- World Vegan Day observed on 01st November: World Vegan Day is celebrated every year on November 1 to encourage people to follow the vegan lifestyle and spread awareness about veganism. The day is dedicated to the practice of abstaining from use of animal products and exploitation of animals. All across the world, World Vegan Day is celebrated a day after Halloween. Halloween falls on October 31. This year's theme will be based on the animal rights-focused campaign 'Future Normal'.
- 2. International Day to End Impunity for Crimes against Journalists: 2 November: November 2nd has been observed as the International Day to End Impunity for Crimes against Journalists (IDEI) since 2013. The day came into existence when the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) passed a resolution in December 2013. This year's slogan is Knowing the "Truth is Protecting the Truth".
- 3. University Grants Commission proposed 'Bharatiya Bhasha Diwas' to be celebrated on Dec 11: The University Grants Commission has written to vice-chancellors and principals of all universities and colleges in this regard following recommendations of a committee constituted last year by the education ministry to promote Indian languages. All higher education institutions in India must observe a 'Bharatiya Bhasha Divas' on December 11 every year to create "language harmony" and develop a conducive environment for learning Indian languages.
- 4. 7 Indian states & 2 UTs celebrated their formation day on November 1st: On November 1st, Seven of the 28 Indian states and two Union Territories observed their formation day. The states of Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Haryana, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh and Punjab besides the Union Territories of Lakshadweep and Puducherry were formed on this day, though in different years. Besides 28 states, India has eight Union Territories.
- World Tsunami Awareness Day observed on 05th November: In December 2015, the UN General Assembly designated November 5 as World Tsunami Awareness Day, calling on countries, international bodies and civil society to raise tsunami awareness and share innovative approaches to risk reduction. UN Disaster Risk Reduction (UNDRR) facilitates the observance of World Tsunami Awareness Day in collaboration with the rest of the United Nations system. The theme of World Tsunami Awareness Day 2022 in Asia-Pacific: Early Warning and Early Action Before Every Tsunami.
- 6. National Cancer Awareness Day 2022: National Cancer Awareness Day 2022 is celebrated every year on 7th November in India. This day is important because it educates people about the serious risk of cancer. According to the World Health Organization (WHO), cancer is the second most deadly disease that causes death among people.

Digital Rupee, RBI launches Its First Pilot Project: The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) will commence pilot launches of the digital rupee from November 1. It has identified nine banks for participation in the pilot launch. They are the State Bank of India, Bank of Baroda, Union Bank of India, HDFC Bank, ICICI Bank, Kotak Mahindra Bank, Yes Bank, IDFC First Bank, and HSBC. A Central Bank Digital Currency (CBDC) or Digital Rupee is a digital form of currency notes issued by a central bank. Digital currency or rupee is an electronic form of money, that can be used in contactless transactions.

CBDCs Types:

1) Retail (CBDC-R): Retail CBDC would be potentially available for use by all,

- 2) Wholesale (CBDC-W) is designed for restricted access to select financial institutions. A cryptocurrency is a decentralised digital asset and a medium of exchange based on blockchain technology. However, it has primarily been controversial due to its decentralised nature, meaning its operation without any intermediary like banks, financial institutions, or central authorities. On the Contrary, Central Bank Digital Currency (CBDC) issued by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) will be a legal tender in a digital form. The four-day event is being hosted in conjunction with the Indonesian Research and Innovation Expo (INA-RIE) from the 27th until the 30th of October 2022 at the Innovation Convention Centre, Cibinong Bogor, Indonesia.
- **9.** UP's Ranipur Tiger Reserve Becomes 53rd Tiger Reserve of India: Uttar Pradesh is set to have its fourth Tiger Reserve and 53rd tiger reserve in India. The tiger reserve is spread across over 529.36 sq km out of which the core area is 230.32 sq km and the buffer area is 299.05 sq km. Apart from Ranipur, Uttar Pradesh has three tiger reserves, Dudhwa, Pilibhit, and Amangarh.
- 10. Central Vigilance Awareness Week is observed from 31st October to 6th November 2022: Central Vigilance Commission observes Vigilance Awareness Week during the week in which 31st of October, the birthday of the late Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel falls. This year, Vigilance Awareness Week is being observed from 31st October to 6th November 2022 with the following theme: "Corruption-free India for a developed Nation".
- 11. Arunachal Pradesh to get Northeast's first fish museum: A fish museum, the first of its kind in the Northeast, would soon be built in Arunachal Pradesh, Fisheries Minister Tage Taki. The museum in the NorthEast region (NER), with all fish species across the district from Tawang to Longding, to

attract tourists, fish lovers and the museum will also serve as a training centre for fish farmers. Arunachal Pradesh Governor: Dr B. D. Mishra;

