- **2 September World Coconut Day.** Established by the Asian and Pacific Coconut Community (APCC) to recognize the importance of the coconut in agriculture, cuisine, industry, and culture. THEME: "Uncovering Coconut's Power, Inspiring Global Action"
- **5 September:- International Day of Charity.** To commemorate the death anniversary of Mother Teresa. THEME: The Power of Charity in Global Solidarity.
- **7 September:-International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies.** THEME: Racing for Air. Every Breath Matters. The United Nations General Assembly designated First Day held in 2020.
- **7 September:- International Day of Police Cooperation.** Theme: ICT and AI in policing. It was designated in the United Nations General Assembly Marked for the first time in 2023.

- **15 September -Engineer's Day (India).** To commemorate the birth anniversary of Sir Mokshagundam Visvesvaraya (1861–1962), one of India’s greatest engineers, statesmen, and Bharat Ratna awardee.Known as the “Father of Modern Mysore” for his role in the industrial, economic, and educational development of Mysore State. He presided over the Indian Science Congress in 1923
- **16 September :–International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone layer.** Theme :- From science to global action. It commemorates the signing of Montreal Protocol on substances that deplete Ozone layer
- **18 September:- World Bamboo Day.** Established in 2009 during 8th World Bamboo Congress in Bangkok , Thailand. Theme :- “ Next generation Bamboo : Solution , Innovation and Design”.
- **21 September :-International Day of Peace (UN).** First observed in 1982. THEME:- Act now for a Peaceful World..
- **25 September :-World Maritime Day.** THEME:- Our Ocean , Our Obligation , Our Opportunity. First observed in 1978. Commemorates adoption of International Maritime Organisation (IMO) Convention in 1948 which came into force in 1958.

It is a pioneering digital learning platform for tribal artforms, preserving heritage, enabling livelihoods, and connecting India's tribal communities with the world.

- The Tribal Affairs Ministry will soon launch "Adi Vaani", India's first artificial intelligence (AI)-powered translator for tribal languages, Developed by IIT Delhi, BITS Pilani, IIIT Hyderabad and IIIT Nava Raipur, in collaboration with Tribal Research Institutes (TRIs). The app will be available on the Play Store with an iOS version coming soon.
- Matsya Shakti Project :- Launched in August 2025 by Union Minister of State for Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying (George Kurian) in Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala. Aimed at empowering minority fishing communities through skill development and sustainable livelihood training under the Pradhan Mantri Virasat Ka Samvardhan (PM VIKAS) scheme.
- e-Sushrut@Clinic is a lightweight, cloud-based Health Management Information System (HMIS) developed by C-DAC and launched in collaboration with the National Health Authority (NHA).
- A private consortium of four space start-ups led by Bengaluru-based Pixxel Space has won a bid to build and run the country's fully-indigenous commercial earth observation satellite constellation
- The third United Nations Conference on Landlocked Developing Countries (LLDC3) held in Awaza, Turkmenistan from 5-8 August. Theme - "Driving Progress through Partnerships,"
- 19th edition assessed 163 countries on safety, conflict, and militarisation. Released by the Institute for Economics and Peace, India is ranked at 115th position with a score of 2.229, highlighting no change from last year. Iceland retained the top spot globally, followed by Ireland and New Zealand. Singapore has been ranked the safest country in Asia, securing the sixth position worldwide, a slight drop from its 5th-place rank in 2024.
- Amish Tripathi launches his new book, The Chola Tigers: The Avengers of Somnathin Chennai.
- PM Modi inaugurated Semicon India 2025 in New Delhi on September 2. Union Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw presented India's first indigenously made Vikram 32-bit processor chip to PM Modi at the 'Semicon India' 2025 conference. Semicon India 2025 is being organised jointly by the India Semiconductor Mission (ISM) under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) and SEMI, the global semiconductor industry body.
- Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA) has launched the BHARATI initiative to support 100 agri-food startups and target \$50 billion agri-food exports by 2030. Foster innovation in agri-food production, processing, packaging, and logistics. BHARATI stands for Bharat's Hub for Agritech, Resilience, Advancement and Incubation for Export Enablement.
- India's first-ever vulture conservation portal—named The Vulture Network—has officially been launched in Assam.
- IIT-Madras secures top spot in NIRF Rankings 2025 for seventh year in a row. Union Education Minister, Dharmendra Pradhan, released the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) 2025, which annually lists the top-performing universities, colleges, and institutes in India.
- Assam's Bodoland becomes first tribal council to digitise land records.
- Royal Bhutan Buddhist Temple Inaugurated in Rajgir, Bihar.
- 27th Saras Aajeevika Mela commenced in New Delhi.
