IMPORTANT DAYS

- 1. International Human Solidarity Day 2022: December 20: International Human Solidarity Day (IHSD) is observed annually on December 20 across the globe to celebrate the ideal of unity in diversity. IHSD highlights the goal of the United Nations and its member states to create awareness about poverty and the need to reduce poverty in independent nations.
- National Mathematics Day 2022 celebrates on 22 December: National Mathematics Day is celebrated on December 22 across the nation every year. The National Mathematics Day is marked to recognise and celebrate the works of Srinivasa Ramanujan. Srinivasa Ramanujan, the Indian mathematical genius, was born on this day in 1887. This year nation celebrates his 135th birth anniversary of Ramanujan.
- 2nd Good Governance Week 19th to 25th December 2022 :: The 2nd Good Governance Week (Sushasan Saptah) is being observed from 19th to 25th December 2022 by the Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DARPG), Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions. Background: Good Governance Week 2021 was celebrated as a part of the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav celebration, from 20th to 26th December 2021.
- 4. Kisan Diwas or National Farmers Day 2022 December 23 :: Kisan Diwas, also known as National Farmers Day, is annually observed across India on December 23 to recognise and honour the major role of farmers in the growth and development of India. The day also marks the birth anniversary of Chaudhary Charan Singh, a farmers' leader who became India's 5th Prime Minister (PM) (1979-1980). National Farmers Day 2022 marks the 120th birth anniversary of Chaudhary Charan Singh.
- National Consumer Day 2022 December 24: National Consumer Day or Bhartiya Grahak Diwas is annually observed across India on December 24 to create awareness about consumer rights and responsibilities. The day also aims to protect consumers from market exploitation like defective products or expensive pricing. National Consumer Day is also known as National Consumer Rights Day.
- 6. National Good Governance Day 2022 December 25: i. Good Governance Day, also known as Sushasan Diwas in Hindi, is annually observed across India on 25th December to mark the birth anniversary of the former Prime Minister (PM) Late Atal Bihari Vajpayee. 25th December 2022 marks the 98th birth anniversary of Atal Bihari Vajpayee. In 2014, The Government of India declared the 25th December of every year, the birth anniversary of Atal Bihari Vajpayee, as Good Governance Day.

NATIONAL NEWS

1. IEA Annual Report: India's Coal Production to Exceed a Billion Tonnes by 2025: The International Energy Agency (IEA) in its annual report titled 'Coal 2022: Analysis and Forecast to 2025', claimed that China and India, the world's two largest coal consumers, are also the world's

largest producers and top two coal importers. It is projected that by 2025, India's coal production will exceed 1 billion tonnes. i. India is expected to continue to be the growth driver of global coal demand as its coal consumption has risen since 2007 at an annual growth rate of 6%.

- ii. According to the report, global coal consumption would climb by 1.2% in 2022, surpassing 8 billion metric tonnes in a single year for the first time and beating the milestone set in 2013.
- India Launches 'Group of Friends' to Promote Accountability for Crimes against Peacekeepers: India, the President of the United Nations Security Council (UNSC), has launched a 'Group of Friends' to promote accountability for crimes against peacekeepers. While addressing the launch event, Subrahmanyam Jaishankar, Union Minister of External Affairs announced that New Delhi will have a database that will record all crimes against the UN Peacekeepers (Blue Helmets). The cochairs of the 'Group of Friends' are India, Bangladesh, Egypt, France, Morocco and Nepal. India, among the largest troop-contributing countries to UN peacekeeping, which has lost around 177 peacekeepers in the line of duty and is notably the largest among other countries. i. Peacekeeping is one of the key tools that is available with the UNSC to maintain international peace and security.
- 3. MP gets India's 1st & World's 2nd Infantry Museum at Mhow Cantonment, Indore: On 16th December 2022, the eve of 75 years of raising of the Infantry School and to commemorate the Vijay Diwas, India's first & World's 2nd Infantry Research Centre and Museum was inaugurated in the Mhow cantonment in Indore district, Madhya Pradesh(MP). About Infantry Research Centre and Museum: i. The museum is housed in a 3 storied building spread across a 2-acre land. The project is developed in 3 phases. ii. The construction of the research centre and museum began in 2009 and was completed in 2019.
- 4. 2022 Social Progress Index: Norway Tops Globally, India Ranks 110th, Puducherry tops in India :: i. The Institute for Competitiveness released the annual 2022 Social Progress Index (SPI) which was published by Social Progress Imperative. India secured a global rank of 110 with score of 60.19 in Tier 4 countries. ii. The index is topped by Norway with a score of 90.74 in Tier-1 countries i.e. high income countries. iii. The SPI 2022 for States and Districts made by the Institute for Competitiveness and Social Progress Imperative was submitted to Economic Advisory Council- Prime Minister (EAC-PM).
- Tentative List of UNESCO World Heritage Sites Now Includes Vadnagar Town, Modhera Sun Temple & Unakoti Sculptures: According to the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI), 3 new Cultural Sites in India have been added to the provisional list of United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) World Heritage sites. They are as follows: Sun Temple, Modhera, Gujarat and its adjoining monuments Vadnagar A multi-layered Historic town, Gujarat, which is also the birthplace of Prime Minister (PM) Narendra Modi Rock-cut Sculptures and Reliefs of the Unakoti, Unakoti Range, Unakoti District, Tripura i. With this addition, India currently has 52 sites on the UNESCO Tentative List. ii. So far in 2022, 6 Indian sites have been included to the tentative list. iii. There are 40 sites in India that have been designated as UNESCO World Heritage Sites. About the

