- 1. International Day for Preventing the Exploitation of the Environment in War and Armed Conflict 2022:** On November 6th, the UN observes the International Day for Preventing the Exploitation of the Environment in War and Armed Conflict. The day seeks to make people aware of the consequences that war and conflict have on the environment.
- 2. India Celebrates 134th Birth Anniversary of CV Raman:** CV Raman was born on 7th November 1888, in Trichinopoly, Tamil Nadu, and died on 21st November 1970, in Bangalore. CV Raman was one of India's greatest scientists. Sir Chandrasekhara Venkata Raman was a physicist who made discoveries that were broader than modern science and were called the Raman Effect, the phenomenon of change of wavelength of light when a beam is scattered in a medium. National Science Day is celebrated in India on 28 February each year to mark the discovery of the Raman effect by Indian physicist Sir C. V. Raman on 28 February 1928.
- 3. 17th Pravasi Bharatiya Divas Convention:** Guyana President Dr. Mohamed Irfaan Ali to be chief guest: Guyana President, Dr. Mohamed Irfaan Ali will be the chief guest at the 17th Pravasi Bharatiya Divas Convention. It will be held from 8th to 10th January next year in Indore, Madhya Pradesh. The theme of the 17th Pravasi Bharatiya Divas is Diaspora: Reliable Partners for India's Progress in Amrit Kaal.
- 4. World Radiography Day 2022:** Every year on November 8, World Radiography Day is observed to honour the discovery of X-radiation, also known as X-rays. This day in 1895 saw the completion of German scientist Wilhelm Conrad Rontgen's discovery of X-radiation, or X-rays. For this accomplishment, he was awarded the first Nobel Prize in Physics in 1901. This year, we will be celebrating the 11th International Day of Radiology on 11 November and this is observed by all the medical imaging professionals from across the world. The theme of International Day of Radiology 2022 is "Radiographers at the Forefront of Patient Safety."
- 5. Infant Protection Day 2022:** Every year, November 7 is celebrated as Infant Protection Day. This day is celebrated with the sole purpose of raising awareness about the safety of newborn lives and giving them proper care.
- 6. International Week of Science and Peace 2022: 9-15 November:** November 9 to November 14 is observed as the International Week of Science and Peace every year around the globe. This week is an initiative taken by the United Nations (UN), hoping to make people contribute towards the encouragement and promotion of peace across the globe. During this week, people inspire and promote peace in their countries and also develop advanced technology for better living.
- 7. National Legal Services Day 2022: 9th November:** National Legal Services Day is marked every year on 9th November to celebrate the commencement of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 which came into force on this very day in 1995.
- 8. World Science Day for Peace and Development observed on 10 November:** World Science Day for Peace and Development was proclaimed by the UN Educational, Scientific and UNESCO in 2001

under the UNESCO 31 C/Resolution 20. It is celebrated every year on November 10, around the globe, marking the significance of science in society. This year's theme for World Science Day for Peace and Development is "Basic Sciences for Sustainable Development".

- 9. Nation celebrates National Education Day on 11 November:** The National Education Day is observed annually on November 11 in India. In India, National Education Day is celebrated every year on November 11 as it marks the birth anniversary of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, who was India's first education minister after independence. He was awarded Bharat Ratna posthumously, India's highest civilian honour in 1992. The theme for National Education Day 2022 is "Changing Course, Transforming Education."
- 10. World Usability Day 2022: "Our Health":** Every year on the second Thursday of November, the world observes World Usability Day. The date is also mentioned on the UN calendar. World Usability Day, which will fall on November 10 this year, is also known as 'Make Things Easier' day. "Usability" is a quality that evaluates how efficiently and effectively a person can use a product, as well as how satisfied he or she is with the process. The theme of World Usability Day 2022 is "Our Health".
- 11. Public Service Broadcasting Day observed on 12 November:** Public Service Broadcasting Day is being celebrated on 12th November every year to commemorate the only visit of Mahatma Gandhi to All India Radio in Delhi in 1947. The day was declared as Public Service Broadcasting Day or (Jan Prasaran Diwas) in 2001, after it was conceptualised by Suhas Borker, Convenor, Jan Prasar.
- 12. World Pneumonia Day observed on 12 November:** World Pneumonia Day is a global event observed every year on 12 November to spread awareness and educate people to combat Pneumonia disease, which is a world's biggest infectious killer of adults and children, responsible for the majority of death of children below five around the world. This year 2022, World Pneumonia Day theme is based on the Worldwide Pneumonia Awareness Campaign – "Pneumolight 2022", with a theme and slogan "Pneumonia Affects Everyone",.
- 13. Rising Sun Water Fest-2022 culminates in Meghalaya:** Rising Sun Water Fest 2022 culminated with a grand Closing Ceremony at Umiam Lake, Meghalaya. The Rising Sun Water Fest 2022 was a three-day watersport and it was held from 3th to 5th November 2022. Rising Sun Water Fest 2022 was the first of its kind in the North East and aimed at encouraging the sports-loving youth of North East to take up water sports like Rowing and Sailing. Rising Sun Water Fest 2022 was an initiative by the Indian Army's Eastern Command with the governments of Assam and Meghalaya.
- 14. Kishor K Basa named Chairman Of National Monuments Authority:** Professor Kishor Kumar Basa has been appointed as the chairman of the National Monument Authority (NMA). The Department of Culture of the Government of India issued an official notification in this regard. He will have a tenure of three years. National Monuments Authority (NMA) under the Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India has been set up as per provisions of The Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Sites and Remains AMASR (Amendment and Validation) Act, 2010 which was enacted in March 2010.

