- 1. Global Handwashing Day 2022: Unite for Universal Hand Hygiene:** October 15 is marked as Global Handwashing Day, with the aim of increasing awareness and understanding about the importance of handwashing with soap as an effective and affordable way to prevent diseases and save lives. This year's theme, "Unite for Universal Hand Hygiene", calls on all of society to work together to scale up hand hygiene.
- 2. International Day for the Eradication of Poverty 2022 observed on 17 October:** International Day for the Eradication of Poverty is observed every year on October 17 globally. It is a day to raise awareness about the global issue of poverty and how it is a violation of human rights and of human dignity. The day also honours the courage of people living in poverty and their everyday struggles. On the occasion of the 35th anniversary of the World Day to Overcome Extreme Poverty and the 30th anniversary of the International Day for the Eradication of Poverty. This year's theme for International Day for the Eradication of Poverty is "Dignity For All in Practice".
- 3. World Trauma Day 2022:** Every year, October 17 is celebrated as World Trauma Day. The day is observed with a view to prevent the increasing rate of accidents and injuries causing death and disability across the world. The day was created in New Delhi, India, in 2011.
- 4. World Statistics Day 2022 celebrates on 20 October:** World Statistics Day 2022 is celebrated annually on October 20th to recognize the importance of statistics in our daily lives. The United Nations Statistical Commission has been at the forefront of advocating for the use of statistics to track progress towards the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The theme of Statistics Day, 2022 is "Data for Sustainable Development".
- 5. World Osteoporosis Day 2022 observed on 20th October:** World osteoporosis day is a global healthcare event observed every year on 20 October. The day is observed to promote the early diagnosis of osteoporosis, its treatment and preventive tips for strong bones. This year 2022, the World Osteoporosis Day theme is "Step Up For Bone Health", intending to encourage people around the world to check for bone density.
- 6. National Solidarity Day 2022:** India observes National Solidarity Day on 20th October every year. This day is observed to honour the Armed Forces. In the wake of the mortifying military thrashing because of China, India had started observing National Solidarity Day on October 20—the date on which China began the assaults in 1962.
- 7. National Police Commemoration Day 21 October:** October 21 commemorates the sacrifices of ten CRPF personnel who lost their lives in the line of duty. On October 21, 1959, ten Indian policemen were killed during an attack by Chinese troops in the Hot Springs region close to Ladakh after an argument between the troops. Since that day, 21 October has been observed as National Police Commemoration Day in honour of the martyrs.
- 8. Global Dignity Day 2022: 3rd Wednesday in October:** Global Dignity Day is observed every year on the 3rd Wednesday of October. This year Global Dignity Day is observed on the 19th of October. The

day is an initiative to educate and inspire young people and help them to understand their self-worth and goals.

