Kindness has no constraints and goes far beyond the feelings of race, religion, politics, and gender. This year the day is being celebrated with the theme is 'Be kind whenever possible.'
- 2. India celebrates Happy Children's Day on November 14: India celebrates Happy Children's Day on November 14 to commemorate the birth anniversary of the first Prime Minister of India Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru. This year marks the 133rd birth anniversary of Pandit Nehru who was born in 1889 in Allahabad, India. Earlier, Children's Day was celebrated in India on November 20, the day World Children's Day is celebrated by the United Nations.
- 3. World Diabetes Day observed on 14th November: World Diabetes Day is observed on November 14 every year to bring the attention of the people to health threats posed by diabetes and how to avoid that. On this day, the enormous achievement of insulin discovery by two outstanding scientists, Sir Frederick Banting and Charles Best, is celebrated. The theme of World Diabetes Day between the years 2021 and 2023 is a really important topic is "Access to Diabetes Care."

National Epilepsy Day Observed On 17 November: Each year, on November 17, National Epilepsy Day is marked in India to raise awareness of the condition. National Epilepsy Day 2022 is observed to raise public awareness of epilepsy. To raise awareness of the causes and symptoms of epilepsy, numerous governmental and non-governmental organisations will mark National Epilepsy Day in 2022. A persistent brain illness called epilepsy is marked by periodic "fits" or "seizures." Every year, November is observed as the Epilepsy Awareness Month to educate and aware people about the signs, symptoms and impact of this dreadful disease. India recognizes 17th of November as National Epilepsy Day to raise awareness about Epilepsy.

Notably: International Epilepsy Day is observed every year on the Second Monday of February across the world. In 2022, International Epilepsy Day falls on February 14, 2022. According to the Epilepsy Foundation, the theme of National Epilepsy Awareness Month (NEAM) 2022 is "**There is no NEAM without ME**".

10. World Antimicrobial Awareness Week: 18-24 November 2022: World Antimicrobial Awareness Week (WAAW) runs from 18 to 24 November every year. It's an international initiative to increase awareness of the growing problem of resistance to antibiotics and other antimicrobial medicines. - 11. 5th Naturopathy Day is celebrated on 18 November 2022: National Naturopathy Day is observed in India every year on November 18th, to promote positive mental and physical health through drug-free therapy. The Theme for this year's event is "Naturopathy: an Integrative medicine".
- **12.** World Toilet Day 2022 observed on 19 November: The United Nations observes World Toilet Day on November 19 annually. The main aim is to raise public awareness of broader sanitation systems such as wastewater treatment, stormwater management, and hand washing. The 2022 theme is 'Making the Invisible Visible' and explores how inadequate sanitation systems spread human waste into rivers, lakes and soil, polluting underground water resources.
- 13. World Children's Day 2022 celebrates on 20 November: World Children's Day is celebrated on November 20 annually. The day aims to promote international togetherness and awareness among children as well as to improve their welfare. The theme for International children's day is, "Inclusion, for every child".
- 14. Centre Approves BSNL Rs 26,821 Crore 4G Deal with TCS: Bharat Sanchar Nigam Ltd (BSNL) received a nod from Central Government to go ahead with Rs 26,821 crore deal with Tata Consultancy

Services (TCS) paving its way to launch 4G services in India. TCS is ready to set up the 4G lines and maintain the network for nine years. BSNL will give Rs 10,000 crore worth of purchase orders to TCS soon. The state-run telco will aim to launch its 4G services by December 2022 or January 2023.

15. Bhopal Railway Station awarded 4-star rating 'Eat Right Station' certification: The Food Safety and Standard Association of India (FSSAI) awarded Bhopal Railway Station a 4-star 'Eat Right Station' certification for providing "high-quality, nutritious food to passengers". Railway stations are awarded the certificate after an FSSAI-empaneled third-party audit agency rates them on a scale of 1 to 5 for food storage and hygiene practices.