- 15. Madhya Pradesh: Ujjain to Get World's First Vedic Clock:** Madhya Pradesh's Ujjain, the city of Mahakal will soon boast the world's first Vedic clock which will be synced with the position of the Sun. After laying the foundation stone at the 300-year-old Jiwaji Observatory in Ujjain, the state higher education minister Mohan Yadav said through this project, people will become familiar with the Vedic time calculation.

- 16. Law Commission Constituted After 4 Years; Justice Ritu Raj Awasthi Appointed As Chairperson:** The central government appointed chairperson and members of the Law Commission over two and a half years after it was constituted. Retired Karnataka High Court Chief Justice Rituraj Awasthi appointed as the chairperson of the commission. Law Commission of India is neither a constitutional body nor a statutory body, it is an executive body established by an order of the Government of India. Its major function is to work for legal reforms. The Commission is established for a fixed tenure and works as an advisory body to the Ministry of Law and Justice. Its membership primarily comprises legal experts. The Law Commission is constituted for three years and the 22nd Law Commission was notified on February 24, 2020.
- 17. MoS Rajiv Chandrashekar releases Two books on achievements and legacy of PM Modi:** Two books on the achievements and legacy of Prime Minister Narendra Modi were released by Minister of State for Skill Development and Entrepreneurship Rajiv Chandrashekar in Dubai. These “**Modi@20: Dreams Meet Delivery**” and “**Heartfelt: The Legacy of Faith**”. The books were released at a programme of Vishwa Sadhbhavana, NID Foundation (Dubai chapter) to enhance and consolidate bonds of fraternity and solidarity among people in the US, Australia, and New Zealand.
- 18. Rajasthan to Host Iconic 8-Day Long Pushkar Fair:** This year, Pushkar Fair is being hosted by Rajasthan from 1st November to 9th November 2022. Pushkar Fair is also known as Pushkar Camel Fair, Kartik Mela, or Kartik ka Mela. The Pushkar Fair will be held without the popular cattle fair due to the spread of lumpy skin disease in livestock. This year, the state tourism department has invited tourists from all over the world for the fair under the aegis of Pushkar Chalo Abhiyan.
- 19. VP Jagdeep Dhankhar to lead India at the ASEAN-India Commemorative Summit:** Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar will attend the ASEAN – India commemorative summit and the 17th East Asia Summit (EAS). The ASEAN – India commemorative summit is being held in Cambodia from 11th November to 13th November 2022. The year 2022 marks the 30th anniversary of ASEAN-India relations and it will be celebrated as the ASEAN-India friendship year which makes it an important milestone.
- 20. Vadodara issued first-ever municipal bond:** Vadodara became the second city in India to issue a municipal bond with assistance from the US Treasury Department's Office of Technical Assistance. The US Embassy and US Treasury officials joined counterparts from India's Ministry of Housing and Urban Development, the city of Vadodara, and the Securities and Exchange Board to celebrate the

successful issuance of Vadodara's first-ever municipal bond. Pune was the first city to issue such a bond in 2017. The bond will provide funds for infrastructure projects in Vadodara.

