- 1. International Volunteer Day for Economic and Social Development: 5 Dec:** International Volunteer Day for Economic and Social Development is observed on December 5 every year. The day is also referred to as International Volunteer Day (IVD) to recognize and promote the tireless work, not just of UN Volunteers, but of volunteers across the globe. International Volunteer Day (IVD) 2022 celebrates the theme of solidarity through volunteering.
- 2. World Soil Day observed on 5th December:** December 5 is celebrated annually as World Soil Day to highlight the importance of healthy soil and promote sustainable management of soil resources. The event aims to raise awareness of the importance of soil quality for human well-being, food security and ecosystems, and events are held at the UN FAO offices and through community based events. The theme for 2022 World Soil Day is 'Soils: Where Food Begins'.
- 3. International Civil Aviation Day observed on 7th December:** On December 7, International Civil Aviation Day is observed globally. The aviation industry has made a huge impact on our lives. The day is observed by the International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO), a United Nations (UN) body responsible for maintaining the international standards for aviation safety. Theme of International Civil Aviation Day will be: "Advancing Innovation for Global Aviation Development".
- 4. National Armed Forces Flag Day 2022:** 7th December :: Every year on December 7, India commemorates Armed Forces Flag Day in order to raise donations for the welfare of the Armed Forces Staff. This day is observed to honour Indian soldiers, sailors, and pilots.
- 5. SAARC Charter Day 2022: 8th December:** The South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation (SAARC) Charter Day is observed every year on 8th December. On this day in 1985, SAARC Charter was adopted in Dhaka, during the first summit of the group. This year marks the 38th Anniversary of the regional group. Eight Member States: Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka. Secretariat: Kathmandu (Nepal). Objective: To promote the welfare of the people of South Asia and to improve their quality of life, and to accelerate economic growth, among other things.
- 6. International Anti-Corruption Day observed on 9th December:** The world celebrates International Anti-Corruption Day on December 9. The main motive behind marking this day is to spread awareness about a corruption-free society. Everyone knows that corruption affects every area of society. This year, the theme for International Anti-Corruption Day is "Uniting the world against corruption."
- 7. 72nd Human Rights Day 2022 observed on 10th December:** Human Rights Day is celebrated across the world on December 10 every year. It marks the day that the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) adopted the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) in 1948. Human Rights Day focuses on the fundamental rights and freedoms that people globally are entitled to simply by virtue of being humans. The campaign will be centred around the theme, "Dignity, Freedom, and Justice for All."

- 8. International Mountain Day 2022:** Raise awareness of mountains on 11 December by organizing safe, socially distanced activities, including virtual presentations and events, photo and art competitions, and hikes. Women move mountains is the theme of this year's International Mountain Day on 11 December.
- 9. Rajeeva Laxman Karandikar named as chairperson of the National Statistical Commission:** Government of India had appointed Rajeeva Laxman Karandikar, Professor Emeritus at Chennai Mathematical Institute (CMI), as the part-time chairperson of the National Statistical Commission (NSC) of India for a period of three years. He will take up this role as an additional responsibility while continuing as Professor Emeritus at CMI. He joined CMI as a visiting professor in 2010, and officiated as the Director of CMI from January 2011 to April 2021. NSC is an autonomous body formed in June 2005 under the recommendation of the Dr. C Rangarajan commission. The objective of its constitution was to reduce the problems faced by statistical agencies in the country with respect to the collection of data, and strengthen public trust in the numbers released by the Government of India.
National Statistical Commission Formed: 1 June 2005.
- 10. NSE Launches New Nifty Bharat Bond Index:** The National Stock Exchange's subsidiary NSE Indices has said it has launched one more index under the Nifty Bharat Bond Index series. The Bharat Bond Index series follows a target maturity date structure wherein each index in the series measures the performance of a portfolio of 'AAA' rated bonds issued by government owned entities maturing in a specific year. The upcoming Bharat Bond ETF which is sixth in the Bharat Bond ETF series will track the newly launched Nifty BHARAT Bond Index maturing in 2033. The first Bharat Bond ETFs tracking the Nifty Bharat Bond indices were launched in December 2019, Mukesh Agarwal, CEO, NSE Indices, said.
- 11. Hansraj Gangaram Ahir named as the new NCBC chairperson:** Former Union Minister Hansraj Gangaram Ahir has assumed charge as Chairperson of the National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC). He is an Agriculturist by profession, read a statement from the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment. National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC) was initially constituted by the Central Govt by the National Commission for Backward Classes Act, 1993. The National Commission for Backward Classes Act, 1993 (27 of 1993) has been repealed through the National Commission for Backward Classes (Repeal) Act, 2018 dated 14.08.2018.
- 12. Canara Bank won Banker's Bank of the Year Award:** Canara Bank won the 'Banker's Bank of the Year Award 2022' for India segment at the Global Banking Summit held in London. Bank Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer LV Prabhakar received the award from the organisers. These are prestigious awards to the banking industry and Canara Bank has been adjudged as the Best Bank in India for 2022. Canara Bank Headquarters: Bengaluru; Canara Bank Founder: Ammembal Subba Rao Pa, Canara Bank Founded: 1 July 1906.