- 16. DigiLocker Users can Now Digitally Store Health Records and Link Them With Ayushman Bharat Health Account (ABHA): The secure cloud-based storage platform of DigiLocker can be used now as a health locker for storing and accessing health records such as vaccination records, doctor prescriptions, lab reports, hospital discharge summaries etc, stated NHA. In addition to this, ABHA holders can also link their health records from different ABDM registered health facilities like hospitals and labs and access them via DigiLocker. Users can also scan and upload their old health records on the app. DigiLocker, It is an authentic documents exchange platform under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology. DigiLocker had earlier completed level 1 integration with ABDM wherein the platform had added ABHA or Ayushman Bharat Health Account creation facility for its 13 crore users.
- 17. India Announces Additional Contribution of '\$ 5 million' to ASEAN-India S & T Fund: The announcement came during the three-day visit of Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar to Cambodia for ASEAN-India and East Asia summits. He addressed the ASEAN-India summit. Vice President Dhankhar highlighted the global concerns on food and energy security, and emphasised the role of the East Asia Summit (EAS) mechanism in promoting free, open and inclusive Indo-Pacific with freedom of navigation and overflight. ASEAN-India Science & Technology Collaboration formally started in 1996 with the establishment of the ASEAN India S&T working group (AIWGST). The motto of ASEAN is "One Vision, One Identity, One Community". 8th August is observed as ASEAN Day. ASEAN Secretariat is situated in Jakarta, Indonesia.
- 18. India to Build its First Hydrogen Fuel Cell Catamaran Vessel: Cochin Shipyard signed an MoU with the Inland Waterways Authority of India to build the country's first hydrogen fuel cell catamaran vessel for Varanasi in Uttar Pradesh. Another MoU was signed by the Shipyard for the construction of six electric catamaran vessels for Uttar Pradesh and two more such vessels for Guwahati.
- 19. 7th Edition of Amur Falcon Festival Celebrated in Manipur: The Manipur Forest Authority to celebrate the 7th edition of the Amur Falcon Festival in Tamenglong district, Imphal. The objective of the Amur Falcon Festival is to spread awareness about the protection and conservation of the Amur Falcon. Amur Falcon is the world's longest-flying migratory bird.

- **20.** New Zealand's Greg Barclay unanimously re-elected as Chairman of ICC for 2 year: New Zealand's Greg Barclay unanimously re-elected as the International Cricket Council (ICC) chairman for another two-year term after his rival, Zimbabwe Cricket (ZC) chairman Tavengwa Mukuhlani, pulled out of the contest late. Barclay, who served his first stint as ICC chair between 2022 and this November, will now be in the position until 2024.
- 21. Union Bank of India rings 104th Foundation Day with launch of Vyom App: The country's fifth largest public sector bank, Union Bank of India, marked its 104th foundation day on 11 November 2022, after being founded on 11 November 1919 and having its first head office inaugurated by the Father of the Nation, Mahatma Gandhi. On this occasion, the bank introduced a super app called Union Vyom, as well as several other digital products. Union Bank of India Founded: 11 November 1919, Mumbai.
- **22.** Kerala Tourism won "Responsible Tourism Global award" at the World Travel Mart: The Kerala Tourism has bagged the prestigious Responsible Tourism Global award at the World Travel Mart held in London. State Tourism Minister PA Mohammed Riyas received the award on behalf of the department at London. The award was given for the STREET project implemented by the Responsible Tourism Mission under the Kerala Government.

- 23. Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports announced National Sports Awards 2022: Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports announced the National Sports Awards 2022. The awardees will receive their awards from the President of India at a specially organized function at Rashtrapati Bhavan on 30th November, 2022. National Sports Awards are given every year to recognize and reward excellence in sports.

