- 1. World Television Day 2022 observed on 21st November:** World Television Day is observed on 21 November, every year. It is a day that recognizes the value and impact of television in our lives. We all know television plays a crucial role in society and in an individual's life.
- 2. World Fisheries Day observed on 21st November:** World Fisheries Day is annually celebrated on 21st November. This day is dedicated to highlighting the critical importance of healthy ocean ecosystems and to ensure sustainable stocks of fisheries in the world.
- 3. International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women 2022:** 25th November: The International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women is observed on November 25, every year. It is a day to pay tribute to the Mirabal sisters, the Dominican Republic activists who were murdered at the order of Rafael Trujillo in 1960. The 2022 theme of International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women is **'UNITE! Activism to End Violence against Women and Girls.'**
- 4. India Celebrates National Milk Day on 26th November:** National Milk Day is celebrated on the birth anniversary of Dr. Verghese Kurien, who is also known as the **'Father of White Revolution'**. The day was chosen as the National Milk Day by the dairy majors of the country including the National Dairy Development Board (NDDB), the Indian Dairy Association (IDA), along with the milk federation of 22 states.
- 5. Constitution Day of India:** Constitution Day is celebrated on 26th November every year in India to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India. The constitution of India was adopted by the Constituent Assembly on 26th November 1949, and it came into effect on 26th January 1950. The Constitution of India is termed as **'of the people, for the people, and by the people.'** The preamble of the Indian Constitution declared India as a sovereign, socialist, secular, democratic, republic, and the welfare state. Dr. B.R. Ambedkar was the chairman of the drafting committee of the Constituent Assembly. He was the first Minister of Law and Justice in India. The framing of the constitution took over 2 years, 11 months, and 17 days. The constituent assembly included 299 members and 15 were a woman.
- 6. November 28 is marked as Red Planet Day:** Commemorating the day one of the most significant space missions to Mars was launched, November 28 is marked as Red Planet Day. After 3 previous attempts, Spacecraft Mariner 4 became the first successful flyby of Mars. The spacecraft was launched on November 28, 1964, and reached Mars on July 14, 1965. The successful mission produced 22 pictures of the Martian surface.
- 7. International Jaguar Day 2022: 29 November::** International Jaguar Day was created to raise awareness about the increasing threats facing the jaguar and the critical conservation efforts ensuring its survival.
- 8. PM Modi to Inaugurate Arunachal's first Greenfield Airport Donyi Polo Airport:** Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the first Greenfield airport in Arunachal Pradesh — the Donyi Polo Airport at Itanagar — and dedicated the 600 MW Kameng Hydro Power Station to the nation. Northeast India will now have 16 airports. The name of the airport reflects the traditions and rich cultural heritage of Arunachal Pradesh and the age-old indigenous reverence to the Sun (**'Donyi'**) and the Moon (**'Polo'**) in the state. The foundation stone for this airport was laid by the PM in 2019. The Donyi Polo airport will be the third operational airport in Arunachal Pradesh and the first in its capital city Itanagar, taking the total number of airports in the Northeast to 16. Arunachal Pradesh currently has two airports, one at Pasighat and the other at Tezu.
- 9. CEC Shri Rajiv Kumar Invited as International Observer for Elections in Nepal:** Chief Election Commissioner Rajiv Kumar has been invited by the Election Commission of Nepal as an international observer

for the forthcoming elections to Nepal's House of Representatives and Provincial Assembly. Elections are scheduled in Nepal on 20 November to elect 275 members of the Federal Parliament and 550 seats of the seven Provincial Assemblies.

- 10. Bandaru Wilsonbabu named as the Ambassador of India to Comoros:** Indian Foreign Service (2004), Shri Bandaru Wilsonbabu, presently Ambassador of India to the Republic of Madagascar, has been concurrently accredited as the next Ambassador of India to the Union of the Comoros, with residence in Antananarivo. He is expected to take up the assignment shortly. The Comoros is an independent country made up of 3 islands in southeastern Africa. The Comoros is a volcanic archipelago off Africa's east coast, in the warm Indian Ocean waters of the Mozambique Channel.
- Comoros Capital:** Moroni; **Comoros President:** Azali Assoumani.
- 11. India won Excellence in Family Planning (EXCELL) Award:** India became the only country to receive the Leadership in Family Planning (EXCELL) Awards 2022 in the 'country category' at the International Conference on Family Planning held in Thailand. India's efforts in improving family planning demonstrate the progress the country has been making toward achieving the SDG targets on women and maternal health. The adoption of modern contraceptive methods and significantly reducing the unmet needs for family planning.
- 12. India Launches Official Website And Theme of SCO 2023:** India has launched the official website of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) as it will host the next SCO summit as a chairman of organisation in 2023. The theme of the event is "For a SECURE SCO". Prime Minister Narendra Modi had floated the concept of SECURE at the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) summit in China in 2018. Explaining the SECURE concept, the Prime Minister said 'S' for security for citizens, 'E' for economic development, 'C' for connectivity in the region, 'U' for unity, 'R' for respect of sovereignty and integrity, and 'E' for environment protection. India received the SCO rotating presidency in Samarkand, Uzbekistan. India will hold the presidency of the grouping for a year until September 2023.
- 13. First Unani Medicine Regional Center of Northeast Inaugurated in Silchar, Assam:** The first institute of Unani medicine in the Northeast region of India was inaugurated in Silchar town of Assam. The Unani medicine institute in Silchar of Assam was inaugurated by Union Ayush minister Sarbananda Sonowal. Unani medicine, also called Unani tibb, Arabian medicine, or Islamic medicine, a traditional system of healing and health maintenance observed in South Asia.
- 14. Retired IAS Arun Goel appointed as Election Commissioner of India:** President Droupadi Murmu has appointed retired IAS Arun Goel as the Election Commissioner in the Election Commission with effect from the date he assumes the office. A Punjab cadre officer of the 1985 batch, Goel will join Chief Election Commissioner Rajiv Kumar and Election Commissioner Anup Chandra Pandey in the poll panel.