- 21. Indian Navy participates Malabar Naval Exercise in Japan:** India is participating in 26th International Malabar Naval Exercise begins in Yokosuka of Japan. In the Malabar Naval Exercise, Australia, Japan and the USA are also participating. The naval forces of these countries will take part in the exercise till the 18th of next month. Indian Naval Ships Shivalik and Kamorta are ready to demonstrate at the event. It started as a bilateral drill between the Indian Navy and the US Navy in the Indian Ocean. Japan became a permanent member of the exercise in 2015.
- 22. Prime Minister Narendra Modi unveils logo, theme and website of India's G20 presidency:** Prime Minister Narendra Modi has unveiled India's logo, theme and website for its presidency of the G20, which reflects the country's message and overarching priorities to the world. The G20 logo, created with the four colours of India's national flag, comprises of earth sitting atop a lotus. The seven petals in the logo signify the seven seas and the coming together of seven continents at G20 India 2023. The earth reflects India's pro-planet approach to life and from this, it derives the theme of G20 India 2023 – **"Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam: One Earth, One Family, One Future."** The G20, or Group of 20, is an intergovernmental forum of the world's major developed and developing economies and represents about 85 per cent of the global GDP.
- 23. Adidas appoints Bjorn Gulden as CEO of the company:** Adidas has appointed Bjorn Gulden, the CEO of rival Puma, as its new chief executive, and he will take over the German sportswear brand in January as the company. Gulden will replace Kasper Rorsted, Adidas' CEO since 2016, whose departure was announced in August.

- 24. 3 Indian women feature in 2022 Asia's Power Businesswomen' list** which features 20 women from the Asia-Pacific region. The list of women bosses features three Indians as well. The first Indian woman named on the list is Ghazal Alagh, co-founder and chief innovation officer of Honasa Consumer, Mamaearth's parent firm. She started Gurgaon-based company in 2016. Second Indian businesswoman on the list is Soma Mondal, chairperson of Steel Authority of India Ltd (SAIL), the first to chair the state-run company. Namita Thapar, executive director at India business of Emcure Pharma, is the third Indian to be named of Forbes Asia's Power Businesswomen 2022 list.
- 25. India Will Become Third-Largest Economy By 2027: Morgan Stanley:** India is on track to become the world's third largest economy by 2027, surpassing Japan and Germany, and have the third largest stock market by 2030, thanks to global trends and key investments the country has made in technology and energy, says Morgan Stanley. All told, India's GDP could more than double from \$3.5 trillion today to surpass \$7.5 trillion by 2031. Its share of global exports could also double over that period, while the

Bombay Stock Exchange could deliver 11% annual growth, reaching a market capitalization of \$10 trillion in the coming decade.

- 26. India Joins Mangrove Alliance for Climate (MAC) at COP27:** India joined the Mangrove Alliance For Climate (MAC) at the ongoing 27th Summit of the Conference of Parties (COP27) at Sharm el-Sheikh in Egypt. The Mangrove Alliance for Climate (MAC) is an intergovernmental alliance that seeks to expand and hasten the progress towards the conservation and restoration of mangrove ecosystems. Its members include the UAE, Indonesia, India, Sri Lanka, Australia, Japan, and Spain. India is among the first five countries to join the MAC, at the 27th session of the Conference of the Parties (COP27) at Sharm el-Sheikh in Egypt. The others are Australia, Japan, Spain, and Sri Lanka. Reducing Emissions from Deforestation and forest Degradation (REDD+) is a mechanism developed by Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) in 2005.
- 27. Uttar Pradesh to host 2023 Khelo India University Games:** Uttar Pradesh government to host Khelo India National University Games in 2023-2024 in four cities. Khelo India National University Games will be conducted in four cities of Uttar Pradesh including Lucknow, Gorakhpur, Varanasi, and Noida. Uttar Pradesh has got the opportunity to host the National University Games for the first time after Odisha and Karnataka.
- 28. PM Gati Shakti Multimodal Waterways Summit to be held in Varanasi:** Union Minister Sarbananda Sonowal to inaugurate the two-day PM Gati Shakti Multimodal Waterways Summit. The PM Gati Shakti Multimodal Waterways Summit will be held at the Deendayal Hastkala Sankul (Trade Centre and Museum) in Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh. The primary objective of the summit is to bring together greater awareness about the PM Gati Shakti National Masterplan with a focus on infrastructure development in the waterways. PM Gati Shakti Multimodal Waterways Summit is a transformative approach for improving logistics efficiency and reducing logistics costs to ensure first and last-mile connectivity. The Ministry has identified 101 projects estimated to cost around 62 thousand crore rupees under Gati Shakti which are aimed to be completed by 2024.
- 29. PM Modi to gift Himachal Pradesh artifact to the G20 leaders in Bali summit:** Prime Minister Narendra Modi will gift the local artifacts made in Himachal Pradesh to the world leaders at the upcoming G20 Summit. The G20 Summit will take place in Indonesia's capital city, Bali. PM Modi will hand over the local artifacts like Chamba Rumals, Kinnauri Shawl, Himachal Mukhate, Kangra Miniature Paintings, Kullu Shawl, and Kanai Brass Set to the World leaders. Prime Minister also unveiled the logo, theme, and website for India's Presidency of the G20. India's G20 logo juxtaposes planet Earth with Lotus and the theme is "Vasudhaiv Kutumbakam". The country is all set to assume the presidency of the grouping of the world's 20 largest economies on 1st December 2022.
- 30. India to host Women's World Boxing Championships in 2023:** India to host the IBA Women's World Boxing Championship 2023. In a press conference held in New Delhi, an MoU was signed between the International Boxing Association (IBA) and the Boxing Federation of India (BFI). The MoU

