- Union Minister Bhupender Yadav Launches New Features in e-Shram Portal for Unorganised Workers: Union Minister for Labour & Employment and Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Bhupender Yaday, launched new features in eShram Portal to improve the utility of the portal and facilitate ease of registration for unorganised workers. The new version also has a Data Sharing Portal (DSP) and a Data Analytics Portal. The portal was added with a feature of capturing family details of migrant worker which will be supportive in providing Child education and women-centric schemes to the migrant workers who have migrated with family.
- Uneecops Plans to set up First Green Hydrogen Microgrid Project in Leh Region: Uneecops Technologies Limited, a Delhi-based company specialising in green hydrogen and solar development, announced its plans to set up the First green hydrogen microgrid project in Leh Region (Ladakh). This is a pioneering initiative that is expected to revolutionise sustainable energy solutions in the region and pave the way for similar projects in the future. ✓ The project involves setting up a 25kWe(Kilowattelectric) green hydrogenbased fuel cell microgrid for a guest house located at the Power Station in Alchi, Leh.
- RAMBAAN, Asia's 1st Mobile Biosafety Level-3 Laboratory, Exhibited at G20 Summit, Goa: India's and Asia's first mobile biosafety level-3 (BSL-3) laboratory named 'Rapid Action Mobile BSL-3 Advanced Augmented Network (RAMBAAN)', designed to investigate emerging viral infections was showcased at the second G20(Group of 20) Health Working Group meeting held in Panaji, Goa.The made-in-India mobile clinic RAMBAAN (Rapid Action Mobile BSL3+ Advanced Augmented Network) can be used to reach remote regions to carry out testing.
- AAI & DGCA Signs Pact with European Agencies to Deepen Aviation Ties Between India & EU: During the European Union (EU)-India Aviation Summit 2023 held from 20th to 21st April 2023 in New Delhi, Delhi, the Airport Authority of India (AAI) and Directorate General of Civil Aviation of India (DGCA India) signs a deal with European agencies to deepen the ties between India and European Union (EU) in the aviation sector. ✓ AAI and Eurocontrol signed a declaration of intent to enhance Air Traffic Management (ATM). ✓ DGCA of India and the European Union Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) signed a letter of intent (LoI) for closer cooperation. ✓ Note: The summit was jointly organised by the European Commission DirectorateGeneral for Mobility and Transport and the Ministry of Civil Aviation, Government of India.
- Rajasthan Gets 3 New Conservation Reserves: Sorsan in Baran, Khichan in Jodhpur, & Hamirgarh in Bhilwara: On the occasion of International Mother Earth Day (Earth Day) 2023 (22nd April 2023), the Forest Department, Government of Rajasthan announced 3 new conservation reserves that will protect the rare and endangered wildlife of Rajasthan. The 3 new wildlife conservation reserves