- United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization (UNESCO): Director-General Audrey Azoulay, Established 1945 (came into force in 1946), Headquarters Paris, France.
- 6. Ministry of Ayush: The Status of Centres of Excellence Scheme 'AYURSWASTHYA Yojana: On 20th December 2022, the Ministry of Ayush (Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homeopathy) issued a notification regarding the status of the centres of excellence scheme 'AYURSWASTHYA Yojana'. AYURSWASTHYA Yojana, a Central Sector Scheme under the Ministry of Ayush is currently run with 2 components AYUSH and Public Health (PHI) & Centre of Excellence (CoE) from the Financial Year (FY) 2021-2022 by merging two erstwhile schemes of AYUSH Ministry.
- Jyotiraditya Scindia Launches India's First Green Steel Brand "KALYANI FeRRESTA": On 20th December 2022 Union Minister of Steel, Jyotiraditya Scindia launched India's first Green Steel Brand, "KALYANI FeRRESTA" in New Delhi. This was manufactured by a Saarloha Advanced Materials (Saarloha) Pune-based Kalyani group company, by using renewable energy resources, leaving zero carbon footprints in the environment. India is presently leading the countries which have committed to achieving carbon neutrality, with ongoing green steel manufacturing. i. Sweden was the 1st country in the world to manufacture fossil-free steel which is also known as green steel. ii. The world's first green steel was delivered by Swedish steelmaker SSAB Oxelösund to Volvo Group.
- **8.** GIXI: IGX launches India's First Gas Price Index :: On December 20, 2022, the Indian Gas Exchange (IGX) launched GIXI, the first ever, nationwide price index to reflect benchmark natural gas prices for India. This launch is on the lines with international benchmarks such as JKM (Japan Korea Marker), HH (Henry Hub), WIM (West India Marker), TTF (Dutch). It was launched by Tarun Kapoor, former petroleum secretary and advisor to Prime Minister of India during an event in New Delhi, Delhi. It will reflect the volume-weighted average price for all gas traded and also represent the gas prices at the Western and Southern hubs. About Indian Gas Exchange (IGX): Promoted by the Indian Energy Exchange (IEX), it is India's first automated national level Gas Exchange. Managing Director & CEO-Rajesh Kumar Mediratta Headquarters- Noida, Uttar Pradesh Establishment- 2020.
- Bank: The 19th meeting of the Experts and Coordinators of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization Interbank Consortium (SCO-IBC), the first to be held under India's presidency, came to an end in New Delhi, Delhi. The SCO IBC will be led by India Infrastructure Finance Company Limited (IIFCL) from October 26 to October 25, 2023. The SCO-IBC is presided over by Pawan Kumar, Deputy Managing Director of IIFCL. i. During the summit, it was determined to establish a data bank, work toward the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), and undertake climate financing initiatives. iv. Recently, Prime Minister (PM) Narendra Modi attended the 22nd SCO Summit, which took place on September 15-16, 2022, in Samarkand, Uzbekistan. The SCO Presidency for the upcoming years 2022–2023 was transferred from Uzbekistan to India during the summit.
- 10. UP's Sania Mirza is about to become India's 1st Muslim Woman Fighter Pilot : Sania Mirza from Mirzapur, Uttar Pradesh, who cleared the National Defence Academy (NDA) exam and secured 149th