- Institute (ICAR-SBI) got its first-ever woman director in over a century of the Institution's existence. Dr. G Hemaprabha was appointed as the Director of the ICAR-Sugarcane Breeding Institute up to 2024 on the recommendation of the Agricultural Scientists Recruitment Board, New Delhi under the Union Minister of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare. The ICAR-Sugarcane Breeding Institute, Coimbatore is the premier and one the oldest agriculture research institutes under the Indian Council of Agriculture Research. It was established in 1912, the institute has been largely responsible for meeting the sugarcane varietal requirements of the country for the past ten decades with the dual mandate of developing improved sugarcane varieties and also supporting the sugarcane breeding program of over 23 Sugarcane Research Stations in India.
- 13. Tata Steel Jamshedpur India's first to achieve ResponsibleSteel certification: Tata Steel has received ResponsibleSteel certification for three of its production facilities in Jamshedpur, Jharkhand. The steel works, tubes division and cold rolling mill (Bara) have joined the group of other steel-producing sites around the world with the certification.
- 14. HARIT Aaykar Initiative by Income Tax Department for Increasing Greenery and Creating Micro Forests: The Income Tax Department participated in the Government of India's month-long Special Campaign for Swachhata which ends on 31st October, 2022. This day (31st October) marks the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel and is also observed as the National Unity Day. Under this initiative, the Income Tax Department resolves to increase the green cover by planting trees and creating micro-forests in and around Income Tax Department's buildings and other public areas. A micro-forest is a small, planted forest that maximises tree density and biodiversity.
- 15. Goa hosts Civil Air Navigation Services Organisation Asia Pacific Conference: Goa to host three days Civil Air Navigation Services Organisation (CANSO) Conference from 1st to 3rd November 2022. In these three days, delegates and exhibitors from the Asia Pacific region and beyond will discuss and collaborate on the key issues that will help shape the future of Asia's aviation industry. The CANSO aims to turn the Complete Air Traffic System (CATS) Global Council's vision for the skies of 2045 into a reality.
- 16. University Grants Commission proposed 'Bharatiya Bhasha Diwas' to be celebrated on Dec 11: The University Grants Commission has written to vice-chancellors and principals of all universities and colleges in this regard following recommendations of a committee constituted last year by the education ministry to promote Indian languages. - 18. Unemployment Rate Surges to 7.77% in Oct Against 6.43% in Sept- CMIE: India's unemployment rate rose in October due to a sharp increase in the rural joblessness rate after the kharif harvest season, according to the Centre for Monitoring Indian Economy (CMIE). Unemployment rate in surged last month on the back of significant increase in rural unemployment rate, reversing the decline registered in September. The jobless rate rose to 7.77% in October, from a four-year low of 6.43% in September, the CMIE data showed. The rural unemployment rate surged to 8.04% from 5.84% in September, while the urban jobless rate moderated to 7.21% compared with 7.7% in the previous month. Kharif crops sown at the beginning of the monsoon season are harvested between September and the first half of October.
- 19. Ganga Utsav 2022– The River Festival to be celebrated on 4th November: Ministry of Jal Shakti is organizing Ganga Utsav- The River Festivals 2022 on 4th November 2022 at the Major Dhyan Chand Stadium in New Delhi in two separate sessions. The Ganga Utsav- The River Festivals 2022 is being organized by the collaboration of The National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG), the Department of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, and the Ministry of Jal Shakti.
- 20. Kerala to host Track Asia Cup 2022 Cycling Tournament: Kerala is set to host the Track Asia Cup 2022 Cycling Tournament. Track Asia Cup is one of the biggest cycling events and will be held at LNCPE Outdoor Velodrome from 25th November 2022 to 28th November 2022. In the Track Asia Cup 2022, around 200 cyclists will participate from over 25 countries in Asia. The event is being conducted outside Delhi for the first time.
- 21. Centre Sets Up Radhakrishnan Committee for Higher Educational Institutions: The Ministry of Education has set up a high-level panel to strengthen the assessment and accreditation of higher educational institutions, on November 4, 2022. The panel will be headed by Dr K Radhakrishnan, Chairperson, Board of Governors, IIT Kanpur. He is also the chairperson of the Standing Committee of IIT Council. The mandate of the committee includes strengthening the assessment and accreditation processes and preparing a road map for the National Accreditation Council envisioned in the National Education Policy, 2020. India has one of the largest and diverse education systems in the world,".
- **22.** Subhrakant Panda named as President of FICCI: The Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FICCI) has announced Mr Subhrakant Panda as its President-Elect. Mr Panda is currently the Senior Vice President of FICCI. He shall succeed Mr Sanjiv Mehta as President of the apex chamber at the conclusion of the 95th Annual General Meeting to be held on December 16th-17th, 2022.