- 13. India ranked 48th in Global Aviation Safety Rankings 2022:** According to DGCA officials, India has jumped to the 48th position in the global aviation safety ranking by the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO). Four years ago, the country was ranked at the 102nd position. In the ranking, Singapore is at the top, followed by the UAE and South Korea at the second and third positions, respectively, the officials said. China is at the 49th place. International Civil Aviation Organization Headquarters: Montreal, Canada; International Civil Aviation Organization Founded: 7 December 1944.
- 14. A book 'Brave Hearts of Bharat, Vignettes from Indian History' authored by Vikram Sampath:** A book titled 'Brave Hearts of Bharat, Vignettes from Indian History' by Vikram Sampath, an anthology of 15 stories of men and women and their indomitable spirit of freedom and courage, was launched in Delhi. The book is published under Penguin publication. The book chronicles the stories of courage and determination of few individuals, whose stories largely remained untold and therefore unknown for a long time.
- 15. Ladakh To Soon Have India's First Dark Night Sky Reserve:** Ladakh is all set to have India's first Dark Night Sky Reserve at Hanle village in Changthang region. In about eighteen locations in Hanley, powerful telescopes will be installed for stargazing. On his maiden visit to Hanley, Ladakh Lieutenant Governor RK Mathur was convinced with the unique potential lied for Astro tourism in the area
- 16. National Zoological Park celebrates International Cheetah Day 2022:** The National Zoological Park, Delhi Zoo has celebrated International Cheetah Day and Wildlife Conservation Day in New Delhi on 4th December. The purpose of the celebration is to spread awareness among the present generation about Wildlife Conservation. The day is dedicated to encouraging people worldwide to help this animal win the race against extinction. The cheetah (a big and slender cat with long legs) is popularly known as the fastest animal on earth, it can reach a top speed of 70 mph in just three seconds. The animal weighs anywhere from 46 to 158 pounds and, unlike most other big cats, cheetahs hunt in the daytime. At present the majority of the animal is found in Namibia and South Africa. The Government of India has started a project to repopulate India with Cheetah brought from Namibia and settled in Kuno National park in Madhya Pradesh.
- 17. UP CM Yogi Adityanath launches 'One District One Sport' scheme:** The Uttar Pradesh government's ambitious One District One Product (ODOP) scheme has received praise at the national level for helping in the revival of traditional crafts in the state. Now, on similar lines, the government has launched the One District One Sport (ODOS) programme for promoting local sporting talent.
- 18. Hyderabad-based startup gets India's first real-time Gold ATM:** Goldsikka with technology support from Hyderabad-based startup, Opencube Technologies has launched its first Gold ATM at Begumpet and described it India's first Gold ATM and world's first Real Time Gold ATM. This ATM can dispense gold coins in different denominations ranging from 0.5 gm to 100 grams.
- 19. 7th edition of US-India Naval Exercise Sangam begins in Goa:** The 7th edition of Exercise Sangam, a joint Naval Special Forces exercise between Indian Navy MARCOs and US Navy SEALs commenced in Goa. The present edition which will see personnel from SEAL Team Five based at San

Diego, US and Indian Navy MARCOs from INS Abhimanyu together aims at exchange of ideas and experiences on various aspects of maritime special operations.