rank, is set to become India's 1st Muslim female fighter pilot in the Indian Air Force (IAF) and UP's 1st IAF pilot. On 27th December 2022, she will join NDA Khadakwasla in Pune, Maharashtra. **Note:** The NDA exam was held to fill 400 seats, 19 of which were reserved for women candidates. 2 of these 19 seats were reserved for fighter pilots.

Union Cabinet Approves Revision of Pension of Armed Forces Pensioners/Family Pensioners Under OROP: The Union Cabinet, chaired by Prime Minister (PM) Narendra Modi, approved the revision of the pension of Armed Forces pensioners and family pensioners under the One Rank One Pension (OROP) scheme, effective July 1, 2019, at an annual additional expenditure of Rs. 8,450 crore and arrears of Rs. 23,638 crore. Pensions of former retirees would be revised based on the average of the minimum and maximum pensions of Defence Forces retirees of the same rank and service period in calendar year 2018.

INTERNATIONAL NEWS

- 1. Highlights of 2022 UN Biodiversity Conference held in Montreal, Quebec, Canada: i. From December 7 19, 2022, the United Nations (UN) Biodiversity Conference was held in Montreal, Quebec, Canada to acknowledge new set of goals to guide global action through 2030 in order to prevent nature loss. ii. It comprised of the 15th meeting of the Conference of the Parties (COP 15) to the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD), 10th Meeting of the Parties to the Cartagena Protocol on Biosafety (Cartagena Protocol COP/MOP 10), and the 4th meeting of the Parties to the Nagoya Protocol on Access and Benefit-sharing (Nagoya Protocol COP/MOP 4). iii. The president of COP15 was China. iv. India was represented by Union Minister Bhupender Yadav, Ministry of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change (MoEF&CC). i. The framework envisages to protect 30% of land and 30% of coastal and marine areas by 2030, up from an earlier aim of 20%. It will fulfill the deal's highest-profile goal, known as 30-by-30. Currently, such protection covers 17% of land.

 India has improved its position in the global ranking of scientific publications from 7th in 2010 to 3rd in
 - India has improved its position in the global ranking of scientific publications from 7th in 2010 to 3rd in 2020, according to the "Science & Engineering Indicators 2022" report by the National Science Foundation (NSF) of the United States (US). The amount of scholarly output produced in India has increased, going from 60,555 papers in 2010 to 1,49,213 papers in 2020.
- 3. Forbes: PV Sindhu World's 12th Highest Paid Female Athlete in 2022; only indian and badminton player on top 25: Forbes' World's Highest-Paid Female Athletes: i. The Forbes ranking World's Highest-Paid Female Athletes 2022 of the highest-paid female athletes reflects earnings from the calendar year 2022. i. Pusarla Venkata Sindhu, known as PV Sindhu is hailing from Hyderabad, Telangana. ii. She is the first and only Indian to become the BWF World Championships in 2019 and only the second individual athlete from India to win two consecutive medals at the Olympic Games. She was honoured with Arjuna Award in 2013 and Major Dhyan Chand Khel Ratna Award in

2016. Government of India honoured her with Padma Shri in 2015 and Padma Bhushan in 2020 for sports. According to the Forbes's World's Highest-Paid Female Athletes 2022, Indian Badminton player PV Sindhu is ranked 12th with a total earning of USD 7.1 million (0.1 million on-field and USD 7 million off-field). She is the only Indian and the only badminton player among the top 25 of the list.