- 23. Haryana CM Launched 'CM dashboard' for Live Monitoring of Departments: Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar launched the 'CM Dashboard' portal that will have real-time data of all departments and decisions taken on major schemes. The 'CM Dashboard' portal will provide live monitoring of every department at the block, district, and panchayat levels. The portal will have information about the decisions taken by the administrative wing on major schemes. This will enable tracking of methodology and analysis of the report and further help in the comparison of old and new data.
- **24.** Switzerland created record for operating the longest passenger train: Switzerland is now home to the world's longest passenger train. The train has 100 coaches, measures 1910 metres and consists of 4,550 seats. The train was seen passing through the mountainous landscape in the Swiss Alps. Celebrating the 175th anniversary of Switzerland's first railway, the country's railway operators came together to create the new Guinness World Record-holding train which tows 100 carriages, weighs 2,990 tons, and measures 1.91 km (1.19 miles) long.
- 25. Uttarakhand Chief Minister launches Lakhpati Didi Yojana: Uttrakhand Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami inaugurated the 'Lakhpati Didi' fair at the survey of India Maidan, Hathbarkala in Dehradun. The fair is part of an initiative undertaken by the BJP government to empower women in the state. The Rural Development department of the Uttrakhand government has made preparations to make 1.25 lakh women from self-help groups 'Lakhpati' by 2025. Under the 'Lakhpati Didi' scheme women belonging to self-help groups (SHGs) will be encouraged to take up micro-enterprises with skill development.
- 26. Niveshak Didi" programme launched in order to promote financial literacy: Niveshak Didi" programme launched: Niveshak Didi, in order to promote financial literacy "By the women, for the women," India Post Payments Bank (IPPB) organised India's First Floating Financial Literacy Camp in Srinagar, J&K. The Niveshak Didi Initiative is founded on the principle of "women for women," as rural women are better at ease discussing their concerns with another woman.
- **27.** Amit Dasgupta honoured with a member of the Order of Australia Award: Amit Dasgupta was appointed as an Honorary Member in the General Division of the Order of Australia (AM) for his service to the Australia-India bilateral relationship. Dasgupta is a tireless promoter of Australia-India relations, challenging the nations' governments and people to realise the underlying potential of a stronger bilateral relationship.

28. First time CRPF names two female cadre officers as IG of RAF: Two female cadre officers appointed as IG: After their entrance into the CRPF in 1987, two female officers have recently been appointed as Inspectors General (IG). The Rapid Action Force (RAF), a specialised anti-riot force, has appointed Annie Abraham as its IG. As the new Bihar sector IG, Seema Dhundia has been appointed.

- 29. Independent India's first voter Master Shyam Saran Negi passes away: Three days after casting his vote for the 34th time, India's oldest voter Shyam Saran Negi died on November 5, 2022 at his home in Kalpa in Himachal Pradesh. He was 106. Negi, who was the Election Commission's brand ambassador, voted for the Himachal Pradesh Assembly election through postal ballot on November 2. It was the last vote for the man who was 31 when India gained Independence.
- 30. International Day for Preventing the Exploitation of the Environment in War and Armed Conflict 2022: On November 6th, the UN observes the International Day for Preventing the Exploitation of the Environment in War and Armed Conflict. The day seeks to make people aware of the consequences that war and conflict have on the environment.
- 31. India Celebrates 134th Birth Anniversary of CV Raman: CV Raman was born on 7th November 1888, in Trichinopoly, Tamil Nadu, and died on 21st November 1970, in Bangalore. CV Raman was one of India's greatest scientists. Sir Chandrasekhara Venkata Raman was a physicist who made discoveries that were broader than modern science and were called the Raman Effect, the phenomenon of change of wavelength of light when a beam is scattered in a medium. National Science Day is celebrated in India on 28 February each year to mark the discovery of the Raman effect by Indian physicist Sir C. V. Raman on 28 February 1928.
- 32. 17th Pravasi Bharatiya Divas Convention: Guyana President Dr. Mohamed Irfaan Ali to be chief guest: Guyana President, Dr. Mohamed Irfaan Ali will be the chief guest at the 17th Pravasi Bharatiya Divas Convention. It will be held from 8th to 10th January next year in Indore, Madhya Pradesh. The theme of the 17th Pravasi Bharatiya Divas is Diaspora: Reliable Partners for India's Progress in Amrit Kaal.
- **33.** World Radiography Day 2022: Every year on November 8, World Radiography Day is observed to honour the discovery of X-radiation, also known as X-rays. This day in 1895 saw the completion of German scientist Wilhelm Conrad Rontgen's discovery of X-radiation, or X-rays. For this accomplishment, he was awarded the first Nobel Prize in Physics in 1901. This year, we will be celebrating the 11th International Day of Radiology on 11 November and this is observed by all the medical imaging professionals from across the world. The theme of International Day of Radiology 2022 is "Radiographers at the Forefront of Patient Safety."