- 6. NITI Aayog Releases Report on to revive and mainstream millets in diets: NITI Aayog (National Institution For Transforming India) released a report titled "Promoting Millets in Diets: Best Practices across States/UTs of India" which presents a collection of good and innovative practices adopted by state governments and organisations in various aspects of the millet value chain. ✓ The report discusses the best practices across various aspects, especially production, processing and consumption and serves as a guiding repository to revive and mainstream millets in our diets.
- 7. Union Minister Nirmala Sitharaman approves Navratna status to Rail Vikas Nigam: Union Minister Nirmala Sitharaman, Ministry of Finance (MoF), approved the upgradation of Rail Vikas Nigam Limited (RVNL) to a Navratna Central Public Sector Enterprise (CPSE) from a Category-I MiniRatna CPSE. According to the Department of Public Enterprises (DPE), RVNL, a public sector undertaking under the Ministry of Railways (MoR), has become the 13th Navratna amongst CPSEs.
- 8. Textile Minister Piyush Goyal dedicated Handloom & Handicraft Portal for Making Artisans & Weavers Self-Reliant: Union Minister Piyush Goyal, Ministry of Textiles, launched a new virtual Indian store i.e. ECommerce portal (Indiahandmade) for handicrafts and handloom industry from Gujarat. This platform will directly connect consumers with over 35 lakh handloom weavers and 27 lakh skilled handicraft artisans, thereby eliminating intermediaries. ✓ The platform also offers free shipping with return options and safe and secure multiple payment gateways for a smooth transaction experience.
- 9. 28 States/UTs adopts National Generic Document Registration System for Land Records: National Generic Document Registration System(NGDRS) for Land Records has been adopted by a total of 28 States and Union Territories (UT). According to the Department of Land Resources (DoLR), under the Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD), eRegistration is taking place in these States/UTs, or they have started sharing data with the national portal of NGDRS via User Interface /Application Programming Interface (API). ✓ According to the latest data from the DoLR's Land Resources Division, the (14- digit alpha-numeric unique ID) Unique Land Parcel Identification Number (ULPIN) or Bhu-Aadhar has been adopted by 26 States/UTs and pilot testing done in 7 more States /UTs.
- 10. MSME Minister Narayan Rane launches Revamped CGTMSE Scheme: Union Minister Narayan Tatu Rane, Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (M/o MSME) launched the revamped Credit Guarantee Fund Trust for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE) Scheme in Mumbai, Maharashtra. This launch was on the lines of an additional corpus support of Rs 9,000 crore in the Union Budget for FY 2023-24 to CGTMSE to revamp its Scheme to provide guarantee for additional Rs 2 lakh crore to MSEs. ✓ CGTMSE will collaborate with National Institute for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (NI-MSME), Hyderabad (Telangana) for setting up a Centre of Financial Inclusion for MSME.
- 11. Union Minister Amit Shah Launches World's 1st 'Nano DAP' Developed by IFFCO: Union Minister Amit Shah, Ministry of Home Affairs and Ministry of Cooperation, launched "IFFCO Nano DAP(liquid)", the world's first liquid Nano DAP(Diammonium phosphate), developed by Indian TEACHERS' VISION SCO-77, TOP FLOOR, SEC-15D CHD PH:- 7529000184

- MoHUA launches the 'City Beauty Competition' and Portal: On April 26, 2023, the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) launched the 'City Beauty Competition' portal for participation of all urban local bodies (ULBs) across the country through an online process. The aim of the portal is to encourage and recognize the transformational efforts made by cities and wards across the country to create beautiful, innovative and inclusive public spaces.

- 14. India-built Mongolia's First greenfield Oil Refinery to be completed by 2025: Mongolia's first greenfield oil refinery, built in the South Gobi on the outskirts of the capital city Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia, and funded with Indian assistance, will be completed by 2025. Its first stage of Mongol Oil Refinery, built with a USD 1.2 billion Indian soft loan, will be completed at the end 2023 while its Stage-2 (Open Art Units, Utilities & Offsites, Plant Buildings) and Stage-3 (Captive Power Plants) at a cost of USD 790 million will be completed by 2025. ✓ The project is part of the Development Partnership Administration initiative of the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA), Government of India. ✓ About Mongolia: Capital Ulaanbaatar, Currency Mongolian Tugrik
- 15. UK Bilateral Training Exercise 'Ajeya Warrior 2023' Begin at Salisbury Plains of UK: The 7th edition of India and the United Kingdom (UK) bilateral training exercise 'Ajeya Warrior 2023' was planned to be conducted at Salisbury Plains, UK to build positive military relations, to learn each other's best practices and promote the ability to operate together while undertaking company-level subconventional operations in urban and semi-urban environments. ✓ It is a biennial training exercise of India and UK, which is conducted alternatively in the UK and India, the 6th edition was held at Chaubatia, Uttarakhand in October 2021.
- 16. India signs new Work Plan 2023 on Quality Infrastructure with Germany: Department of Consumer Affairs, under the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution, and the German Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Climate Action signed the new Work Plan for 2023 during the 9th Annual Meeting of the Indo-German Working Group on Quality Infrastructure (QI) in Berlin, Germany. This year's Annual Meeting marks the 10th anniversary of the Working Group. About Germany: Capital—Berlin, Currency—Euro