was signed in the presence of IBA President Umar Kremlev and BFI President Ajay Singh. The occasion was also felicitated by world champion Nikhat Zareen.

31. Finance Minister Approves India's First Sovereign Green Bonds Framework: Finance Minister Approves India's First Sovereign Green Bonds Framework.

What Are Green Bonds:

A green bond is a debt instrument with which capital is being raised to fund 'green' projects, which typically include those relating to renewable energy, clean transportation, sustainable water management etc. A bond is a fixed income instrument that represents a loan made by an investor to a borrower (typically corporate or governmental). Bonds traditionally paid a fixed interest rate (coupon) to investors. Green bonds enhance an issuer's reputation, as it helps in showcasing their commitment towards sustainable development. Green bonds typically carry a lower interest rate than the loans offered by the commercial banks. The Framework comes close on the footsteps of India's commitments under Panchamrit as elucidated by the Prime Minister, Narendra Modi, at COP26 at Glasgow in November, 2021. The approval is fulfillment of the announcement in the Union Budget FY 2022-23 by the Union Finance Minister that Sovereign Green Bonds will be issued for mobilising resources for green projects.

32. Ramesh Kejriwal elected new president of All India Rubber Industries Association: All India Rubber Industries Association (AIRIA) has announced that it has elected Ramesh Kejriwal as its president and Shashi Singh as the senior vice president. Kejriwal will play a key role in leading forward the road map of the apex body for rubber industries in the country. Prior to being elected to this position, Kejriwal was a Managing Committee Member of AIRIA and has previously served as the Eastern Region Chairman.

33. Switzerland Tourism: Neeraj Chopra becomes 'Friendship Ambassador' of Switzerland: Switzerland Tourism has appointed Olympic Gold medalist Neeraj Chopra as the 'Friendship Ambassador'. In his new role, the talented Indian sports superstar will showcase and promote the adventurous, sporty, and stunning outdoors of Switzerland to Indian travellers.

34. National Fisheries Development Board awarded "India Agribusiness Awards 2022": National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB), Hyderabad, a vibrant organization under the Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India was one of the organisation to be awarded with "India Agribusiness Awards 2022" for the best Agribusiness Award under Fisheries Sector. Notably: While Haryana has received the 'India Agribusiness Awards 2022' in the best state category for their contribution in the areas of agriculture.

35. Year 2022 declared as ASEAN-India Friendship year: The year 2022 has been declared as the ASEAN-India Friendship year, as ASEAN and India commemorate 30 years of partnership. A series of events has been planned to celebrate the occasion throughout the year. As a part of this programme, Indian media delegation is on a visit to Singapore and Cambodia under the ASEAN-INDIA Media exchange programme from 8th November to 13th November. India was initially made a sectoral partner by ASEAN in 1992. With the increasing depth in the relationships the status was changed to a
