- 1. United Nations Day 2022 celebrates on 24th October:** United Nations Day, on 24 October, marks the anniversary of the entry into force in 1945 of the UN Charter. With the ratification of this founding document by the majority of its signatories, including the five permanent members of the Security Council, the United Nations officially came into being. In 1945, 50 governments gathered to draft the UN Charter. The year 2022 marks the 77th anniversary of the United Nations and its founding Charter. The Charter was signed on 26 June 1945 by the representatives of the 50 countries. Poland, which was not represented at the Conference, signed it later and became one of the original 51 Member States. The United Nations officially came into existence on 24 October 1945, when the Charter had been ratified by China, France, the Soviet Union, the United Kingdom, the United States and by a majority of other signatories. The name “United Nations” was coined by the United States President Franklin D. Roosevelt and first used in the Declaration by United Nations of 1 January 1942, during Second World War. United Nations Headquarters in New York, USA, Mr Antonio Guterres is the Secretary-General of the United Nations.
- 2. World Development Information Day observed on 24 October:** Every year the United Nations marks October 24 as World Development Information Day. This day is observed to create awareness towards the problems surrounding development in different nations and how to overcome them. It was in 1972 when the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) established the World Development Information Day in order to draw the attention of the world toward development problems and also to strengthen international cooperation.
- 3. Global Media and Information Literacy Week: 24-31 October:** Global Media and Information Literacy (MIL) Week 2022 is observed from October 24 to October 31. The Global MIL Week 2022 focuses on trust and solidarity as it relates to people, media, digital platforms, governments, the private sector, and non-governmental organizations. UNESCO has announced the theme for this year’s MIL week as “Nurturing trust: A Media and Information Literacy Imperative.” The eleventh Global Media and Information Literacy (MIL) Week is hosted by Nigeria and is taking place in Abuja, as well as online.
- 4. World Polio Day 2022:** World Polio Day 2022 is observed every year on October 24 to raise awareness about the polio vaccination and eradication of polio from every corner of the world. The day is observed to commemorate the progress made by the world towards polio eradication. This year, the overarching theme of World Polio Day is “World Polio Day 2022 and Beyond: A healthier future for mothers and children”.
- 5. 7th Ayurveda Day 2022 observed on 23rd October:** The 7th Ayurveda Day was celebrated on a magnificent scale in India and at the international level. The theme of this year’s Ayurveda Day is “Har Din Har Ghar Ayurveda”, with the motive to propagate the benefits of Ayurveda to masses and grass-root communities. The main celebration of National Ayurveda Day was held at Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi. All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA), under the Ministry of Ayush, is the nodal agency for driving the Ministry of Ayush’s mandate for Ayurveda Day this year.