- 20. World Bank upgrades India's GDP growth forecast for 2022-23 to 6.9 percent:** According to the World Bank, Indian economy is set to grow at 6.9 per cent in 2022-23, raising its forecast of 6.5 per cent growth made in October. In October, it had cut India's GDP growth forecast to 6.5 per cent from 7.5 per cent earlier. Now, it has upgraded the projection to 6.9 per cent for 2022-23 (April 2022 -March 2023).
- 21. Presidency of G20, SCO, UNSC in 2022: A Historic Opportunity For India:** December of 2022 began with India assuming the presidency of two global bodies — G20 on the first day of the month and UNSC on the second and the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) in 2023 when major powers are not even talking to each other and India alone, now the fifth largest economy, is interacting with each of them, presents a historic opportunity. G20 presidency is driven by the vision of "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam" (the world is one family), its presidency of the United Nations Security Council seeks to prioritise countering terrorism and reformed multilateralism. Leading with the "Five S's" approach charted out by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Samman (Respect), Samvad (Dialogue), Sahyog (Cooperation), Shanti (Peace), and Samridhi (Prosperity), India took over UN presidency today.
- 22. India Hosts Conclave of NSAs of Central Asian Countries:** This is the first time India is hosting a conclave of top security officials from Central Asian countries including Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan focussing on the evolving security situation in Afghanistan and ways to deal with the threat of terrorism emanating from that country. The security situation in Afghanistan and the evolving dynamics in that country will figure in the deliberations. India and the Central Asian countries have shared interests in peace, security and stability in the region. A number of Central Asian countries share land borders with Afghanistan and there have been concerns by them after the Taliban seized power in Kabul in August last year.
- 23. Google Launches Anti-Misinformation Campaign in India:** Google's Jigsaw subsidiary is launching a new anti-misinformation project in India, aimed at preventing misleading information that has been blamed for inciting violence. The initiative will use "prebunking" videos – designed to counter false claims before they become widespread – circulated on the company's YouTube platform and other social media sites. Google's efforts to challenge the spread of misinformation mark a contrast with rival Twitter which is cutting its trust and safety teams, despite new owner Elon Musk saying it will not become a "free-for-all hellscape".
- 24. India to Become 8th Largest Advertising Market in 2023:** According to GroupM's global end-of-year forecast, India is expected to surpass Brazil to become the eighth-largest advertising market in 2023. In 'This Year, Next Year 2022', GroupM has ranked India as the ninth-largest advertising market globally. According to the report, India's total advertising revenue in 2022 has grown by 15.8 per cent to

touch \$14.9 billion, led by growth in pure-play digital advertising. In 2023, it is expected to increase by 16.8 per cent.

- 25. Former Union minister and noted economist Yoginder Alagh passes away:** Prof Yoginder K Alagh, renowned economist, academic and a former Union minister, has passed away. He was emeritus professor at Ahmedabad-based Sardar Patel Institute of Economic and Social Research (SPIESR). Born in Chakwal, in present-day Pakistan, in 1939, Alagh studied at the University of Rajasthan and later got a doctorate in economics from the University of Pennsylvania, USA.
- 26. BBC Releases 100 Most Influential Women's List:** 4 Indian women's in the list: The British Broadcasting Corporation (BBC) has published the list of 100 most influential women in the world and has included women from several areas such as politics, science, sports, entertainment, and literature. The BBC's 100 most influential women's list also includes four Indians: Actress Priyanka Chopra Jonas, author Geetanjali Shree, engineer and astronaut Sirisha Bandla, and social worker Sneha Jawale.
- 27. RBI Monetary Policy 2022: RBI Repo Rate Hike by 35 bps to 6.25%:** The decision of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) Governor Shaktikanta Das headed six-member Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) has been announced. In the consecutive fifth hike this year, the RBI's Monetary Policy Committee has raised the repo rate by 35 basis points (bps) to 6.25 per cent with immediate effect, making loans expensive. The policy rate is now at the highest level since August 2018. The RBI has maintained policy stance at 'withdrawal of accommodation'.

- 28. SAARC Charter Day 2022: 8th December:** The South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation (SAARC) Charter Day is observed every year on 8th-December. On this day in 1985, SAARC Charter was adopted in Dhaka, during the first summit of the group. This year marks the 38th Anniversary of the regional group. The charter was signed by the Leaders of SAARC Countries Heads of State or Government of Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka at the First SAARC Summit held in Dhaka, Bangladesh. Objective: To promote the welfare of the people of South Asia and to improve their quality of life, and to accelerate economic growth, among other things. These are usually held biennially and hosted by member states in alphabetical order.
- 29. Time Magazine's 2022 Person of the Year: Volodymyr Zelensky and "Spirit of Ukraine":** Time magazine named President Volodymyr Zelensky as well as "the spirit of Ukraine" as its 2022 person

of the year, for the resistance the country has shown in the face of Russia's invasion. Zelensky shares the 2022 title with "the spirit of Ukraine," which Felsenthal said was embodied by the "countless individuals inside and outside the country" who fought behind the scenes, including everyday people such as chefs and surgeons. Mahatma Gandhi is the only Indian to be named TIME Person of the Year, having been given the honour in 1930.

