- 1. International Day for the Fight against Illegal, Unreported and Unregulated Fishing 2022:** International Day for the Fight against Illegal, Unreported and Unregulated Fishing is organized every year on 5th June. Food and Agriculture Organization Headquarters: Rome, Italy. Established: 16 October 1945.
- 2. Russian Language Day 2022 Observed on 6th June:** Russian Language Day 2022 Observed on 6th June. all six official languages of the UN: English, Arabic, Spanish, Chinese, Russian and French.
- 3. World Food Safety Day 2022 Observed on 7th June:** World Food Safety Day is celebrated globally on June 7 every year as per the World Health Organization (WHO). World Food Safety Day aims to transform food systems to deliver better health sustainably and prevent foodborne diseases. This year, the theme is 'Safer food, better health'. WHO also launched a campaign to inspire global participation. **WHO Headquarters: Geneva, Founded: 7 April 1948.**
- 4. World Oceans Day 2022 observed on 8th June:** The World Oceans Day is celebrated on June 8 every year across the globe. The day is commemorated to remind people of the importance of the oceans and the major role they play in everyday life. Revitalization: collective action for the ocean" is the theme for World Oceans Day 2022. The concept of World Oceans Day was first proposed by the UN in 1992 at the Earth Summit in Rio de Janeiro.
- 5. World Brain tumour Day 2022 observed on 8th June:** World Brain Tumour Day is observed every year on 8 June with an aim to create awareness about brain tumours. It is a mass or growth of abnormal cells in your brain. There are two types of brain tumors, noncancerous (benign), and cancerous (malignant). In 2022, the theme of World Tumor Day is 'Together We Are Stronger'.
- 6. World Day Against Child Labour 2022 observed on 12th June:** 12 June marks the World Day Against Child Labour under the theme "Universal Social Protection to End Child Labour." The International Labour Organization (ILO) launched the World Day Against Child Labour in 2002 to focus attention on the worldwide extent of kid labour and therefore the action and efforts needed to eliminate it. **Headquarters ILO: Geneva, Switzerland, President : Guy Ryder, Founded: 1919.**
- 7. NABARD Chairman launches My Pad My Right programme in Leh:** National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD), Chairman Dr GR Chintala has launched "My Pad My Right programme", in Leh. This will help women to participate in country's economic development. Under this unique project, award winning sanitary pad making machines will be installed through the network of self help groups. **Formation: July 12, 1982, NABARD Headquarters: Mumbai, Chairman: Govinda Rajulu Chintala**
- 8. A Manimekhalai appointed as MD of Union Bank:** The government has appointed A Manimekhalai as managing director of Union Bank of India. Canara Bank executive director Manimekhalai replaced Rajkiran Rai G, who retired on May 31 after a five-year stint. With her assuming the charge, Manimekhalai becomes the first woman managing director of Union Bank of India. **Headquarters: Mumbai, Founded: 11 November 1919.**
- 9. Swarup Kumar Saha appointed as head of Punjab & Sind Bank:** The government has appointed Swarup Kumar Saha as head of Punjab & Sind Bank. Saha, who is the executive director of Punjab National Bank (PNB), replaced S Krishnan, who also superannuated on May 31. **Headquarters: New Delhi, Founded: 24 June 1908.**

- 13. THE Asia University Rankings 2022-4 Indian institutions in top 100:** Times Higher Education Asia University Rankings 2022 was released by the Times Higher Education (THE). The Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bangalore continued to be the best institute of the country. It ranked at 42nd place.

- 14. Kiya.ai launches India's first banking metaverse Kiyaverse:** Kiya.ai, a digital solutions provider serving financial institutions and governments globally, announced the launch of India's first-ever banking metaverse "Kiyaverse". In the first phase, Kiyaverse will allow banks to extend their own metaverse for clients, partners, and employees, through services that will include Relationship Manager & Peer Avatars and Robo-advisors. **Kiya.ai MD and CEO: Rajesh Mirjankar, Kiya.ai HQ: Mumbai.**
- 15. NATO conducts naval exercises in Baltic Sea with NATO allies and partners:** U.S.-led naval exercise in the Baltic Sea, more than 7,000 sailors, airmen, and marines from 16 nations, including two aspiring NATO members, Finland and Sweden, began a nearly two-week. BALTOPS, an annual naval exercise that began in 1972, is not performed in response to any specific danger.