This week is an initiative taken by the United Nations (UN), hoping to make people contribute towards the encouragement and promotion of peace across the globe. During this week, people inspire and promote peace in their countries and also develop advanced technology for better living.
- 36. National Legal Services Day 2022: 9th November: National Legal Services Day is marked every year on 9th November to celebrate the commencement of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 which came into force on this very day in 1995.

In India, National Education Day is celebrated every year on November 11 as it marks the birth anniversary of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, who was India's first education minister after independence. He was awarded Bharat Ratna posthumously, India's highest civilian honour in 1992. The theme for National Education Day 2022 is "Changing Course, Transforming Education."
- 39. World Usability Day 2022: "Our Health": Every year on the second Thursday of November, the world observes World Usability Day. The date is also mentioned on the UN calendar. World Usability Day, which will fall on November 10 this year, is also known as 'Make Things Easier' day. "Usability" is a quality that evaluates how efficiently and effectively a person can use a product, as well as how satisfied he or she is with the process. The theme of World Usability Day 2022 is "Our Health".
- **40.** Public Service Broadcasting Day observed on 12 November: Public Service Broadcasting Day is being celebrated on 12th November every year to commemorate the only visit of Mahatma Gandhi to All India Radio in Delhi in 1947. The day was declared as Public Service Broadcasting Day or (Jan Prasaran Diwas) in 2001, after it was conceptualised by Suhas Borker, Convenor, Jan Prasar.
- 41. World Pneumonia Day observed on 12 November: World Pneumonia Day is a global event observed every year on 12 November to spread awareness and educate people to combat Pneumonia disease, which is a world's biggest infectious killer of adults and children, responsible for the majority of death of children below five around the world. This year 2022, World Pneumonia Day theme is based on the Worldwide Pneumonia Awareness Campaign "Pneumolight 2022", with a theme and slogan "Pneumonia Affects Everyone",.

Rising Sun Water Fest 2022 was an initiative by the Indian Army's Eastern Command with the governments of Assam and Meghalaya.
- 43. Kishor K Basa named Chairman Of National Monuments Authority: Professor Kishor Kumar Basa has been appointed as the chairman of the National Monument Authority (NMA). The Department of Culture of the Government of India issued an official notification in this regard. He will have a tenure of three years. National Monuments Authority (NMA) under the Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India has been set up as per provisions of The Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Sites and Remains AMASR (Amendment and Validation) Act, 2010 which was enacted in March 2010.
- 44. Madhya Pradesh: Ujjain to Get World's First Vedic Clock: Madhya Pradesh's Ujjain, the city of Mahakal will soon boast the world's first Vedic clock which will be synced with the position of the Sun. After laying the foundation stone at the 300-year-old Jiwaji Observatory in Ujjain, the state higher education minister Mohan Yadav said through this project, people will become familiar with the Vedic time calculation.

