written, signs, or visible representation, or otherwise, incites or seeks to incite hatred or contempt for the government constituted by law in India. Disaffection encompasses all feelings of hostility and disloyalty. The penalty under Section 124A can vary from a three-year jail sentence to a life sentence, plus a fine. The Supreme Court, in determining the legality of Section 124A of the Indian Penal Code, has raised the bar for the government to invoke the provision, saying that "it will be desirable not to proceed" with the charge of sedition until the government evaluates the provision. The statute of sedition is effectively suspended until the court hears the matter again in July.

23. HDFC Bank Launches 'Xpress Car Loan' Industry First Digital New Car Loan: HDFC Bank, a private sector lender, has introduced 30-minute 'Xpress Car Loans', an end-to-end digital new car loan solution for both existing and non-customers. The bank has integrated its lending application with automobile dealers throughout India. It is the industry's first automotive lending experience, and it is expected to change the way automobile financing is done in India. Establishment: 1994, Headquarters: Mumbai, Maharashtra, Tagline: We Understand Your World.

24. NITI Aayog's AIM has released the AIM-PRIME Playbook to assist academics: The AIM-PRIME Playbook was launched at the Dr. Ambedkar International Center in New Delhi. The AIM-PRIME programme, a national project of the Atal Innovation Mission, NITI Aayog, is being executed by Venture Center, Pune, with support from

the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation and the Office of Principal Scientific Advisor. Following the launch, the dignitaries attended a startup display where they engaged with selected cohort start-ups and incubators.

- 25. LS Speaker Om Birla launches One of its Kind 'Kalam Website':** Lok Sabha (LS) Speaker, Om Birla has launched the one-of-its-kind literary initiative Kalam website of the Prabha Khaitan Foundation (PKF) to support and encourage vernacular literature. The aim of Kalam is to popularize Hindi literature and provide a platform for veteran and young authors and poets to talk about their writings and love for vernacular literature.
- 26. In Delhi, India's first Khadi Centre of Excellence will open:** The Ministry of MSME has created a Centre for Experimentation, Innovation, and Design for the Khadi Village and Industries Commission (KVIC) with the goal of empowering Khadi Institutions across the country. The Center's mission is to create clothing, home goods, and fashion accessories that appeal to individuals of all ages. The goal of the Khadi Centre of Excellence (CoEK) is to make Khadi a worldwide, classic, and value-driven brand.
- 27. International Day of Plant Health observed on 12th May 2022:** The United Nations designated 12 May the International Day of Plant Health (IDPH) to raise global awareness on how protecting plant health can help end hunger, reduce poverty, protect biodiversity and the environment, and boost economic development. The United Nations declared 2020 as the International Year of Plant Health (IYPH).
- 28. International Nurses Day 2022 Observed on 12th May:** May 12 is observed as International Nurses' Day across the world to honour the services of nurses. The theme for this year's Nurses' Day is "Nurses: A Voice to Lead – Invest in Nursing and respect rights to secure global health". Many hospitals across the world are observing International Nurses Week from May 6 to 12.
- 29. World's oldest chess grandmaster Yuri Averbakh passes away:** Russian chess grandmaster, Yuri Averbakh who was among the world's best players for a decade, trained world champions and was the last surviving participant in one of the greatest competitions in history, has died in Moscow at 100. He won the Moscow Championship in 1949 and earned the Grandmaster title in 1952. In 1954, he became the champion of the USSR. He also chaired the Chess Federation of the USSR from 1972 to 1977.
- 30. VP Venkaiah Naidu releases 'Modi @20: Dreams Meeting Delivery' book:** Vice President M Venkaiah Naidu has released the book "Modi@20 Dreams Meet Delivery" in New Delhi. The book presents different facets of the distinct thought process, the pioneering, pro-active approach and the quintessential, transformational leadership style that Narendrabhai Modi has come to be so closely identified with.
- 31. Sri Lanka's Prime Minister resigned after weeks of Protest:** Sri Lankan prime minister Mahindra Rajapaksa resigned from his position on 9th May 2022. He sent his resignation letter to the president of Sri Lanka Gotabaya Rajapaksa. The curfew was imposed after the clash between the supporters and anti-government demonstrators. What is behind Sri Lanka's economic crisis? Ans. The main reason for Sri Lanka's economic crisis is prime minister Mahendra rajpaksha according to the protester of the government. According to the protesters, rajpaksha is the main reason who post Sri Lanka towards an economic crisis to mishandling the economy.
- 32. Mamata Banerjee received Special Bangla Academy Award:** West Bengal Chief Minister, Mamata Banerjee received the Bangla Academy Award for her "relentless literary pursuit". The award, introduced this year by Sahitya Academy, was presented to Banerjee for her book "Kabita Bitan", which pays tribute to the best writers of West Bengal. Mamata Banerjee's 'Kabita Bitan' was launched at the 2020 Kolkata Book Fair. The book contains 946 poems written by the TMC supremo.