- 19. Reserve Bank of Zimbabwe to Launch Gold-Pegged Digital Currency: Reserve Bank of Zimbabwe (RBZ) is set to launch a gold-backed digital currency to serve as legal tender in Zimbabwe. This is an initiative of the government of Zimbabwe to stabilize the local currency from continued depreciation against the United States (US) dollar. ✓ This will allow small amounts of Zimbabwean dollars to be exchanged for the digital gold token, enabling more Zimbabweans to hedge against currency volatility
- 20. Reliance General Becomes 1st Insurer to Accept eRupee in Partnership with Yes Bank: Reliance General Insurance, a subsidiary of Reliance Capital, has become the first company to accept eRupee(e₹)/ Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) CBDC (Central Bank Digital Currency) for premium payments. Reliance General Insurance accepts the eRupee through a partnership with Yes Bank to enable its customers to make premium payments digitally using the bank's platform.
- 21. NPCI Bharat BillPay launches NOCS platform to process ONDC transactions: NPCI Bharat BillPay Ltd (NBBL) has developed and launched the NOCS platform to provide reconciliation and settlement services for transactions undertaken on the Open Network for Digital Commerce (ONDC) network. NOCS will help ONDC by providing a populationscale solution for the challenges of high transaction volume among different entities on the network. ✓ NPCI Bharat BillPay Ltd (NBBL):-CEO— Noopur Chaturvedi ,Headquarters— Mumbai, Maharashtra
- 22. WYLD, World's 1st Social Currency Payment Card, launched in Mumbai: WYLD, the world's 1st Social Currency Payment Card, was launched in Mumbai, Maharashtra, and was powered by San Francisco (California, USA)- based VISA Inc., an American multinational financial services corporation. ITC Overtakes Infosys as India's 6th Largest Company; RIL tops the list: ITC Limited has overtaken Infosys Limited, an Indian multinational information technology company, to become India's 6th largest company, as per market capitalization(m-cap). ITC's market cap stands at Rs 5.11 lakh crore (as of April 24, 2023) while the market cap of Infosys (7th place) stands at Rs 5.08 lakh crore. ✓ Reliance Industries Limited (RIL) is India's largest company with a market cap of Rs 16.07 lakh crore followed by Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) with Rs 11.62 lakh crore and HDFC Bank with Rs.9.28 lakh crore. ✓ ICICI Bank stands at the 4th position with an m-cap of ~Rs 6.38 lakh crore and Hindustan Unilever Limited (HUL) stands at 5th place with an m-cap of ~Rs 5.85 lakh crore.
- 27. ADB Annual Report 2022: Pakistan is the Largest Recipient of ADB Loans in Asia: According to the Asian Development Bank (ADB) Annual Report 2022, Pakistan received loans of USD5.58 billion, making it the largest recipient of ADB-funded programs/projects in 2022. According to the report, released on 24th April 2023, ADB has disbursed a total of over USD 31.8 billion to 40 countries in 2022.

- 29. Ratan Tata honoured with Order of Australia(AO), highest civil honour of Australia: Ratan Tata, Indian industrialist, philanthropist, and chairman Emeritus of Tata Sons, was awarded the Officer of the Order of Australia (AO), Australia's highest civilian honour, in recognition of his contribution to strengthening the bilateral ties between India and Australia particularly in trade, investment, and philanthropy. The announcement was made by the Australian Ambassador to India Mr. Barry O' Farrell. ✓ In March 2023, Ratan Tata was appointed as an Honorary Officer in the General Division of the Order of Australia.
- 30. Winners of Goldman Environmental Prize 2023 Announced: On April 24, 2023, winners of the Goldman Environmental Prize 2023 were announced at the War Memorial Opera House in San Francisco, California, the United States of America (USA). 6 winners of the 2023 prize are Alessandra Korap Munduruku from Brazil, Chilekwa Mumba from Zambia, Delima Silalahi from Indonesia, Diane Wilson from the USA, Tero Mustonen from Finland, and Zafer Kızılkaya from Turkiye. ✓ 2023 marks the 34th anniversary of the Goldman Environmental Prize which honors one grassroots activist from each of the six inhabited continents. ✓ The award is also known as the "Green Nobel Prize".