- Law Commission Constituted After 4 Years; Justice Ritu Raj Awasthi Appointed As Chairperson: The central government appointed chairperson and members of the Law Commission over two and a half years after it was constituted. Retired Karnataka High Court Chief Justice Rituraj Awasthi appointed as the chairperson of the commission. Law Commission of India is neither a constitutional body nor a statutory body, it is an executive body established by an order of the Government of India. Its major function is to work for legal reforms. The Commission is established for a fixed tenure and works as an advisory body to the Ministry of Law and Justice. Its membership primarily comprises legal experts. The Law Commission is constituted for three years and the 22nd Law Commission was notified on February 24, 2020.
- 46. MoS Rajiv Chandrashekhar releases Two books on achievements and legacy of PM Modi: Two books on the achievements and legacy of Prime Minister Narendra Modi were released by Minister of State for Skill Development and Entrepreneurship Rajiv Chandrashekhar in Dubai. These "Modi@20: Dreams Meet Delivery" and "Heartfelt: The Legacy of Faith". The books were released at a programme of Vishwa Sadhbhavana, NID Foundation (Dubai chapter) to enhance and consolidate bonds of fraternity and solidarity among people in the US, Australia, and New Zealand.
- **47.** Rajasthan to Host Iconic 8-Day Long Pushkar Fair: This year, Pushkar Fair is being hosted by Rajasthan from 1st November to 9th November 2022. Pushkar Fair is also known as Pushkar Camel Fair, Kartik Mela, or Kartik ka Mela. The Pushkar Fair will be held without the popular cattle fair due to

the spread of lumpy skin disease in livestock. This year, the state tourism department has invited tourists from all over the world for the fair under the aegis of Pushkar Chalo Abhiyan.

- 48. VP Jagdeep Dhankhar to lead India at the ASEAN-India Commemorative Summit: Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar will attend the ASEAN India commemorative summit and the 17th East Asia Summit (EAS). The ASEAN India commemorative summit is being held in Cambodia from 11th November to 13th November 2022. The year 2022 marks the 30th anniversary of ASEAN-India relations and it will be celebrated as the ASEAN-India friendship year which makes it an important milestone.
- Vadodara issued first-ever municipal bond: Vadodara became the second city in India to issue a municipal bond with assistance from the US Treasury Department's Office of Technical Assistance. The US Embassy and US Treasury officials joined counterparts from India's Ministry of Housing and Urban Development, the city of Vadodara, and the Securities and Exchange Board to celebrate the successful issuance of Vadodara's first-ever municipal bond. Pune was the first city to issue such a bond in 2017. The bond will provide funds for infrastructure projects in Vadodara.
- Indian Navy participates Malabar Naval Exercise in Japan: India is participating in 26th International Malabar Naval Exercise begins in Yokosuka of Japan. In the Malabar Naval Exercise, Australia, Japan and the USA are also participating. The naval forces of these countries will take part in the exercise till the 18th of next month. Indian Naval Ships Shivalik and Kamorta are ready to demonstrate at the event. It started as a bilateral drill between the Indian Navy and the US Navy in the Indian Ocean. Japan became a permanent member of the exercise in 2015.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi unveils logo, theme and website of India's G20 presidency:

 Prime Minister Narendra Modi has unveiled India's logo, theme and website for its presidency of the G20, which reflects the country's message and overarching priorities to the world. The G20 logo, created with the four colours of India's national flag, comprises of earth sitting atop a lotus. The seven petals in the logo signify the seven seas and the coming together of seven continents at G20 India 2023. The earth reflects India's pro-planet approach to life and from this, it derives the theme of G20 India 2023 "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam: One Earth, One Family, One Future." The G20, or Group of 20, is an intergovernmental forum of the world's major developed and developing economies and represents about 85 per cent of the global GDP.

- 95. Shri Bhupender Yadav, Union Minister for Environment Forest and Climate Change said, "One of the key stakeholders are the youth of today. Developing an understanding of the LiFE among the younger generations is essential for fostering responsible consumption patterns and influencing the lifestyle choices of the generations to come to make them Pro-Planet-People."
- **96. G7 Nations Launched Climate 'Shield' Fund**: Global Shield Fund coordinated by G7's president Germany and the V20 group of climate-vulnerable countries, it aims to rapidly provide pre-arranged insurance and disaster protection funding after events such as floods, droughts and hurricanes hit. A G7-led plan dubbed "Global Shield" to provide funding to countries suffering climate disasters was launched at the U.N. COP27 summit, although some questioned the effectiveness of the planned scheme.