- 33. Mumbai Gets India's First EV Charging Station Powered by bio-gas: India's first EV charging station powered by bio-gas** was inaugurated in Mumbai, Maharashtra. This station will be expected to generate 220 units of electricity from food waste collected from its nearby areas, mostly from bulk generators like hotels and offices.
- 34. South Korea becomes 1st Asian country join NATO Cyber Defence Group: South Korea became the first Asian country** join in North Atlantic Treaty Organization Cooperative Cyber Defence Centre of Excellence. South Korea's National Intelligence Service (NIS) is joined as a contributing participant in the NATO Cooperative Cyber Defence Centre of Excellence. Now, the total NATO CCDCOE has 32 countries as its official members which include 27 NATO member countries and 5 non-NATO states as contributing participants.
- 35. Leonid Kravchuk, the first president of Independent Ukraine Passes Away: Leonid Kravchuk, a former communist** who helped sign the Soviet Union's death warrant and then served as the first president of independent Ukraine, passed away at the age of 88. Capital: Kyiv, Currency: Ukrainian hryvnia, President: Volodymyr Zelenskyy, Prime minister: Denys Shmyhal.
- 36. Rajiv Kumar appointed as next Chief Election Commissioner:** Election Commissioner Rajiv Kumar was appointed as the next chief election commissioner. He will assume charge on May 15 after incumbent Sushil Chandra demits office on May 14, a notification issued by the Law Ministry said. In pursuance of clause (2) of Article 324 of the Constitution, the President appointed Shri Rajiv Kumar as the Chief Election Commissioner with effect from the 15th of May 2022. Election Commission of India Formed: 25 January 1950.
- 37. Deepika Padukone named as 1st Indian brand ambassador of Louis Vuitton: Actress Deepika Padukone** has become the first-ever Indian brand ambassador of luxury brand Louis Vuitton. The news was announced by the French brand. The brand unveiled the role of a 36-year-old Bollywood actress during their new handbag campaign. She has also received the first Time 100 Impact Awards for creating awareness about mental health.
- 38. ICICI Bank and Santander UK Partner for business ease between India and UK: ICICI Bank, one of India's largest** private sector banks, established a partnership with Santander Bank in the United Kingdom, aimed at making banking easier for businesses operating in both countries. The ICICI and Santander UK Plc signed a MoU in Mumbai to build a framework of partnership between the banks to satisfy the financial service needs of corporate clients operating along the India-UK corridor.
- 39. Haryana launched 'Chaar-Bijae Yojana' for fodder cultivating farmers: Haryana Agriculture Minister, Jai Parkash Dalal** launched the 'Chaar – Bijae Yojana', a scheme launched to provide financial assistance of Rs 10,000 per acre (Upto 10 acres) to farmers cultivating and supplying fodder to Gaushalas (Cowsheds). The rationale behind the scheme is to address the State's fodder shortage and rising stray cattle. The Subsidy will be directly credited to the farmer's account under Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT).
- 40. UNDP and Agriculture Ministry signs MoU for Credit Strategic Partnership: The Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare (MoA&FW), the Government of India, and the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP)** have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) under which UNDP will provide technical assistance to the Centre's ambitious Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) and Kisan Credit Card – Modified Interest Subvention Scheme.
- 41. World Migratory Bird Day 2022 observed on 14th May: World Migratory Bird Day is marked twice a year** since its inauguration in 2006. International Migratory Bird Day will be celebrated on 14 May and 8 October 2022. The theme for World Migratory Bird Day 2022 is light pollution.
- 42. Vietnam opens world's longest glass-bottomed bridge: World's Largest Glass Bottom Bridge was opened** in Vietnam. It is called Vietnam's Bach Long pedestrian bridge, which is 632m (2,073ft) long and located 150m

Sanjiv Bajaj appointed as President of Confederation of Indian Industry: Chairman of Bajaj Finserv Limited, Sanjiv Bajaj has assumed the office of Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) President for the year 2022-23 after replacing the CEO of Tata Steel, TV Narendran. Confederation of Indian Industry Founded: 1895, Headquarters: New Delhi, India.

44. Morgan Stanley cuts India's FY23 growth forecast to 7.6%: Morgan Stanley downgraded India's growth forecast to 7.6% from 7.9% for FY2023 amid a slowdown in global growth, higher commodity prices and risk aversion in global capital markets.

45. Haryana Govt Launches 'e-Adhigam' Scheme to distribute tablets to students: The Haryana State Government launches the 'e-Adhigam' scheme under which nearly 3 lakh students will be receiving tablet computers to aid their online education. The state government has planned to provide the gadget to five lakh students. Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar launched the Advance Digital Haryana Initiative of Government with Adaptive Modules (Adigham) scheme at Maharishi Dayanand University in Rohtak, Haryana.