- 24. 41st India International Trade Fair begins in New Delhi: The 41st edition of the India International Trade Fair (IITF) has started at Pragati Maidan in New Delhi. Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal inaugurated the fair. The fair will continue till the 27th of this month. During the inauguration ceremony, Minister of State for Commerce and Trade Anupriya Patel and Som Parkash were also present. This year the theme of the trade fair is Vocal For Local, Local to Global.NITI Aayog Member (Health) Dr V K Paul inaugurated the Health Pavilion at the 41st India International Trade Fair in New Delhi today. The theme of this year's pavilion of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare is- Heal in India, Heal by India.
- **25.** Wangala Festival: 100 Drum Festival of Meghalaya: Wangala Festival of Meghalaya is one of the most popular festivals among the Garos of Meghalaya. Wangala Festival is a harvest festival that is held in honor of Saljong, the Sun-God of fertility. The celebrations of the Wangala Festival mark the end of a period of toil, which brings good output to the fields.

- **26.** Reliance Industries to make India's first multimodal logistics park in Chennai: According to the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH), Reliance Industries Ltd (RIL) has been awarded the project to build India's first multimodal logistics park (MMLP) in Chennai, Tamil Nadu. A crucial cog in the Centre's logistics overhaul, the MMLP will be spread over 184 acres and cost Rs 1,424 crore. Reliance Industries Limited (RIL) CMD: Mukesh Ambani.
- 27. Natasa Pirc Musar Elected Slovenia's First Female President: Natasa Pirc Musar, won the second round of Slovenia's Presidential elections. Natasa Pirc Musar becomes the first female President of the country. She won 58.86 percent of votes in the runoff, while the opposition right-wing politician and the former Foreign Minister Andze Logar won 46.14 percent of votes.
- 28. ASEAN Agreed to Admit East Timor as 11th member: The Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) has agreed in principle to admit East Timor as the group's 11th member, the 10 member-bloc said in a statement, more than a decade after the country requested membership. The half-island nation, officially called Timor Leste, will also be granted observer status at high-level ASEAN meetings, the bloc said after regional leaders met in Phnom Penh for a summit. The country would be the first new member of the regional grouping in more than two decades, since Cambodia was admitted in 1999. We agreed in principle to admit Timor Leste to be the 11th member of ASEAN," the statement said, adding that next steps would include a "roadmap for full membership" to be submitted at next year's summit.
- 29. U-19 Men's T-20 World Cup 2024 to be Hosted by Sri Lanka: International Cricket Council (ICC) has announced the venue for Under-19 Men's and Women's T-20 World cup. ICC announced that the 2024 Under -19 men's T-20 World Cup will be hosted by Sri Lanka while the 2026 edition will be staged in Zimbabwe and Namibia. The 2025 Under -19 women's T20 World Cup will be held in Malaysia and Thailand, and 2027 Under -19 women's event will be jointly hosted by Bangladesh and Nepal.
- 30. India Hosts LeadIT Summit with Sweden at COP27 in Egypt: India and Sweden hosted the LeadIT Summit, on the sidelines of COP27 at Sharm El Sheikh in Egypt. The Leadership for Industry Transition- LeadIT initiative focuses on low carbon transition of the hard to abate industrial sector.LeadIT was launched by the Prime Ministers of Sweden and India with support from the World Economic Forum (WEF) during the UN Secretary-General's Climate Action Summit in 2019, in New York.
- 31. "In Our LiFEtime" Campaign Launched by India at COP 27: National Museum of Natural History (NMNH), under the Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate Change and United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), jointly launched "In Our LiFEtime" campaign. Shri Bhupender Yadav, Union Minister for Environment Forest and Climate Change said, "One of the key stakeholders are the youth of today. Developing an understanding of the LiFE among the younger generations is essential for fostering responsible consumption patterns and influencing the lifestyle choices of the generations to come to make them Pro-Planet-People."