- 6. World Day for Audiovisual Heritage celebrates on 27 October:** World Day for Audiovisual Heritage (WDAH) is celebrated on October 27 every year to highlight and promote the importance of such preservation. Audiovisual heritage refers to documents like film, sounds, radio, television programmes and other audio and video that are of socio-cultural importance and need preservation for posterity. “Enlisting documentary heritage to promote inclusive, just and peaceful societies” is the theme for WDAH this year.
- 7. Indian Army Celebrates 76th Infantry Day On 27 October:** Indian Army Infantry Day is celebrated on October 27 every year to pay homage to the soldiers who fought for the country and laid down their lives in the line of duty. The date October 27 was chosen for the occasion as it was on this day that the first Indian infantry soldiers defended the country's territory from external aggression.
- 8. Union Territory of J&K celebrates its Accession Day on 26th October:** The Accession Day of Jammu and Kashmir on 26th October with the Union of India is being celebrated across the Union Territory. Accession Day carries great significance as it was on this day in 1947 that the then Maharaja of Jammu and Kashmir, Hari Singh signed the Instrument of Accession to become part of the greatest democracy of the world. The day became an official public holiday in J&K for the first time in 2020 after the abrogation of articles 370 and 35A on 5th August 2019. The Instrument of Accession is a legal document executed by Maharaja Hari Singh, ruler of the princely state of Jammu & Kashmir, on 26th October 1947.
- 9. International Animation Day 2022 observed on 28th October:** International Animation Day is celebrated on 28 October every year. It was in this year when the International Animated Film Association (ASIFA) declared International Animation Day (IAD) as a worldwide occasion to commend the speciality of animation. This day is celebrated in more than 50 distinct nations throughout the world. IAD was started by ASIFA, an individual from UNESCO. The International Film Association established International Animation Day in 2002, honouring the birth of animation, recognized as the first public performance of projected moving images at Emile Reynaud's Theatre Optique in Paris, on the 28th October 1892.
- 10. World Psoriasis Day is Observed On 29 October:** World Psoriasis Day is observed every year on October 29th to make the general public aware of the important facts related to psoriasis and this disease and its treatment. In the year 2022, World Psoriasis Day is being observed with the theme of “Unloading Psoriatic Disease”. Psoriasis is a serious abnormal skin condition in which red and white scaly patches start developing on the patient's skin. These spots usually appear on the elbows, knees, scalp or lower back. These spots can sometimes be itchy or painful. At the same time, as the problem progresses, they may also feel burning sensations or swelling.
- 11. International Internet Day is celebrates on 29 October:** International Internet Day is celebrated on October 29 every year across the world to celebrate the usage of the internet for the first time. The day marks the sending of the first electronic message which was transferred from one computer to another in 1969. At that time the Internet was known as ARPANET (Advanced Research Projects Agency Network). The Internet provides instant access to information.
- 12. Rashtriya Ekta Diwas or National Unity Day 2022:** The National Unity Day or Rashtriya Ekta Diwas is celebrated every year on October 31st to commemorate the birth anniversary of India's first Home

Minister, Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. This year will mark the 147th birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, who is also known as the Iron Man of India. The Statue of Unity at Kevadiya in the Narmada district of Gujarat (2018) was built in his honour

- 13. Nation celebrates 113th Birth anniversary of Homi Jehangir Bhabha:** 113th Birth anniversary of Indian nuclear physicist Homi Jehangir Bhabha who is also known as the father of the Indian nuclear program. He was born on 30 October 1909 in Bombay, Bombay Presidency, British India (now Mumbai, Maharashtra, India). On 24 January 1966, Bhabha died when Air India Flight 101 crashed near Mont Blanc. The official reason for the crash-A misunderstanding between Geneva Airport and the pilot about the aircraft's position near the mountain. However, there are assassination claims like the involvement of a foreign intelligence agency to paralyse India's nuclear program. Homi J Bhabha was the founding director and professor of physics at the Tata Institute of Fundamental Research (TIFR). Homi J Bhabha was also the founding director of the Atomic Energy Establishment, Trombay (AEET). It is now named the Bhabha Atomic Research Centre in his honour. TIFR and AEET were the cornerstones of Indian development of nuclear weapons and both were supervised by Bhabha as director. In 1942, Bhabha was awarded the Adams Prize and Padma Bhushan in 1954. In 1951 and 1953–1956, Bhabha was also nominated for the Nobel Prize for Physics.
- 14. World Thrift Day observed on 31st October:** World Thrift Day is celebrated every year on October 31, across the world. World Thrift Day, also often called World Savings Day. However, India does this a day earlier, marking it on October 30 every year. The day is significant as it is an occasion to generate awareness about the concept of saving money in a bank (so as to enrich the money supply in the country) instead of keeping it locked away at home. This year, the theme of World Thrift Day is “Saving prepares you for the future”,
- 15. World Cities Day is observed on 31 October:** World Cities Day brings Urban October to an end on 31st October each year and was first celebrated in 2014. As with World Habitat Day, a global observance is held in a different city each year and the day focuses on a specific theme. A different city hosts the event each year. This year's global observance is planned in Shanghai, China under the theme “Act Local to Go Global.”
- 16. Former cricketer Yuvraj Singh named brand ambassador of T20 World Cup for the Blind:** The Cricket Association for the Blind in India (CABI) has announced former India cricketer Yuvraj Singh as their brand ambassador for the 3rd T20 World Cup for the Blind to be held in India in December. Ajay Kumar Reddy B2 (Andhra Pradesh) will lead the Indian team while Venkateswara Rao Dunna – B2 (Andhra Pradesh) will be the vice-captain. The participating countries for the 3rd T20 World Cup for the Blind are India, Nepal, Bangladesh, Australia, South Africa, Pakistan and Sri Lanka. The World Cup is an initiative of the Samarthanam Trust for the disabled, which has been organizing this championship since 2012.
- 17. India's first 'Migration Monitoring System' inaugurated in Mumbai:** India's first 'Migration Monitoring Systems' was inaugurated by the Maharashtra Women and Children Development Minister Mangalprabhat Lodha in Mumbai. The website-based Migration Tracking System will track the movement of vulnerable seasonal migrant beneficiaries. The Migration Monitoring Systems aims to provide information about migrant pregnant women, lactating women, and children. The system