- 30. Peru Gets its First Female President After Pedro Castillo is Impeached:** Dina Boluarte became Peru's first female president amid a political maelstrom when her predecessor and former boss Pedro Castillo was ousted in an impeachment trial and detained by police after he tried to illegally shut down Congress.
- 31. Meghalaya Government launches 'Asia's first Drone delivery hub for easy access to healthcare':** The Meghalaya government in partnership with startup TechEagle has unveiled Asia's first drone delivery hub and network which is aimed at providing universal access to healthcare for the people in the state. The project is aimed at delivering vital supplies like drugs, diagnostic samples, vaccines, blood and blood components quickly and safely to different regions of the state using a dedicated drone delivery network. Meghalaya Chief Minister: Conrad Kongkal Sangma; Meghalaya Governor: B. D. Mishra.
- 32. NABARD named Shri Shaji KV as Chairman:** K V Shaji has been named Chairman of the National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD). He formerly served as NABARD's Deputy Managing Director (DMD) till May 21, 2020. National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) is an apex regulatory body for overall regulation of regional rural banks and apex cooperative banks in India. It is under the jurisdiction of Ministry of Finance, Government of India. Indira Gandhi on 05 November 1982. Set up with an initial capital of Rs. 100 crore, its' paid up capital stood at Rs. 17,080 crore as on 31 March 2022.
- 33. U.N. Convention on Biological Diversity, COP 15 Commences in Canada:** The United Nations Convention on Biological Diversity, also called as Conference of Parties (COP-15) commenced in Montreal, Canada on 7 December 2022. The two-weeklong conference (7-19 December 2022) was originally scheduled to be held in Kunming, China in October but was shifted to Montreal, Canada due to covid situation in China. This is the second part of the COP15. The first part was hosted by China on 18 August 2021 virtually and the second part was to be held in a face to face conference but it has been shifted from China to Canada. However the host of the COP15 in Montreal is still China. Parties to the CBD normally meet every two years at events known as the Conference of the Parties, or COP, to check in on progress and update the terms of the contract. That's what's starting now in Montreal (COP15 was supposed to begin in 2020, but it got delayed several times due to Covid; the first part of the event took place last year in Kunming, China). The first COP -1 was held in Nassau, Bahamas 1994.
- 34. 9th World Ayurveda Congress and Arogya Expo 2022 Inaugurated in Goa:** The World Ayurveda Congress & Arogya Expo 2022 will be held in Goa from 8-11 December with an objective to provide a

global platform to stakeholders, including industry leaders, practitioners, traditional healers, educationists, students, medicine manufacturers, etc. The theme for the 9th World Ayurveda Congress (WAC) this year is 'Ayurveda For One Health'.

- 35. Karthigai Deepam Chariot festival held in Tamil Nadu:** The Karthigai Deepam Chariot festival was held at Thiruparankundram in Madurai, Tamil Nadu after a gap of two years due to the COVID-19 pandemic. This is one of the most important festivals in Madurai which many devotees attend. It is a very old festival and is also celebrated in the neighboring states like Kerala, Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka. Tamil Nadu Governor: R. N. Ravi, Chief minister: M. K. Stalin.
- 36. Anurag Thakur Inaugurated India's 1st Drone Training Conference:** Towards empowering and mobilising farmers across the nation with the use of agri-drones, Information and Broadcasting Minister Anurag Singh Thakur inaugurated India's first Drone Skilling and Training Virtual E-Learning Platform at the Chennai manufacturing facility of Garuda Aerospace, a drone-based startup of India. The Minister, simultaneously flagged off Garuda Aerospace's drone yatra, 'Operation 777' which will educate and demonstrate the efficacy of drones for different agricultural uses across 777 districts in India. The I&B Minister also launched the first of 1000 planned Drone Centre of Excellence at the company's Manufacturing unit in Chennai which is also the largest in India.
- 37. Tata Sons Chairman N Chandrasekaran appointed as the Chairman of B20:** Chairman of Tata Sons, N Chandrasekaran has been appointed as the chair of B20 India which represents the entire G20 business community. He will lead the business agenda during India's G20 Presidency. The Government of India has appointed CII, who assumed charge as the B20 India Secretariat on December 1 and will lead the B20 India process.