- **32. G7 Nations Launched Climate 'Shield' Fund** : Global Shield Fund coordinated by G7's president Germany and the V20 group of climate-vulnerable countries, it aims to rapidly provide pre-arranged insurance and disaster protection funding after events such as floods, droughts and hurricanes hit. A G7-led plan dubbed "Global Shield" to provide funding to countries suffering climate disasters was launched at the U.N. COP27 summit, although some questioned the effectiveness of the planned scheme.
- 33. Climate Change Performance Index 2023: India ranked 8th in the list: The Climate Change Performance Index (CCPI) 2023 released which was published by three environmental non-governmental organizations viz. Germanwatch, NewClimate Institute and the Climate Action Network (CAN) International. India rose two spots to rank eighth out of 63 countries in the Climate Change Performance Index 2023 (CCPI).
- 34. India Becomes the World's Second Largest Producer of Steel: India has emerged as the second-largest producer of crude steel by replacing Japan. The biggest steel producing country is currently China, which accounted for 57% of world steel production the Government of India has launched the Purvodaya programme which aims accelerated the development of eastern India through the establishment of an integrated steel hub.
- 35. National Commission for Women Launched Digital Shakti 4.0: The National Commission for Women (NCW) launched the fourth phase of the Digital Shakti Campaign, a pan-India project on digitally empowering and skilling women and girls in cyberspace. Digital Shakti started in June 2018 to help women across the nation to raise the awareness level on the digital front, to build resilience, and fight cyber-crime in the most effective ways. The Digital Shakti 4.0 is focused on making women digitally skilled and aware to stand-up against any illegal/inappropriate activity online. NCW launched the campaign in collaboration with CyberPeace Foundation and Meta.
- 36. Ex-Chief Economic Advisor Arvind Virmani named as full-time member of NITI Aayog: Former Chief Economic Advisor, Arvind Virmani has been appointed as a full time member of NITI Aayog. The other existing Members of NITI Aayog are VK Saraswat, Ramesh Chand and VK Paul. While Suman Bery is the Vice Chairman of NITI Aayog, Parameswaran is the incumbent CEO of the think tank.
- 37. Uttar Pradesh To Register Maximum Number of New Companies After Maharashtra Post Covid: UP has added the most number of new companies after Maharashtra since the outbreak of Covid-19, beating industrial hubs such as Delhi, Karnataka and Tamil Nadu, data combined by the corporate affairs ministry (MCA) show.
- 38. German Bank 'KfW' to Provide 150 million Euro Loan to SBI for Solar Projects: State Bank of India has signed a 150 million euro (Rs 1,240 crore) loan agreement with the German development bank KfW for funding solar projects.
 - The long-term loan, under the Indo-German solar partnership, will facilitate new and upcoming capacities in the solar sector and further contribute to the country's goals announced during the

COP26. In 2015, New Delhi and Berlin had signed a memorandum of understanding to foster solar energy through technical as well as financial cooperation.

- 39. International Gita Mahotsav to be organized at Haryana: International Gita Mahotsav is to be organized in Haryana from November 19 to December 6 at Kurukshetra. President Draupadi Murmu will attend this grand festival of Holy Gita. Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal said that the President will participate in the Gita Yagya at Brahma Sarovar.
- 40. Sandhya Devanathan Appointed as Meta's New India Head : Facebook-parent Meta has appointed Sandhya Devanathan as its new top executive for the country two weeks after the departure of former India head Ajit Mohan. Devanathan will transition to her new role on 1 January 2023. Devanathan currently serves as vice president of gaming for Meta's Asia-Pacific (APAC) division.
- 41. President Sh. Murmu appoints Dr CV Ananda Bose as Governor of West Bengal: President Droupadi Murmu has appointed Dr CV Ananda Bose as the Governor of West Bengal. Bose (71) is a 1977 batch (retired) Indian Administrative Service (IAS) officer of Kerala cadre. He last served as an administrator in the National Museum here before superannuating in 2011. Manipur Governor La Ganesan had been holding the additional charge of West Bengal since July this year after incumbent Jagdeep Dhankhar was nominated as the vice president.