Uttar Pradesh To Register Maximum Number of New Companies After Maharashtra Post Covid: UP has added the most number of new companies after Maharashtra since the outbreak of Covid-19, beating industrial hubs such as Delhi, Karnataka and Tamil Nadu, data combined by the corporate affairs ministry (MCA) show.
- 102. German Bank 'KfW' to Provide 150 million Euro Loan to SBI for Solar Projects: State Bank of India has signed a 150 million euro (Rs 1,240 crore) loan agreement with the German development bank KfW for funding solar projects.
 - The long-term loan, under the Indo-German solar partnership, will facilitate new and upcoming capacities in the solar sector and further contribute to the country's goals announced during the COP26. In 2015, New Delhi and Berlin had signed a memorandum of understanding to foster solar energy through technical as well as financial cooperation.
- 103. International Gita Mahotsav to be organized at Haryana: International Gita Mahotsav is to be organized in Haryana from November 19 to December 6 at Kurukshetra. President Draupadi Murmu will attend this grand festival of Holy Gita. Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal said that the President will participate in the Gita Yagya at Brahma Sarovar.
- 104. Sandhya Devanathan Appointed as Meta's New India Head: Facebook-parent Meta has appointed Sandhya Devanathan as its new top executive for the country two weeks after the departure of former India head Ajit Mohan. Devanathan will transition to her new role on 1 January 2023. Devanathan currently serves as vice president of gaming for Meta's Asia-Pacific (APAC) division.
- 105. President Sh. Murmu appoints Dr CV Ananda Bose as Governor of West Bengal: President Droupadi Murmu has appointed Dr CV Ananda Bose as the Governor of West Bengal. Bose (71) is a 1977 batch (retired) Indian Administrative Service (IAS) officer of Kerala cadre. He last served as an

- administrator in the National Museum here before superannuating in 2011. Manipur Governor La Ganesan had been holding the additional charge of West Bengal since July this year after incumbent Jagdeep Dhankhar was nominated as the vice president.
- **106.** World Television Day 2022 observed on 21st November: World Television Day is observed on 21 November, every year. It is a day that recognizes the value and impact of television in our lives. We all know television plays a crucial role in society and in an individual's life.
- **107.** World Fisheries Day observed on 21st November: World Fisheries Day is annually celebrated on 21st November. This day is dedicated to highlighting the critical importance of healthy ocean ecosystems and to ensure sustainable stocks of fisheries in the world.
- International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women 2022: 25th November: The International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women is observed on November 25, every year. It is a day to pay tribute to the Mirabal sisters, the Dominican Republic activists who were murdered at the order of Rafael Trujillo in 1960. The 2022 theme of International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women is 'UNITE! Activism to End Violence against Women and Girls.'
- 109. India Celebrates National Milk Day on 26th November: National Milk Day is celebrated on the birth anniversary of Dr. Verghese Kurien, who is also known as the 'Father of White Revolution". The day was chosen as the National Milk Day by the dairy majors of the country including the National Dairy Development Board (NDDB), the Indian Dairy Association (IDA), along with the milk federation of 22 states.
- 110. Constitution Day of India: Constitution Day is celebrated on 26th November every year in India to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India. The constitution of India was adopted by the Constituent Assembly on 26th November 1949, and it came into effect on 26th January 1950. The Constitution of India is termed as 'of the people, for the people, and by the people.' The preamble of the Indian Constitution declared India as a sovereign, socialist, secular, democratic, republic, and the welfare state. Dr. B.R. Ambedkar was the chairman of the drafting committee of the Constituent Assembly. He was the first Minister of Law and Justice in India. The framing of the constitution took over 2 years, 11 months, and 17 days. The constituent assembly included 299 members and 15 were a woman.
- 111. November 28 is marked as Red Planet Day: Commemorating the day one of the most significant space missions to Mars was launched, November 28 is marked as Red Planet Day. After 3 previous attempts, Spacecraft Mariner 4 became the first successful flyby of Mars. The spacecraft was launched on November 28, 1964, and reached Mars on July 14, 1965. The successful mission produced 22 pictures of the Martian surface.
- 112. International Jaguar Day 2022: 29 November: International Jaguar Day was created to raise awareness about the increasing threats facing the jaguar and the critical conservation efforts ensuring its survival.