- 16. Abania Elects General Major Bajram Begaj as New President:** Albania's parliament has elected a top military official, General Major Bajram Begaj as its new president after no candidates were nominated in three rounds of voting. The outgoing President Ilir Meta signed the decree on Begaj's dismissal as Chief of General Staff of the AAF. Albania Capital: Tirana, Currency: Albanian lek, Albania Prime Minister: Edi Rama.
- 17. Blue Duke declared as the State Butterfly of Sikkim:** Chief Minister P.S. Golay, during the World Environment Day celebrations, declared Blue Duke as the State Butterfly of Sikkim. **Capital: Gangtok, Sikkim Governor: Ganga Prasad, Chief minister: PS Golay.**
- 18. Har Time EMI on Time' is a financial education initiative launched by Bajaj Finance:** Bajaj Finance Limited, the lending arm of Bajaj Finserv Limited, a global financial services conglomerate, has launched Har Time EMI On Time, a digital campaign to raise awareness about the importance and advantages of good financial habits for a secure financial future.
- 19. Andhra Pradesh launched '14400 app' to report corrupt officials:** Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Jagan Mohan Reddy launched the '14400' app. This app has been developed by Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB). This app is customized for the people to register corruption-related complaints against the officials in the state. A complaint can be filed through a toll-free number 14400. **Governor: Biswabhusan Harichandan, Chief minister: Y. S. Jaganmohan Reddy.**
- 20. India successfully tested nuclear- capable Agni-4 ballistic missile in Odisha:** India has successfully executed a nuclear- capable Agni-4 ballistic missile from APJ Abdul Kalam Island in Odisha. The missile has the range of around 4,000 kilometres. Earlier, India successfully test-fired an extended range version of the BrahMos supersonic cruise missile from a Sukhoi fighter jet. It was the first launch of the extended range version of the BrahMos missile from a Su-30MKI aircraft.
- 21. Indian Army Contingent participates in the "Khaan Quest 2022" exercise:** Indian Army participates in a multinational exercise "Ex Khaan Quest 2022" where 16 other countries also took part in Mongolia. President of Mongolia, Ukhnaagiin Khurelsukh inaugurated the Exercise as the host. Indian Army is represented by a contingent from the LADAKH SCOUTS. The 14-day exercise is aimed at enhancing interoperability, building military to military relationships, developing peace support operations and military readiness among participating nations. **Army Founded: 1 April 1895, Headquarters: New Delhi, Chief of the Army Staff: Manoj Pande, Motto: Service Before Self.**
- 22. India ranked worst in the world in terms of environmental performance in 2022:** In the 2022 Environment Performance Index (EPI), an analysis by Yale and Columbia University researchers that gives a data-driven evaluation of the situation of sustainability around the world, India came in last out of 180 countries. Climate change, environmental public health, and biodiversity are among the 40 performance factors used by the EPI to rank 180 nations. With an overall score of 18.9, India came in last, while Denmark came in first as the world's most sustainable country.
- 23. PM Modi launches new series of coins with Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav design:** Prime Minister Narendra Modi has launched a special series of coins that are also 'visually impaired friendly'. The coins of Re 1, Rs 2, 5, 10 and 20 denominations will have the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM) design. They are not commemorative coins and will be part of circulation.
- 24. Alok Kumar Choudhary takes charge as MD of SBI:** Alok Kumar Choudhary has taken charge as the new Managing Director (MD) of State Bank of India (SBI). His appointment comes in the wake of the

superannuation of Ashwani Bhatia as Managing Director on May 31, 2022. **Bank of India Founded: 1 July 1955, Headquarters: Mumbai, Chairman: Dinesh Kumar Khara.**