- 15. Network Readiness Index 2022:** India ranked 61st: India has moved up by six slots to improve its position and rank 61st as per the Network Readiness Index 2022 (NRI 2022) report prepared by a US-based Portulans Institute, an independent non-profit research and educational institute. In a statement issued by the Telecom Ministry, it was stated that India's overall score has improved to 51.19 in 2022 from 49.74 in 2021. The NRI 2022 report ranks a total of 131 economies that together account for about 95 per cent of the global Gross Domestic Product (GDP). The United States ranks first on the list, with an overall score of 80.3. Singapore comes in second

with a score of 79.35, and Sweden comes in third with a score of 78.91. Singapore leads Asia Pacific, followed by South Korea and Japan.

- 16. Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar attends FIFA world cup inauguration in Qatar:** Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar has joined the Emir of Qatar Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al Thani and other dignitaries in the inauguration of FIFA World Cup in Qatar. **Qatar Capital:** Doha; **Qatar Currency:** Qatari Riyal.
- 17. 13th bilateral naval exercise Naseem Al Bahr-2022:** 13th bilateral naval exercise Naseem Al Bahr-2022. The exercise is being conducted in two phases: the Harbour Phase and the Sea Phase. The Indian Navy's guided missile frigate Trikand and Offshore Patrol Vessel Sumitra, with their integral helicopters, and the maritime patrol aircraft, Dornier, are participating in the exercise.
- 18. HDFC Bank, Canara Bank Get RBI Approval for Rupee Trade with Russia:** The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) allowed HDFC Bank Ltd and Canara Bank Ltd to open a special "vostro account" for trade in Rupees with Russia. This paves the way for cross-border trade in the Indian currency, especially between New Delhi and Moscow. Three other Indian banks — State Bank of India, IndusInd Bank and UCO Bank — had earlier received the necessary permissions from the regulator to roll out rupee trades. In July, the central bank had introduced a new arrangement for settling international trades in rupees. The mechanism, enabling the invoicing, payment and settlement of exports and imports in rupees, is aimed at promoting trade. It would also restrict dollar outflows at a time when the local unit has been depreciating.
- 19. Russia Replaces China to Become the Biggest Supplier of Fertilizers to India:** Russia has become India's biggest fertilizer supplier for the first time. Russian exporters reportedly grabbed a 21% share of the Indian fertilizer market in the first half of the 2022-23 fiscal year, overtaking China, previously India's largest supplier. Russian exports reportedly surged 371%, to a record 2.15 million tons from April to October.
- 20. Manika Batra: First Indian woman to win medal at Asian Cup Table Tennis:** Manika Batra, the Indian Table Tennis player, became the first Indian woman to win a medal at the Asian Cup Table Tennis Tournament. Manika defeated World no.6 Hina Hayata of Japan in the Asian Cup 2022 in the women's singles bronze medal match in Bangkok, Thailand. Asian Cup Table Tennis Tournament is an annual competition which is held by the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF) and the Asian Table Tennis Union. The first edition of the Asian Cup Table Tennis Tournament was held in 1983.
- 21. RBI Releases "Handbook of Statistics on Indian States, 2021-22":** The seventh edition of the Handbook of Statistics on Indian States 2021-22 is released by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI). Which seeks to provide comprehensive data about the regional economies of India. It covers sub-national statistics on socio-demographics, state domestic product, agriculture, price and wages, industry, infrastructure, banking, and fiscal indicators across the states during various time periods ranging from 1951 to 2021-22. Two new sections have been included in the recent edition – health and environment. Key Findings Of The Report: The Indian economy showed remarkable resilience to multiple consecutive shocks it experienced since early 2020. Karnataka has the highest total installed capacity of grid-interactive renewable power among all states. It had total installed capacity of 15,463 megawatts (MW). Tamil Nadu has remained the top state in India with the maximum number of factories including micro, small and mid-sized units followed by Gujarat, Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh, and Uttar Pradesh in the top-five bracket on a list of 36 states and union territories across India.
- 22. Manipur Sangai Festival 2022 Commenced in the State:** The Sangai Festival of Manipur begins, it is the largest tourism festival in Manipur. The festival is named after the State Animal which is found only in Manipur

have been organized grandly this time after the COVID-19 pandemic hit the festival in the last two years. The theme of the festival is the 'festival of oneness'. The ten days festival is expected to attract tourists to Manipur.