provides updated information about migrant pregnant women, lactating women, and children in a single system.

- 18. Dr Bimal Jalan authored a book titled "From dependence to Self-Reliance":** Economist Dr Bimal Jalan authored the book **"From dependence to Self-Reliance: Mapping India's Rise as a Global Superpower"**, a stocktaking of India's growth trajectory, benefits from Bimal Jalan's deep insights. The book is written lucidly, with the general reader in mind. Dr Bimal Jalan is the former governor of the RBI.
- 19. Netherlands Beats China, Becomes India's 3rd-Largest Export Market:** The Netherlands has emerged as India's third-largest export destination, ahead of China and Bangladesh. It has moved up two spots in the list of India's top ten export destinations since FY22. Brazil, which occupied the 21st spot in FY22, is now India's 8th biggest export market. Similarly, Indonesia has moved up seven notches to grab The 7th position. The US and the UAE continue to be the largest and second-largest export destinations, respectively, for India.
- 20. National Intellectual Property Award won by IIT Madras for 2021 and 2022:** National Intellectual Property Award: The national award for intellectual property was given to the Indian Institute of Technology-Madras (IIT-M) for 2021 and 2022. The prize was established by the Ministry of Commerce and Industry's Ministry of Commerce and Industry. This award has encouraged IIT Madras to produce and safeguard more and more intellectual property with societal effect.
- 21. FIPRESCI declared 'Pather Panchali' as best Indian movie:** Legendary filmmaker Satyajit Ray's feature **"Pather Panchali"** has been declared the best Indian film of all time by the International Federation of Film Critics (FIPRESCI). The 1955 film has received the number one slot in the top ten films in the history of Indian cinema list, which was declared after a poll conducted by the India chapter of FIPRESCI.
- 22. Gol appoints Sangeeta Verma as acting chairperson of CCI:** The government of India appointed Sangeeta Verma as the acting chairperson of the Competition Commission of India (CCI). The appointment follows full-time Chairperson Ashok Kumar Gupta demitting office. Verma is currently a member at the regulator. Her appointment will be effective for a **"period of three months or till the appointment of regular Chairperson or till any further orders, whichever is the earliest,"**. The Competition Commission of India (CCI) was established under the Competition Act, of 2002 for the administration, implementation and enforcement of the Act. It was constituted in March 2009.
Members of the CCI: It consists of 7 members; one Chairperson and six other members. The members are appointed by the government for five years and are re-eligible for appointments. However, the members have to retire after attaining the age of sixty-five years.
- 23. Gujarat achieves 100 percent household tap connections under Jal Jeevan Mission:** Gujarat has been declared as a 100 percent **'Har Ghar Jal'** state. In Gujarat, households in rural areas have access to safe drinking water through taps under the **'Har Ghar Jal'** mission. About 91,73,378 houses in the state have water connections according to the government record. The **'Har Ghar Jal'** was launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in 2019. The **'Har Ghar Jal'** aims to make available 55 liters of water per person every day to each rural household through household tap connections by 2024. Gujarat has achieved 100 percent water tap connections two years ahead of the 2024 deadline.