- 9. International Stuttering Awareness Day observed on 22 October:** International Stuttering Awareness Day (ISAD) or International Stammering Awareness Day is celebrated on October 22. The theme for 2022's International Stuttering Awareness Day is **"Being seen, being heard: Representation and normalisation of stuttering in the mainstream,"**.
- 10. India Stands 3rd in the World in Terms of Fish Production:** Union Minister of State for Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying Dr. L Murugan has recently said that India stands third in the world in terms of fish production. India is the 3rd largest fish producing and 2nd largest aquaculture nation in the world after China. Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana: The programme aims to achieve 22 million tonnes of fish production by 2024-25. Also, it is expected to create employment opportunities for 55 lakh people. Focus on Blue Revolution: Focuses on creating an enabling environment for integrated and holistic development and management of fisheries for the socio-economic development of the fishers and fish farmers.
- 11. NATO announced its annual nuclear exercise "Steadfast Noon":** The North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO), also called the North Atlantic Alliance announced had started its annual nuclear exercise code-named "Steadfast Noon". The week-long exercise is taking place over Southern Europe and involves aircraft and personnel from 14 NATO countries. Steadfast Noon involves training flights with dual-capable fighter jets, as well as conventional jets, backed by surveillance and refuelling aircraft. The North Atlantic Treaty, which was signed in Washington, D.C., on April 4, 1949, is implemented by the organisation, which was founded during World War II. As a collective security structure, NATO's autonomous member nations have agreed to defend one another from outside threats. NATO functioned as a check on the imagined Soviet Union threat during the Cold War. NATO Secretary-General Jens Stoltenberg.
- 12. Goa to host 9th World Ayurveda Congress & Arogya Expo:** The 9th World Ayurveda Congress (WAC) and Arogya Expo, will be held in Panaji, Goa from 8th to 11th December 2022. The 9th World Ayurveda Congress aims to transformationally push Ayurveda to bring it into global focus. The 9th World Ayurveda Congress (WAC) is going to be hosted in Goa and it aims to create an accessible and affordable healthcare system that is in harmony with modern medical practices. The theme for the 9th World Ayurveda Congress (WAC) this year is 'Ayurveda For One Health'.
- 13. Tamil Nadu is the only State to achieve Jal Jeevan Mission target for 2022:** Tamil Nadu has emerged as the only state in India which has achieved the target for 2022 Q1 and Q2 for Jal Jeevan Mission, with 69.57 lakh households provided with tap connections. Union Jal Shakti Minister Gajendra Singh Shekhawat visited Chennai and reviewed the progress of the work on the Jal Jeevan Mission for assured portable Tap water supply to every rural household by 2024.
- 14. India to Host SCO National Coordinators Meet:** India is set to host the Shanghai Coordinators Organization national coordinator meeting in Delhi. The SCO National Coordinators meeting will take

place from the 17th to the 18th of October 2022. New Delhi took over the presidency of the nine-member grouping earlier this year at the Samarkand SCO summit. India also hosted anti-terror SCO drills in Haryana earlier this month. The grouping was formed in 2001 and includes nine countries as its members, Russia, China, India, Pakistan, Iran, and the four central Asian countries, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan, Krygyzstan, and Kazakhstan.

15. India Lifted 415 Million out of Poverty in 15 Years: UN ::The number of people living below the poverty line in India decreased by 415 million between 2005-06 and 2019-21, according to a new Multidimensional Poverty Index (MPI) released jointly by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and the Oxford Poverty and Human Development Initiative (OPHI) at the University of Oxford. The index has stated that India still has the world's highest number of poor at 228.9 million, followed by Nigeria (96.7 million projected in 2020). The report found that across 111 countries which were assessed using the most recent comparable data available, 1.2 billion people (19.1 per cent) live in acute poverty and almost half of these people (593 million) are children under the age of 18 years. The developing region with the largest number of poor people is Sub-Saharan Africa (nearly 579 million), followed by South Asia (385 million), the report highlighted. According to the report, India had 97 million poor children in 2019-21. This translates into more than one in five children (21.8 per cent)—more than the total number of poor people in any other country covered by MPI. Bihar continues to be the poorest state in the country. However, the report also commended India's performance in lifting the poor out of poverty. In the last 15 years, it lifted over 41.5 crore people out of poverty. India is an important case study for the Sustainable Development Goals, the first of which is to end poverty in all its forms and to reduce at least by half the proportion of men, women and children of all ages living in poverty in all its dimensions according to national definitions by 2030,

16. Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw Inaugurates India's First Aluminum Freight Rake at Bhubaneswar Railway Station: Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw inaugurated India's first aluminium freight rake — 61 BOBRNALHSM1 — at Bhubaneswar Railway Station. The rake's destination is Bilaspur. As per reports, the aluminium freight rake wields the capacity to carry 180-ton more goods as against the traditional rake. Moreover, it is 180 tons lighter than the traditional steel rake. Fully Lockbolted construction with no welding on superstructure. The tare is 3.25 tons lower than normal steel rakes, 180 ton extra carrying capacity resulting in higher throughput per wagon. Higher payload to tare ratio 2.85. The reduced tare will reduce carbon footprint as lower consumption of fuel in empty direction and more transport of freight in loaded condition.