PM Modi to Inaugurate Arunachal's first Greenfield Airport Donyi Polo Airport: Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the first Greenfield airport in Arunachal Pradesh the Donyi Polo Airport at Itanagar and dedicated the 600 MW Kameng Hydro Power Station to the nation. Northeast India will now have 16 airports. The name of the airport reflects the traditions and rich cultural heritage of Arunachal Pradesh and the age-old indigenous reverence to the Sun ('Donyi') and the Moon ('Polo') in the state. The foundation stone for this airport was laid by the PM in 2019. The Donyi Polo airport will be the third operational airport in Arunachal Pradesh and the first in its capital city Itanagar, taking the total number of airports in the Northeast to 16. Arunachal Pradesh currently has two airports, one at Pasighat and the other at Tezu.
- 114. CEC Shri Rajiv Kumar Invited as International Observer for Elections in Nepal: Chief Election Commissioner Rajiv Kumar has been invited by the Election Commission of Nepal as an international observer for the forthcoming elections to Nepal's House of Representatives and Provincial Assembly. Elections are scheduled in Nepal on 20 November to elect 275 members of the Federal Parliament and 550 seats of the seven Provincial Assemblies.
- 115. Bandaru Wilsonbabu named as the Ambassador of India to Comoros: Indian Foreign Service (2004), Shri Bandaru Wilsonbabu, presently Ambassador of India to the Republic of Madagascar, has been concurrently accredited as the next Ambassador of India to the Union of the Comoros, with residence in Antananarivo. He is expected to take up the assignment shortly. The Comoros is an independent country made up of 3 islands in southeastern Africa. The Comoros is a volcanic archipelago off Africa's east coast, in the warm Indian Ocean waters of the Mozambique Channel.

- 116. India won Excellence in Family Planning Leadership (EXCELL) Award: India became the only country to receive the Leadership in Family Planning (EXCELL) Awards 2022 in the 'country category' at the International Conference on Family Planning held in Thailand. India's efforts in improving family planning demonstrate the progress the country has been making toward achieving the SDG targets on women and maternal health. The adoption of modern contraceptive methods and significantly reducing the unmet needs for family planning.
- 117. India Launches Official Website And Theme of SCO 2023: India has launched the official website of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) as it will host the next SCO summit as a chairman of organisation in 2023. The theme of the event is "For a SECURE SCO". Prime Minister Narendra Modi had floated the concept of SECURE at the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) summit in China in 2018. Explaining the SECURE concept, the Prime Minister said 'S' for security for citizens, 'E' for economic development, 'C' for connectivity in the region, 'U' for unity, 'R' for respect of sovereignty and integrity, and 'E for environment protection. India received the SCO rotating presidency in Samarkand, Uzbekistan. India will hold the presidency of the grouping for a year until September 2023.

- 120. Network Readiness Index 2022: India ranked 61st::India has moved up by six slots to improve its position and rank 61st as per the Network Readiness Index 2022 (NRI 2022) report prepared by a US-based Portulans Institute, an independent non-profit research and educational institute. In a statement issued by the Telecom Ministry, it was stated that India's overall score has improved to 51.19 in 2022 from 49.74 in 2021. The NRI 2022 report ranks a total of 131 economies that together account for about 95 per cent of the global Gross Domestic Product (GDP). The United States ranks first on the list, with an overall score of 80.3. Singapore comes in second with a score of 79.35, and Sweden comes in third with a score of 78.91. Singapore leads Asia Pacific, followed by South Korea and Japan.
- 121. Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar attends FIFA world cup inauguration in Qatar: Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar has joined the Emir of Qatar Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al Thani and other dignitaries in the inauguration of FIFA World Cup in Qatar. Qatar Capital: Doha; Qatar Currency: Qatari Riyal.
- 122. 13th bilateral naval exercise Naseem Al Bahr-2022: 13th bilateral naval exercise Naseem Al Bahr-2022. The exercise is being conducted in two phases: the Harbour Phase and the Sea Phase. The Indian Navy's guided missile frigate Trikand and Offshore Patrol Vessel Sumitra, with their integral helicopters, and the maritime patrol aircraft, Dornier, are participating in the exercise.
- 123. HDFC Bank, Canara Bank Get RBI Approval for Rupee Trade with Russia: The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) allowed HDFC Bank Ltd and Canara Bank Ltd to open a special "vostro account" for trade in Rupees with Russia. This paves the way for cross-border trade in the Indian currency, especially between New Delhi and Moscow. Three other Indian banks State Bank of India, IndusInd Bank and UCO Bank had earlier received the necessary permissions from the regulator to roll out rupee trades. In July, the central bank had introduced a new arrangement for settling international trades in rupees. The mechanism, enabling the invoicing, payment and settlement of exports and imports in

rupees, is aimed at promoting trade. It would also restrict dollar outflows at a time when the local unit has been depreciating.

