#### DATES & DAYS

- **1st July – National Doctor's Day.** Celebrated in India since 1991. Honouring the legendary and renowned doctor Bidhan Chandra Roy (01 July 1882 - 01 July 1962) - was a well-known doctor, educator, freedom fighter, social worker, and politician. Theme: "Behind the Mask: Who Heals the Healers?"
- **5th July:- International Day of Cooperatives.** Theme: "Cooperatives: Driving Inclusive and Sustainable Solutions for a Better World."
- **11 July World Population Day.** Theme:- "Empowering young people to create the families they want in a fair and hopeful world". World Population Day was established by the then-Governing Council of the United Nations Development Programme in 1989.
- **12 July- International Day of Combating Sand and Dust Storms.** In 2023, the United Nations General Assembly proclaimed 12 July as the International Day of Combating Sand and Dust Storms. Theme : - "Sand and Dust Storms: Working Across Agendas for Resilience and Sustainability".
- **12 July- International Day of Hope.** United Nations General Assembly has designated 12 July as the International Day of Hope—a day to celebrate and promote hope as a guiding principle for individuals, communities, and nations alike. THEME :- A Universal Need in Uncertain Times
- **18th July:- Nelson Mandela International Day.** Commemorates the birth of Nelson Mandela, South Africa's first Black President and a global icon of peace, justice, and reconciliation. Recognized by the United Nations in 2009.
- **July 20 :- International Moon Day.** Marks the anniversary of the first landing by humans on the Moon as part of the Apollo 11 lunar mission in 1969. UN General Assembly declared International Moon Day in 2021.
- **22 July :-National Flag Day.** On 22nd July 1947, the Constituent Assembly of India, chaired by Dr. Rajendra Prasad, adopted the National Flag. The design of the Indian tricolour is largely attributed to Pingali Venkayya, an Indian freedom fighter. He passed away in 1963 and was posthumously honoured with a postage stamp in 2009 for his contribution towards Indian freedom struggle. In 2014, his name was also proposed for the Bharat Ratna.
- **26th July :-Kargil Vijay Diwas.** To commemorate India's victory over Pakistan in the Kargil War. It was fought between India and Pakistan between May and July 1999 in the Kargil and along the Line of Control (LOC). Operation Vijay: The Indian Army fought bravely and recaptured the famous 'Tiger Hill' and other important posts around under 'Operation Vijay'

- **Meenakshi Ganesan** assumed charge as the Deputy Director General (DDG) of the Southern Regional Office, Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) , first woman to take over as the DDG of BIS, Southern Region Headquartered in Chennai.

- **NASA's exoplanet-hunting spacecraft – the Transiting Exoplanet Survey Satellite (TESS) has discovered the exoplanet, called TOI-4465 b,** a gas giant which is located almost 400 light years from Earth. With a mass six times and a width 1.25 times that of Jupiter. TOI-4465 b is cooler, given its massive size and density.

- DRDO and Indian Air Force successfully test-fired the indigenous Astra Beyond Visual Range Air-to-Air Missile (BVRAAM) with an indigenously developed Radio Frequency (RF) seeker, validating its precision and technological reliability.
- The National Commodity and Derivatives Exchange (NCDEX) partnered with the India Meteorological Department (IMD) to introduce these innovative financial instruments. Weather derivatives allow farmers, businesses, and financial institutions to hedge against weather-related uncertainties.
- Union Minister Nitin Gadkari inaugurates India's second longest cable-stayed sigandur bridge in Karnataka.
- Yakten village in Pakyong district, Sikkim became India's first digital nomad village on 15 July 2025.
- Gujarat tops in production and export of processed potatoes in India. State has emerged as the top producer of processed potatoes in India, followed by Uttar Pradesh and Punjab.
- Gujarat Becomes First State to Support Cruise Bharat Mission. Aiming to boost coastal tourism in the state, the Gujarat government is in the process to frame its Cruise Shipping Policy aligned with the national Cruise Bharat Mission (CBM). CBM was launched by Union Minister of Ports, Shipping and Waterways, Sarbananda Sonowal on September 30, 2024. Cruise Bharat Mission aims to make India a global cruise tourism hub within the next decade with a goal to increase sea cruise tourism ten fold by 2029.
- India has launched its first-ever commercial hydrogen fuel cell bus service in Leh, Ladakh. The green hydrogen buses were handed over by NTPC Limited to the State Industrial Development Corporation (SIDCO) in a formal ceremony held at NTPC's hydrogen mobility station in Palam, Leh.
- Coal India's First Fully Women-Operated Dispensary Inaugurated at SECL Headquarters, Bilaspur – Chhattisgarh.
- The President of India, Smt Droupadi Murmu presented the Kalinga Ratna Award-2024 to Union Minister for Education, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan at Cuttack, Odisha.
- Cabinet approved PMDKY for a period of six years, covering 100 districts with an annual outlay of ₹24,000 crore. Scheme aims to enhance agricultural productivity, increase adoption of crop diversification and sustainable agricultural practices, augment post-harvest storage at the panchayat and block levels, improve irrigation facilities and facilitate availability of long-term and short-term credit. Finance Minister announced the launch of PMDKY in the Union Budget 2025-26.
- The National Statistical Office (NSO), India, in collaboration with the Innovation Cell of the Ministry of Education (MoE), today launched a Grand Challenge titled "Statathon – A Data Journey Towards Viksit Bharat". Grand Challenge is a national-level competition designed to harness emerging technologies and innovative solutions to transform the landscape of official statistics in India.

More than 10 lakh population category - Indore followed by Surat and Navi Mumbai . 3 to 10 lakh population category - **Noida** emerged the cleanest city, followed by Chandigarh and Mysore. In the 'Swachh Shahar' category for cities : -More than 10 lakh population - **Ahmedabad** secured the first position followed by Bhopal and Lucknow. Best Ganga Town to **Prayagraj**. Best Cantonment Board- **Secunderabad** Cantonment for its exemplary sanitation efforts. Best Saifai Mitra Surakshit Shehar- GVMC Visakhapatnam, Jabalpur, and Gorakhpur.
- **IIT Madras recently launched YD One**, India's lightest wheelchair.
- **China has successfully tested Magnetic Levitation (Maglev) technology**, with the potential to make trains even faster than jets.
- On **27th July in Tamil Nadu - India is commemorating the 1000th anniversary of Rajendra Chola I's northern expedition**, which led to the establishment of **Gangaikonda Cholapuram**, a grand Chola capital and the Brihadisvara Temple a UNESCO-listed architectural marvel.
- **India secured three gold, two silver, and one bronze medal at the 66th International Mathematical Olympiad (IMO) 2025, held in Sunshine Coast, Australia.** Gold winners – Kanav Talwar and Arav Gupta from Delhi, and Aditya Mangudi from Maharashtra. India ranked 7th globally this year, scoring a record 193 out of 252 points-its highest so far.