- 23. India's Purnima Devi Barman is one of UNEP's 'Champions of the Earth' for 2022:** India's Purnima Devi Barman, an Assam-based wildlife biologist, is one of the five 'Champions of the Earth' for this year, the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) announced. The annual awards are the highest environmental honour that the UNEP confers on individuals and organisations whose actions have a "transformative impact" on the environment. The other honourees include Arcenciel (Lebanon); Constantino (Tino) Aucca Chutas (Peru); Sir Partha Dasgupta of the United Kingdom and Cecile Bibiane Ndjebet (Cameroon). UNEP said that since its inception in 2005, the annual Champions of the Earth award has been awarded to trailblazers at the forefront of efforts to protect our natural world. It is the UN's highest environmental honour.
- 24. Mumbai Becomes the First City in South Asia to Top CDP's Climate Action List:** Mumbai has become the first Indian city to be added to the A-list in the 5th Annual Cities Report published by CDP, a non-profit organisation that runs the world's environmental disclosure system for companies, cities, states, and regions – recognises the important role that cities play in taking bold actions to mitigate and adapt to climate change. Mumbai announced detailed plans to zero out carbon emissions by 2050, a target that puts it two decades ahead of India's national goal and makes it the first city in South Asia to set such a timeline.
- 25. Tenzing Norgay National Adventure Awards 2021 Announced by GoI:** The Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India announced the National Adventure Award called "Tenzing Norgay Adventure Award" (TNNA) for the year 2021. The award is given in four categories which are Land Adventure, Water Adventure, Air Adventure, and Life Time Achievement. The awardees will receive their awards from the President of India along with other Sports Awardees at the Rashtrapati Bhawan on 30th November 2022.

- 26. Museum maker AP Shreethar awarded Economic Times Inspiring Leaders Award 2022:** Museum maker AP. Shreethar was honored with Economic Times Inspiring Leaders Award 2022 in Delhi. He is known to have conducted over 72 shows and exhibitions around the globe. AP Shreethar is additionally credited as the creator of the world's first Live Art Museum.
- 27. Groundnut Festival 'Kadalekai Parishe' begins in Karnataka:** The annual festival of 'Kadalekai Parishe', also known as the groundnut festival, Kadalekai Parishe is a fair held in the month of Kartik near Basavanagudi in Bengaluru. It happens near the Dodda Ganesha temple and the Bull Temple at Basavanagudi. This year, over 3,000 people from other parts of Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, and also Tamil Nadu took part in the festivities that welcomed the first seasonal yield of the groundnut crop.
- 28. Tata to Acquire Packaged Water Giant Bisleri for About ₹7,000 Crore:** Tata Consumer is set to acquire India's largest packaged drinking water company, Bisleri, for an estimated Rs 6,000-7,000 crore. Chairman Ramesh Chauhan is aiming to disinvest Bisleri International to Tata Consumer Products three decades after selling soft drink brands Thums Up, Gold Spot and Limca to Coca-Cola. Several companies including Coca-Cola India through its brand Kinley, PepsiCo's Aquafina, Bailley from Parle Agro and Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation (IRCTC)'s Rail Neer compete in the segment but they all trail the market leader Bisleri.

- 29. India Expresses Commitment to Peace, Security and Prosperity in the Indo-Pacific Region:** India and Asean in a joint statement reaffirmed the importance of maintaining and promoting peace, stability, maritime safety, freedom of navigation and overflight in the Indo-Pacific region, and also commitment to peaceful resolution of disputes, in accordance with international law, including UNCLOS. The Vice President of India attended the 19th ASEAN-India Summit in Phnom Penh, Cambodia. ASEAN and India adopted a joint statement announcing the elevation of the existing Strategic Partnership to Comprehensive Strategic Partnership.
- 30. 39 Schools Awarded with Swachh Vidyalaya Puraskar for 2021-22:** Thirty-nine schools from across the country were awarded the Swachh Vidyalaya Puraskar for the 2021-2022 academic session by the Ministry of Education. The schools were selected from among a total of 8.23 lakh entries. Out of which 28 were government and aided schools and 11 were private schools. The schools are rated on six broad parameters of water, toilets, handwashing with soap, operation, and maintenance, behavioral change, and capacity building.