- 24. OAG report: Delhi's IGI airport is now world's 10th busiest airport:** Official Airline Guide (OAG) report, the Indira Gandhi International Airport in Delhi is the 10th busiest airport in the world in terms of seat capacity and frequency of domestic and international flights as of October 2022. According to OAG, there were 34,13,855 seats at the Delhi airport, popularly known as the Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGIA).
- 25. 12th World Hindi Conference will take place in February 2023 in Nadi, Fiji:** 12th World Hindi Conference: According to P S Kartigeyan, the Indian High Commissioner to the South Pacific island, Fiji will host the famous World Hindi Conference for the first time next year as a new platform for the globalisation of Hindi. The governments of India and Fiji decided together to host the World Hindi Conference in Fiji.
- 26. Centre approves Terai Elephant Reserve in Uttar Pradesh:** The Centre has approved the setting up of the Terai Elephant Reserve (TER) at Dudhwa-Pilibhit in Uttar Pradesh. The Terai Elephant Reserve is the 3rd Elephant Reserve in India which is spread over 3,049 sq km. The Terai Elephant Reserve includes protected areas, forest areas, and corridors for the conservation of wild elephants. The other two TER are Lemru in Chattisgarh and Agasthyalai in Tamil Nadu. The Project Elephant is a centrally sponsored scheme that supports Elephant conservation in India.
- 27. Garuda VII air exercise, jointly conducted by France and India:** Garuda VII air exercise: At Air Force Station Jodhpur, the Indian Air Force (IAF) and the French Air and Space Force (FASF) are taking part in the bilateral exercise "Garuda VII" from October 26 to November 12, 2022. FASF is taking part in this exercise with a troop of 220 people, one A-330 Multi Role Tanker Transport (MRTT) aircraft, and four Rafale fighter aircraft. Chief of Air Staff, India: Air Chief Marshal Vivek Ram Chaudhari.
- 28. SIMBEX 2022 maritime exercise between Singapore and India:** SIMBEX 2022 maritime exercise: From October 26 to October 30, 2022, Visakhapatnam will play home to the 29th Singapore-India Maritime Bilateral Exercise (SIMBEX). The two phases of SIMBEX-2022 are the Harbour Phase at Visakhapatnam and the Sea Phase in the Bay of Bengal.
- 29. India to Hold Mega 'Yudh Abhyas' Military Drill With US Near China Border:** Indian and US militaries to conduct the battalion-level "Yudh Abhyas" exercise between 15th November 2022 to 2nd December 2022. The Yudh Abhyas will be held at Auli in Uttarakhand which is just 100 km from the Line of Actual Control (LAC). The member countries of the "Quad" will conduct the Malabar exercise off Yokosuka in Japan between 8th November 2022 to 18th November 2022. The "Quad" member countries include India, Australia, Japan, and the US. The Quad has declared that it would "deter" any "coercion" in the Indo-Pacific. "Yudh Abhyas" will include high-altitude warfare drills. In August, the US and Indian forces conducted the "Vajra Prahar" exercise at Bakloh in Himachal Pradesh. The "Vajra Prahar" involved the special forces of the two countries.
- 30. Spiritual leader Mata Amritanandamayi appointed as Chair of C20:** Spiritual leader Mata, Amritanandamayi Devi (Amma) has been appointed the Chair of the country's Civil 20 (C20), an official engagement group of the Group of 20 (G20), by the union government. The G20 is the premier inter-governmental forum for the world's developed and emerging economies to address financial stability on a global basis. The C20 is its platform for civil society organisations (CSOs) to bring forth non-

government and non-business voices to the G20 leaders. India will assume the Presidency of the G20 for one year from December 1, 2022 to November 30, 2023.

- 31. Indian Navy Participates in Maiden Trilateral Exercise with Mozambique and Tanzania:** first edition of the India-Mozambique-Tanzania Trilateral Exercise commenced at Dar Es Salaam, Tanzania on 27th October 2022. The Indian Navy has participated in the Maiden Trilateral Exercise with Mozambique and Tanzania. Indian Navy is represented by the guided missile frigate, INS Tarkash, a Chetak Helicopter, and MARCOS.
- 32. BPCL recognised as country's most sustainable oil & gas company:** Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited (BPCL), 'Maharatna' and a Fortune Global 500 Company has once again achieved the No.1 rank in the Indian oil and gas sector for its sustainability performance in the 2022 edition of the S&P Dow Jones Sustainability Indices (DJSI) Corporate Sustainability Assessment (CSA) rankings. Headquarters: Mumbai; Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited Founded: 1952. Chairman: Arun Kumar Singh.