17. Justice DY Chandrachud named as 50th Chief Justice of India: President Droupadi Murmu has appointed Dr Justice DY Chandrachud as the new Chief Justice of India. He will succeed the present Chief Justice of India Justice Uday Umesh Lalit. Justice Chandrachud's appointment will come into effect from the 9th of next month. Justice DY Chandrachud would be the 50th Chief Justice of India. While Justice Lalit has a tenure of 74 days, Justice Chandrachud will serve as the CJI for two years.

Justice Chandrachud will demit office on November 10, 2024. His father Justice Yeshwant Vishnu Chandrachud was the 16th Chief Justice of India, serving from February 22, 1978, till July 11, 1985.

- 18. PM Kisan Samman Sammelan 2022 Launched by PM Modi:** The Prime Minister will officially open 600 Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samruddhi Kendras (PMKSK) under the ministry of chemicals and fertilisers. PMKSK will provide agri-inputs like fertilisers, seeds, and implements; testing facilities for soil, seeds, and fertilisers; awareness-raising activities for farmers; details on various government programmes; and regular capacity building for retailers at block/district level outlets. Direct benefit transfer will be used to distribute the 12th instalment payment under the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN) for the welfare of farmers. PM will also introduce the One Nation One Fertilizer initiative, Bhartiya Jan Urvarak Pariyojana
- 19. 22nd World Blockchain Summit Begins in Dubai:** World Blockchain Summit in Dubai is taking place on Oct. 17 and 18, 2022 at Atlantis, The Palm. It is one of the most elite gatherings of the global crypto and blockchain ecosystem. The 22nd global edition of the World Blockchain Summit will bring together some of the world's leading crypto influencers, policymakers, key government delegates, media, family offices, HNIs and other curated investors, among others, to foster the crypto and blockchain community across the globe. Blockchain technology is a technology that leads to a chain of blocks, containing digital information stored in a public database. It is a distributed database existing on multiple computers at the same time, which constantly grows as new sets of recordings or blocks are added to it. Blockchain consists of three important concepts: blocks, nodes and miners. Every chain consists of multiple blocks and each block has three basic elements: The data in the block. A 32-bit whole number called a nonce. The nonce is randomly generated when a block is created, which then generates a block header hash. The hash is a 256-bit number wedded to the nonce. It must start with a huge number of zeroes (i.e., be extremely small).
- 20. SARANG – The Festival of India in Republic of Korea'** :The 8th edition of annual flagship cultural program of Embassy of India, Seoul 'SARANG– The Festival of India in Republic of Korea' will be held from Sept. 30 through Oct. 14, 2022. Starting in 2015, SARANG has emerged as a prominent Indian cultural festival, introducing India's colorful and diverse heritage and has, since then, grown in size, scale and popularity, promoting India's soft power in its truest sense and contributing to its rich civilizational legacy and cultural vibrancy. The word SARANG has a very meaningful interpretation for both Koreans and Indians. SARANG in Korean means 'love' and for Indians it refers to 'diversity representing different colors of India'.
- 21. Pakistan Removed from FATF Grey List:** the Financial Action Task Force (FATF), the international watchdog on terror financing and money laundering, has removed Pakistan from the list of countries under "increased monitoring" (Grey List). FATF is the global money laundering and terrorist financing watchdog. It also aims to counter the financing of proliferation of weapons of mass destruction. It was set up in 1989 out of a G-7 meeting of developed nations in Paris. Its Secretariat is located at the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) headquarters in Paris. As of today,

it is a 39-member body with 37 countries and two regional organisations: the European Commission, and the Gulf Cooperation Council. Indonesia is the only observer country of FATF. India joined with 'observer' status in 2006 and became a full member of FATF in 2010. The Grey List includes countries that are considered safe haven for supporting terror funding and money laundering. It serves as a warning that the country may enter the blacklist. The Black List includes Non-Cooperative Countries or Territories (NCCTs) that support terror funding and money laundering activities. As of now, Iran, North Korea and Myanmar are the three black listed countries. Pakistan has been removed from the list after four years. It was first put on the list in 2008, removed in 2009 and before adding it again in 2018, it remained under increased monitoring from 2012 to 2015.