RBI approves re-appointment of Kamakodi as MD & CEO of CUB for 3 years: Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has approved the reappointment of N Kamakodi as the Managing director (MD) & Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of a Kumbakonam (TamilNadu) based private sector bank City Union Bank (CUB) for a period of three years with effect from May 1, 2023. ✓ City Union Bank (CUB): MD & CEO− Dr N. Kamakodi, Headquarters− Kumbakonam, Tamil Nadu
- 34. Government appoints Arun Sinha as Chairman of NTRO: The Government has appointed Arun Kumar Sinha, a 1984 batch Indian Police Service (IPS) officer of Kerala cadre, as the appointed

- 35. He will succeed, Sanjiv Chadha, the incumbent MD & CEO of BoB, who is set to retire on 30th June 2023. ✓ Rajneesh Karnataka, Executive Director of Union Bank of India was appointed as the MD & CEO of Bank of India(BoI) for a period of three years from the date of assumption of office or until further orders.He succeeds Atanu Kumar Das whose tenure as MD and CEO of BoI ended in January 2023.
- 37. Vodafone appoints Margherita Della Valle as Permanent CEO: Vodafone Group Plc (Vodafone), a British multinational telecommunications company, appointed Margherita Della Valle, Group Chief Executive Officer (CEO) (Interim) and Chief Financial Officer (CFO), as the permanent CEO of Vodafone. She is the first permanent female CEO of Vodafone. ✓ She had taken up the charge as interim CEO of the organisation on 1st January 2023 after Nick Read stepped down from the CEO role.

Jaden Pariat becomes 1st Indian in 6 years to get on Podium in British F4 Championship: India's Jaden Pariat of Argenti Motorsport, a 16- year-old from Meghalaya, become the 1st Indian in 6 years to get on Podium in the first round of the ROKiT British F4 Championship, the FIA (Federation Internationale de l'Automobile) certified championship, at Donington Park in Leicestershire, England, United Kingdom (UK). ✓ Jaden Pariat is the 2nd Indian to get an international podium in a Tatuus F4 car after Kush Maini of Jenzer Motorsport who finished 3rd in the 2017 Italian F4 Championship. ✓ Jaden Pariat clinched the 3rd position in Race 2 of the ROKiT British F4 Championship.
- 39. 1 Antalya: India finished 2nd with 4 medals: India finished 2nd in the overall medal tally at the 2023 Hyundai Archery World Cup Stage 1 held in Antalya, Türkiye, with 4 medals (2 gold, 1 silver, 1 bronze). The United States of America (USA) topped the medal tally with 4 medals(2 gold and 2 silver).
 ✓ 2023 Hyundai Archery World Cup is the 17th edition of the international archery circuit organised annually by World Archery. ✓ Indian archer Jyothi Surekha Vennam wins gold in women's individual compound and mixed team events along with Ojas Pravin Deotale.

- 40. Five-time Punjab CM Parkash Singh Badal passed away: Five-time Punjab Chief Minister (CM) and veteran Shiromani Akali Dal (SAD) leader Parkash Singh Badal passed away at the age of 95 in Mohali, Punjab. He was born on 8th December 1927 at Abul Khurana, near Malout in Punjab. ✓ The Government of India awarded him the second-highest civilian award, Padma Vibhushan, in 2015(public affairs), however he returned his award in 2020 to support the 2020–2021 Indian farmers' protest against the farm laws.
- 41. Tripura's 1st Padma Shri awardee, Himangshu Mohan Choudhury, Passed Away: On 25th April 2023, former Indian Administrative Services (IAS) Officer, Himangshu Mohan Choudhury, who was the first recipient of Padma Shri from Tripura, passed away in Agartala, Tripura. He was born into a family hailing Feni district (now in Bangladesh). ✓ Himangshu Mohan Choudhury was honoured by the Government of India in 1972 with Padma Shri for Civil Service, the 4th highest Indian civilian award.
- 42. Boxing Champion, Padma Shri Awardee Kaur Singh passed away: Veteran heavyweight boxer, a Padma Shri and Arjuna awardee, Kaur Singh, 74 passed away in Kurukshetra, Haryana. Kaur Singh won six gold medals in international competitions. He was awarded Sena Medal and the Vishisht Sewa Medal in 1988 for his bravery. ✓ In 1982 he got the Arjuna Award, India's second-highest National Sports Award by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, for earning gold medal in the Asian Games. ✓ In 1983, the Government of India awarded Kaur Singh with the Padma Shri, India's fourth-highest civilian honour award for outstanding contribution to Indian sports.