- 25. World Bank cuts India GDP forecast to 7.5%:** The World Bank has slashed its growth forecast for India for the current financial year to 7.5 percent, a hefty 1.2 percentage points down from its previous forecast of 8.7 percent.
- 26. Sital Sasthi' festival being celebrated in Odisha:** Sital Sasthi is a sacred Hindu festival is being celebrated in Odisha. This week-long special festival highlights the marriage of Lord Shiva and Goddess Parvati. According to the Hindu calendar, Sital Sasthi is observed on the sixth day of the Jyestha month during the Shukla Paksha. Capital: Bhubaneswar, Odisha Governor: Ganeshi Lal, Chief Minister: Naveen Patnaik.
- 27. Union Health Minister releases FSSAI's 4th State Food Safety Index on World Food Safety Day:** Tamil Nadu was the highest-ranking state among the major states this year, followed by Gujarat and Maharashtra. Goa, on the other hand, was first among the smallest states, followed by Manipur and Sikkim. Jammu & Kashmir, Delhi, and Chandigarh ranked top, second, and third among the UTs, respectively.
- 28. Shreyas G Hosur became 1st Indian Railways officer to complete gruelling 'Ironman' Triathlon:** Creating a history of sorts, Shreyas G. Hosur, became the first officer from the Indian Railways to complete the gruelling 'Ironman' Triathlon, considered to be the toughest single-day sports event in the world. This event includes 3.8 km of swimming, 180 km of cycling and 42.2 km of running. He completed the event in 13 hours and 26 minutes in Hamburg, Germany.
- 29. Amit Shah inaugurates new building of National Tribal Research Institute in New Delhi:** Union Home and Cooperation Minister, Amit Shah has inaugurated the newly built National Tribal Research Institute (NTRI) in New Delhi. This institute is to promote and preserve the tribal heritage and culture and the nerve centre of tribal research issues and matters in academic, executive and legislative fields.
- 30. Mahatma Gandhi Setu:** Mahatma Gandhi Setu is also called Gandhi Setu or Ganga Setu. The bridge is situated over the Ganga River in Bihar, India. The Mahatma Gandhi Setu connects Patna from the south and Hajipur from the north of Bihar. The length of Mahatma Gandhi Setu is 5,750m (18,860) making it the third-longest bridge in India. In May 1982, the bridge was inaugurated by the then Prime minister Ms. Indira Gandhi, from Hajipur, Bihar. The construction of the bridge was approved by the Central Government in 1969 and was built by Gammon India Limited. It took 10 years to build the Mahatma Gandhi Setu which was from 1972-to 1982.
- 31. Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna Award:** Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna Award was introduced in the year 1991-1992, from 2021, the award is known as Major Dhyan Chand Khel Ratna Award. The Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna Award is the highest in sports given in India. The ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports presents the Khel Ratna award.
- This is awarded annually and it is named after the former Prime minister of India, Mr. Rajiv Gandhi, who served the nation from 1984 to 1989. The award consists of a medallion, a certificate, and a cash prize of Rs. 25 lakh. The Chief Minister of Rajasthan Ashok Gehlot announced that the state government is going to introduce the Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna Award to state sportspeople. He also said that the Rajiv Gandhi Rural Olympics will be held on 29th August 2022.
- 32. Ramkrishna Mukavilli becomes the first Indian to recognized by United Nations Global Compact as Global SDG Pioneer:** For the first time in the world, an Indian (Ramkrishna Mukavilli) has been named a

Global Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) Pioneer for Water Stewardship by the United Nations Global Compact (UNGC). The United Nations Global Compact has named ten new SDG Pioneers, who are corporate leaders who are excelling in advancing the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) by implementing the UN Global Compact Ten Principles on human rights, environment, labour, and anti-corruption.