- 22. Kati Bihu 2022:** The Kati Bihu is an auspicious festival of Assam which is a harvest festival. It is celebrated on 18th October 2022 and the day is marked on the first day of Kati month according to the Assamese Calendar. The Kati Bihu generally falls in October every day. Kati Bihu is also known as Kongali Bihu which marks the crucial phase in farmers' lives in Assam.
- 23. Reliance Jio surpasses BSNL to become largest landline service provider in August:** Mukesh Ambani-led Reliance Jio became the largest landline service provider in the country for the first time, in August. With 7.35 million landline connections as on August 31, Reliance Jio beat state-owned telecom operator and hitherto market leader BSNL's 7.13 million connections, according to the latest data released by the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (Trai). Third-placed MTNL provided 2.6 million connections. Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) had earlier pointed out the declining number of landline connections in the country as a cause for concern since the same network is also used to deliver fixed-line broadband services. **Founded:** 20 February 1997, **TRAI Headquarters:** New Delhi, **TRAI Chairperson:** Ram Sewak Sharma, **Secretary:** Sunil K. Gupta.
- 24. PM Modi launched Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Jan Urvarak Pariyojana:** Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Jan Urvarak Pariyojana-One Nation One Fertiliser. Under the Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Jan Urvarak Pariyojana, companies must market all subsidized fertilizers under a single brand, 'Bharat'. The One Nation One Fertiliser aims to give farmers quality crop nutrients at low costs under the 'One Nation, One Fertiliser'.
- 25. UIDAI topped Grievance Redressal Index for second consecutive month:** The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI), which oversees Aadhaar, has once again topped the September rankings report published by the Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DARPG), for resolving most public grievances among all government ministries and government departments. This is the second consecutive month UIDAI has topped the rankings. **CEO:** Dr. Saurabh Garg, **UIDAI Founded:** 28 January 2009, **UIDAI Headquarters:** New Delhi.
- 26. India Ranks 41st Among 44 Nations In Pension Index:** As compared to 40th out of 43 countries in 2021, India ranked 41 out of 44 countries in the Mercer CFS Global Pension Index. The MCGPI is a comprehensive study of 44 global pension systems, accounting for 65 percent of the world's population. The survey pointed out that the country needs to strengthen its regulatory framework and

boost the coverage under private pension arrangements. In the absence of social security coverage in the country, the adequacy and sustainability sub-indices can be improved significantly by boosting coverage under private pension arrangements.