- 124. Russia Replaces China to Become the Biggest Supplier of Fertilizers to India: Russia has become India's biggest fertilizer supplier for the first time. Russian exporters reportedly grabbed a 21% share of the Indian fertilizer market in the first half of the 2022-23 fiscal year, overtaking China, previously India's largest supplier.Russian exports reportedly surged 371%, to a record 2.15 million tons from April to October.
- 125. Manika Batra: First Indian woman to win medal at Asian Cup Table Tennis: Manika Batra, the Indian Table Tennis player, became the first Indian woman to win a medal at the Asian Cup Table Tennis Tournament. Manika defeated World no.6 Hina Hayata of Japan in the Asian Cup 2022 in the women's singles bronze medal match in Bangkok, Thailand. Asian Cup Table Tennis Tournament is an annual competition which is held by the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF) and the Asian Table Tennis Union. The first edition of the Asian Cup Table Tennis Tournament was held in 1983.
- Handbook of Statistics on Indian States, 2021-22": The seventh edition of the Handbook of Statistics on Indian States 2021-22 is released by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI). Which seeks to provide comprehensive data about the regional economies of India. It covers subnational statistics on socio-demographics, state domestic product, agriculture, price and wages, industry, infrastructure, banking, and fiscal indicators across the states during various time periods ranging from 1951 to 2021-22. Two new sections have been included in the recent edition health and environment. Key Findings Of The Report: The Indian economy showed remarkable resilience to multiple consecutive shocks it experienced since early 2020. Karnataka has the highest total installed capacity of grid-interactive renewable power among all states. It had total installed capacity of 15,463 megawatts (MW). Tamil Nadu has remained the top state in India with the maximum number of factories including micro, small and mid-sized units followed by Gujarat, Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh, and Uttar Pradesh in the top-five bracket on a list of 36 states and union territories across India.
- 127. Manipur Sangai Festival 2022 Commenced in the State: The Sangai Festival of Manipur begins, it is the largest tourism festival in Manipur. The festival is named after the State Animal which is found only in Manipur have been organized grandly this time after the COVID-19 pandemic hit the festival in the last two years. The theme of the festival is the 'festival of oneness'. The ten days festival is expected to attract tourists to Manipur.
- 128. India's Purnima Devi Barman is one of UNEP's 'Champions of the Earth' for 2022: India's Purnima Devi Barman, an Assam-based wildlife biologist, is one of the five 'Champions of the Earth' for this year, the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) announced. The annual awards are the highest environmental honour that the UNEP confers on individuals and organisations whose actions have a "transformative impact" on the environment. The other honourees include Arcenciel

UNEP said that since its inception in 2005, the annual Champions of the Earth award has been awarded to trailblazers at the forefront of efforts to protect our natural world. It is the UN's highest environmental honour.

- **129.** Mumbai Becomes the First City in South Asia to Top CDP's Climate Action List: Mumbai has become the first Indian city to be added to the A-list in the 5th Annual Cities Report published by CDP, a non-profit organisation that runs the world's environmental disclosure system for companies, cities, states, and regions recognises the important role that cities play in taking bold actions to mitigate and adopt to climate change. Mumbai announced detailed plans to zero out carbon emissions by 2050, a target that puts it two decades ahead of India's national goal and makes it the first city in South Asia to set such a timeline.
- 130. Tenzing Norgay National Adventure Awards 2021 Announced by GoI: The Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India announced the National Adventure Award called "Tenzing Norgay Adventure Award" (TNNAA) for the year 2021. The award is given in four categories which are Land Adventure, Water Adventure, Air Adventure, and Life Time Achievement. The awardees will receive their awards from the President of India along with other Sports Awardees at the Rashtrapati Bhawan on 30th November 2022.

- 132. Groundnut Festival 'Kadalekai Parishe' begins in Karnataka: The annual festival of 'Kadalekai Parishe', also known as the groundnut festival, Kadalekai Parishe is a fair held in the month of Kartik near Basavanagudi in Bengaluru. It happens near the Dodda Ganesha temple and the Bull Temple at Basavanagudi. This year, over 3,000 people from other parts of Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, and also Tamil Nadu took part in the festivities that welcomed the first seasonal yield of the groundnut crop.
- 133. Tata to Acquire Packaged Water Giant Bisleri for About ₹7,000 Crore: Tata Consumer is set to acquire India's largest packaged drinking water company, Bisleri, for an estimated Rs 6,000-7,000 crore. Chairman Ramesh Chauhan is aiming to disinvest Bisleri International to Tata Consumer Products three decades after selling soft drink brands Thums Up, Gold Spot and Limca to Coca-Cola. Several companies including Coca-Cola India through its brand Kinley, PepsiCo's Aquafina, Bailley from Parle Agro and Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation (IRCTC)'s Rail Neer compete in the segment but they all trail the market leader Bisleri.