- 33. WhatsApp launched SMBSaathi Utsav to support small businesses:** Whatsapp launched SMBSaathi Utsav initiative which aims to support small businesses by helping them to adopt digital mediums like Whatsapp Business App.
- 34. Mithali Raj announced retirement from International cricket:** Indian women's cricket team captain, Mithali Raj (39 years old), hailing from Jodhpur, Rajasthan, announced her retirement from all forms of International cricket. She is the only female cricketer to reach the 7,000-run mark. She holds the record for most runs in Women's ODI. The government of India(GoI) honoured her with Arjuna Award in 2003 for her outstanding achievement in cricket and the Major Dhyan Chand Khel Ratna Award in 2021. GoI honoured her with Padma Shri in 2015 for her contribution to sports.
- 35. OECD slashes India's GDP growth forecast to 6.9% for FY23:** The Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) has forecast India's GDP growth at 6.9 per cent for FY23. This is below the Reserve Bank of India's estimate of a 7.2% rise.
- 36. India's Krishna Srinivasan to head IMF's Asia-Pacific dept:** International Monetary Fund, Managing Director Kristalina Georgieva has announced the appointment of Indian national Krishna Srinivasan as director of the Asia and Pacific Department (APD) from June 22. Srinivasan will succeed Changyong Rhee whose retirement from the Fund was announced on March 23. IMF Formation: 27 December 1945; IMF Headquarters: Washington, D.C., United States; Member Countries: 190; MD: Kristalina Georgieva.
- 37. Assam celebrates Baikho festival for good harvest and rain:** The Baikho festival is celebrated in the state of Assam, which is called as gateway to northeast India. It is celebrated by Rabha tribes of India. This is a celebration of good harvest. Capital: Dispur, Chief Minister: Himanta Biswa Sarma, Governor: Jagdish Mukhi.
- 38. World's First 'Right To Repair' Law For Digital Electronics Passed by New York Legislature:** New York state legislature is a world first, to pass the law for Digital Electronics. The "right to repair" bill enacted by the requiring digital electronics makers to make parts, tools, information, and software available to customers and independent repair businesses. After government pressure to safeguard customers' rights to repair and refurbish their purchased products, the "Fair Repair Act" was enacted.
- 39. Union Ministers Dharmendra Pradhan released books titled 'Loktantra ke Swar' & 'The Republican Ethic':** Union Education and Skill Development & Entrepreneurship Minister, Dharmendra Pradhan along with Union Minister for Information & Broadcasting and Sports Anurag Thakur released books 'Loktantra ke Swar' and 'The Republican Ethic, having selected speeches of the President of India Ram Nath Kovind. The compilation includes speeches on a wide range of subjects.
- 40. Himachal Pradesh becomes the first Indian state to approve a policy for drones:** The Himachal Pradesh government gave nod to a drone policy as it seeks to enable the use of drones and similar technology for different public services in the hill state. The 'Himachal Pradesh Drone Policy 2022' was approved by the chief minister Jai Ram Thakur. The policy envisions creating a holistic drone ecosystem built upon the foundation of Governance and Reforms Using Drones (GARUD).

- 41. WHO award for PGI Chandigarh centre for tobacco control:** The World Health Organisation has awarded the Resource Centre for Tobacco Control (e-RCTC) of the Department of Community Medicine and School of Public Health at the Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER) in Chandigarh with the Regional Director Special Recognition Award.
- 42. UNCTAD's World Investment Report- India ranked 7th:** United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD), India jumped one position to 7th among the top recipients of foreign direct investment (FDI) in the last calendar year (2021) despite FDI inflows into the country declining. While the United States (\$367 billion) remained the top recipient of FDI, China (\$181 billion) and Hong Kong (\$141 billion) also retained second and third position, respectively.
- 43. Andhra Pradesh govt launched YSR Yantra Seva scheme:** Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister, YS Jagan Mohan Reddy has launched YSR Yantra Seva Scheme and flagged off the distribution of tractors and combine harvesters at Chuttugunta Centre in Guntur, Andhra Pradesh. Chief Minister YS Jagan Reddy flagged off the state-level mega distribution of tractors and combine harvesters under YSR Yantra Seva Pathakam in Guntur. **Governor: Biswabhusan Harichandan, Chief minister: Y. S. Jaganmohan Reddy.**
- 44. India's first COVID-19 vaccine for animals 'Anocovax' launched:** Agriculture Minister, Narendra Singh Tomar has launched the country's first homegrown COVID-19 vaccine "Anocovax" for animals, developed by Haryana-based ICAR-National Research Centre on Equines (NRC). Anocovax is an inactivated SARS-CoV-2 Delta (COVID-19) vaccine for animals.