- 27. Mission DefSpace launched by PM Modi in Gujarat:** DefSpace was inaugurated at DefExpo2022 in Gandhinagar, Gujarat. The project's goal is to create cutting-edge defence forces in the space industry. 75 space industry challenges have been highlighted for private companies to work on under Mission DefSpace. Mission DefSpace, the effort will strengthen India's preparation and position the nation for potential future space opportunities. 'South Asia satellite' is a good illustration of this. Ten ASEAN nations will also have real-time access to Indian satellite data by the end of the following year.
- 28. Mission Schools of Excellence' launched by PM Modi in Gujarat:** Mission Schools of Excellence" unveiled by the Prime Minister Narendra Modi. The 'Mission Schools of Excellence' is an ambitious project in Gandhinagar with the dual goals of reforming the curriculum in Gujarat's public schools and countering the Aam Aadmi Party's (AAP) criticisms of the State government for the low quality of education. The 'Mission Schools of Excellence', has a budget of 10,000 crore and is partially supported by the World Bank.
- 29. Wildlife Board Approves Durgavati Tiger Reserve as New Tiger Reserve:** The Durgavati Tiger Reserve is a 2,339 square kilometers new tiger reserve that will spread across Narsinghpur, Damoh, and Sagar districts. Madhya Pradesh Wildlife Board has approved the making of a new tiger reserve of Panna Tiger Reserve (PTP), one-fourth of which will get submerged due to the Linkin of the Ken-Betwa rivers.
- 30. Uttar Pradesh bags top honours at PMAY-U Awards 2021:** Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban (PMAY-U) housing scheme have been delivered and the rest are under various stages of completion, Union Minister of Housing & Urban Affairs Hardeep Singh Puri. PMAY-U Awards 2021 is scheduled annually to recognise the contribution of States, Union Territories and urban local bodies with regard to the implementation of the scheme in Rajkot. In the awards, Uttar Pradesh bagged the first position followed by Madhya Pradesh and Tamil Nadu at second and third place, respectively. Poll-bound Gujarat saw five special category awards for performance related to Affordable Rental Housing Complexes and 'Convergence with other Missions' coming its way.
- 31. DX 2022 Awards: Karnataka Bank bags digital transformation awards of CII:** Karnataka Bank has bagged the National Digital Transformation Awards, "DX 2022 Awards" instituted by the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) for best practices in digital transformation under the BFSI segment. The awards in recognition of the "Innovative Excellence". DX (Digital Transformation) Award is the ideal platform for organizations that have made outstanding contributions in the digital field to showcase their efforts and achievements. ii. DX Award 2022 is the 4th edition of CII.
- 32. 5th Khelo India Youth Games to be held in Madhya Pradesh:** The 5th edition of the Khelo India Youth Games will be held in Madhya Pradesh from 31st January to 11th February 2023. The event was

felicitated by Union Minister for Youth Affairs and Sports Anurag Thakur, and Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh Shivraj Singh Chouhan. Khelo India Youth Games will be held in eight locations.

- 33. Chandrayaan-3 set for launch in August 2023: ISRO chairman ::** Chandrayaan-3 set for launch in August 2023: The Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) plans to launch its third lunar mission in the month of June 2023. The more capable lunar rover that will be carried by Chandrayaan-3, which is essential for future interplanetary explorations, according to S. Somnath, Chairman of the Indian Space Agency, ISRO. It is important to note that the Chandrayaan-2 mission lost control and fell to the Moon's dark side. However, the orbiter is still operational and making crucial observations of both the solar system and the lunar surface. Chandrayaan-3 is crucial for Isro since it will show off India's capacity to do landings for future extraterrestrial expeditions.
- 34. Indian, US Militaries Conduct 'Tiger Triumph' Exercise:** The Indian and US militaries carried out a three-day joint humanitarian assistance exercise in Vishakhapatnam in line with the growing strategic cooperation between the two countries. The Tiger Triumph exercise was the second collaboration between the Indian and US Militaries to coordinate disaster relief in the region.
- 35. Telangana Hyderabad Haleem bags 'Most Popular GI' award:** Telangana's Hyderabad Haleem has won the 'Most Popular GI' award after beating other food items including Rasgulla, Bikaneri Bhujia, and Ratlami Sev. In a rigid competition with more than 15 food items across the country with Geographical Indication (GI) status, the famous Hyderabad Haleem has bagged the 'Most Popular GI' award. For the first time, GI status was accorded to Hyderabad Haleem in 2010. It expired in December 2019. However, later, the registrar of Geographical Indicator renewed the tag for the dish for 10 years. Most Popular GI' award: Process Awarded by the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, the winner was chosen based on public opinion.
- 36. Rishi Sunak bid for prime minister of United Kingdom with over 131 MPs support:** Rishi Sunak bid for prime minister of UK: Rishi Sunak, the son-in-law of Infosys founder N R Narayana Murthy, formally entered the race to succeed Liz Truss as leader of the Conservative party and the next prime minister of the United Kingdom.