- 7. NSE receives SEBI's in-principle approval to set up Social Stock Exchange as a Separate Segment: Mumbai (Maharashtra) based National Stock Exchange of India (NSE) has received in-principle approval from the Securities Exchange Board of India (SEBI) to set up Social Stock Exchange (SSE) as a separate segment of the NSE. SSE was proposed in the Union Budget of 2019-20 to create a platform for listing social enterprises and voluntary organizations. This exchange will enable social enterprises to raise capital through equity or debt instruments. i. To enable fundraising through SSE for not-for-profit organizations (NPOs), the government introduced 'zero coupon zero principal' under the Securities Contracts Regulations Act, 1956.
- 8. IMF Projects 6.8 percent Growth in Current Fiscal for India: On 23rd December 2022 the International Monetary Fund (IMF) in its Article IV consultation report projected a growth rate of 6.8 percent in the current fiscal year (FY23) and falling to 6.1 percent for India in the next fiscal year (FY24).

Google partners DigiLocker to bring On-Device Storing of Government IDs: On 19th December 2022, during the Google for India 2022 (8th edition) conference, Google announced a partnership with DigiLocker, a government-authorised identification storage system, to bring local storage of government-issued IDs on Android devices. This partnership was a part of Google's Artificial Intelligence (AI) offerings. Google's AI offering includes, on-device processing of text and images to identify important documents and organise them in a locally stored 'Files' folder. About DigiLocker: DigiLocker is a flagship initiative of the Ministry of Electronics & IT (MeitY) under the Digital India programme. The digital documents are legally valid documents under the Indian Information Technology Act 2000.

- 1. NASA's Hubble & Spitzer Space Telescopes Discover Two Exoplanets 218 Light Years Away: Two exoplanets, Kepler-138c and Kepler-138d, were found by National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) scientists in a planetary system known as Kepler-138, 218 light-years from Earth in the constellation Lyra. The exoplanets Kepler-138c and Kepler-138d are most likely water worlds, which scientists have theorized and observed with Hubble and the retired Spitzer space telescopes. About Exoplanets Kepler-138c and Kepler-138d i.These exoplanets, Kepler-138c and Kepler-138d, as well as Kepler-138b, orbit the red dwarf star Kepler-138. Kepler-138 b is a smaller planetary companion that orbits the star Kepler-138. The star is smaller and cooler than the Sun, a yellow dwarf star. These had previously been discovered by NASA's Kepler Space Telescope.
- 2. Indian Navy Gets 5th Scorpene Class Submarine 'Vagir': On December 20, the fifth Scorpene-class conventional submarine, "Vagir" (S25), of "Project 75", Kalvari Class submarines, Yard 11879, was delivered to the Indian Navy by Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDL) Mumbai, Maharashtra. It will be commissioned into the Indian Navy in January 2023 as "Indian Naval Ship (INS) Vagir," a fully combat-worthy submarine capable of operation in all modes and deployment regimes. i. Six Scorpene-class submarines are to be built indigenously under Project-75. ii. The first submarine, "INS Kalvari," was commissioned in December 2017, followed by 2nd submarine "INS Khanderi" in September 2019, 3rd submarine "INS Karanj" in March 2021, and 4th submarine "INS Vela" in November 2021.iii. Vagir was launched into the water on November 12, 2020, and began sea trials on February 1, 2022.

- 3. 3rd T20 World Cup for the blind 2022: India won the title for 3rd Consecutive time: On 18th December 2022, the Indian National Blind Cricket Team won the 3rd T20 World Cup for the blind 2022 by defeating Bangladesh in the final held at M Chinnaswamy Stadium, Bengaluru. Team India has won the title for the third consecutive time(previously won in 2012 and 2017).
- 4. Weightlifting: India's Saikhom Mirabai Chanu wins Silver at 2022 IWF World Championships: Indian weightlifter Saikhom Mirabai Chanu won the Silver medal, under 49 kg Women category, at the 2022 IWF World Championships held in Bogota, Colombia from 5th to 16th December 2022. Jiang Huihua of China took home the gold medal with a combined weight of 206 kg. Hou Zhihui of China took home the bronze medal with a combined weight of 198 kg. Note: 2022 IWF World Championships is the first qualifying competition for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games.
- FIFA Ranking: Brazil ranked No.1 despite Argentina's World Cup win in Qatar 2022: On 22nd December 2022, FIFA (Fédération Internationale de Football Association) officially announced the 2022 world rankings, and Brazil hold on to their No. 1 spot and 22nd FIFA Men's World Cup 2022 Champions Argentina ranked 2nd. Morocco has improved from 22nd to 11th in the FIFA world ranking, following their achievements at the 2022 FIFA Global Cup.
